AGE IS JUST A NUMBER

Six players under the age of 20 appeared in Steel FC's contest against Louisville City FC, tying the club record for most teenagers appearing in a single match. The group consisted of Matt Real, Ben Ofeimu, Michee Ngalina, Anthony Fontana, Jeremy Rafanello and Tonny Temple. The other instance came last season came on July 15, against the Pittsburgh Riverhounds. Matt Real is the only player to appear in both matches.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On playing FC Cincinnati so quickly after Louisville... "I think it's good, we have plenty of good young players here so that we can meet these type of tight turnarounds. You are going to play the top team in the Eastern Conference and the best environment in the East so we view it at fun."

On preparing the younger players for the atmosphere at Nippert Stadium...

"You really can't, it's something they have to experience. I don't know that we'll have too many guys out there that haven't experienced it before. There are always one or two and they just have to trust their teammates to lead them through it, help them get comfortable through the first 20 or 30 minutes of the game."

The keys to knock off FC Cincinnati...

"You need to be sound defensively because they are big, open and they press especially at home and they have a lot of the ball. There is just so much quality in every position so its difficult to pinpoint one thing but I think if you are sound defensively, you give yourself a chance in any game."

For the second straight weekend, Bethlehem Steel FC was forced to settle for a draw as the club drew FC Cincinnati, 1-1.

Much like last weekend, Philadelphia Union forward Cory Burke tallied the club's lone goal, scoring his 15th goal in the United Soccer League in the 15th minute. On the goal, Union homegrown midfielder Anthony Fontana earned his first professional assist and point with Steel FC.

Battling the elements, Steel FC earned the game's first scoring chance in the third minute as midfielder Santi Moar drove down the flank toward the visiting box. With the defense closing in, he riffled a pass to Marcus Epps' whose shot was blocked. After defending a set piece, Steel FC countered and earned its first-half lead. Fontana played a quick pass into the box toward the 26-year-old forward that Burke quickly chipped over the keeper and into the net for his team-leading second goal of 2018.

Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 23-31-21 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his two seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 74 different starting XI combinations in 76 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 71 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.



Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.
