STEEL FC LOOKS TO FORTIFY THE FORTRESS

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On the loss at New York Red Bulls II...

"They sustained their energy level through the second half and were sharper in the final third finishing movements when they broke us down. We got into good positions but never executed in that area of the field on the night."

On the string of one-goal losses in July and what is the team working on in order to swing the results back in its favor...

"We haven't changed anything but there is a renewed sense of urgency for us on the defensive side of the ball. We don't have nearly enough clean sheets at this stage of the season, especially at home."

On the challenges Indy Eleven present...

"Indy have seven or so clean sheets, they are an older, very experienced and compact team, especially on the road. They have been just as good on the road as they have at home which makes this a very important match up for both clubs."

Facing off against a new opponent, Bethlehem Steel FC claimed the first road victory of its 2018 campaign, defeating Indy Eleven, 2-1, at Lucas Oil Stadium.

After a scoreless and physical first half, Steel FC jumped ahead as Philadelphia Union midfield Fabian Herbers connected with Santi Moar for the opening tally of the night. Indy Eleven countered with a goal from midfielder Zach Steinberger in the 70th minute but Steel FC responded four minutes later with a long-distance strike from defender Prosper Chiluya.

After a strong defensive play from midfielder Derrick Jones, he floated a ball forward to Aidan Apodaca that earned the club a throw-in near the corner flag. Indy Eleven was unable to clear Olivier Mbaizo's throw inside the box which Herbers'sent into the middle of the box. Moar settled the pass with his left and fired it off the bounce with his right foot inside the right post for the early 1-0 lead and his second goal of the year.

Indy Eleven ended Steel FC's clean sheet 10 minutes later on a patient buildup that saw Soony Saad flick a volley into the middle of the box that was finished off by Steinberger.

Despite the equalizing goal away from home, Steel FC showed its growing experience to claim its first win on the road. Adam Najem fired a corner kick into the box that the hosts cleared out of their 18-yard box but Chiluya claimed it from 30 yards out. Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 24-34-24 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his three seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 80 different starting XI combinations in 82 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 74 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.




Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.






