HOW SWEEP IT IS

CLUB OF HIS OWN

It's taken just two seasons for Santi Moar to make a lasting impact with Bethlehem Steel FC. The runner up for the 2017 USL Rookie of the Year award, Moar tallied his 10th career goal against the Richmond Kickers on Saturday. With the goal, Moar became the first player in Steel FC history to notch 10 goals and 10 assists in his career to found the 10-10 club.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On defeating Richmond...

"It felt good, this was a very important game for us. We are chasing the playoffs right now and this was a game where we knew we would have an opportunity to win and it turned into a wide open game. They had a couple of good chances in the second half but luckily we were able to finish and execute well. I thought we were good in transition."

On Steel FC's momentum...

"Yeah, we are in the playoff picture. We know every game is crucial so now we will go to Charlotte, which is a tall task since they rarely ever lose there. And we will throw the kitchen sink at them and hope the kids are up to the task."

Bethlehem Steel FC midfielder Santi Moar:

On defeating Richmond...

"This is important because we knew how difficult it is to play [at Richmond]. We came here last year and we dropped three points and today we knew we had to be about it and were able to get all three points."

On the goal he scored...

Herbers led the way with a pair of assists along with a goal while Skundrich added with his first goal and assist of his career.

Nanco got Steel FC off to a fast start with a goal in the 10th minute. After the Independence failed to clear a Steel FC corner, defender Brandon Aubrey sent the ball back into the box where Skundrich delivered a back-heeled flick to Nanco for the opening goal.

The final half saw the home club put the match away early with Moar's goal. As players acclimated to the match once more, Aubrey fired a long ball to the offensive half. Herbers beat the defender with a headed flick toward Moar on the flank. The Spaniard raced with the open space before cutting inside the box before firing a right-footed shot inside the far post.

Steel FC continued one of its best offensive performances with Skudrich's first tally in the 72nd minute. After Olivier Mbazio held possession on the right flank, the Cameroonian fired a cross that Herbers tapped to Skundrich. The Lancaster native fired a left-footed shot that Independence keeper Brandon Miller couldn't contain.

The offense reached a crescendo moments later, as Herbers tacked on a goal in the 83rd. With two assists to his credit, Herbers capped off his evening with a counter-attack goal. Charlotte kept Steel FC from the clean sheet with a strike on the final play of the contest from Jorge Herrera.

Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 26-35-24 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his three seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 83 different starting XI combinations in 85 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 74 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.



Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.
