STEEL FC HEADS SOUTH FOR MUSIC CITY SHOWDOWN

After knocking off Ottawa earlier in the week, Bethlehem Steel FC continues its crucial week as part of its march to a second-consecutive appearance in the USL Cup Playoffs with a trip to Nashville. The contest is the Keystone State squad's first appearance in the Music City, with the club looking to avenge an early season loss to the USL newcomers.

PREVIOUS MEETING

Bethlehem and Nashville first squared off in the third match of the season on March 31, with the visitors taking advantage of an early red card that netted them a penalty kick in the fifth minute. Despite being down a man for 85 minutes, Steel FC outshot Nashville but the visitors picked up its first goal and win as a club.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On the 2-0 shutout of Ottawa...

"That was a huge win for us, really important that we got three points and it's great to get another clean sheet. That's five out of six and we are in good form while the group keeps changing so credit this to all the guys that have been a part of this through each game but also the guys that are coming into it and buying into the momentum and mentality to make sure we don't give much away. We know that we are good enough to score goals, we're one of the top five in the entire league in terms of goal production. Really happy today."

On the defense

"I when we are good, we are defending from the front because we talk about it being 11 guys. I harp on it and our poor number nine's, I chase them around the field but the reality is that's what it is going to take at the next level and we are trying to ingrain that into these guys and they have really bought in. When you drop into the midfield, you have to highlight Drew Skundrich's ground coverage, I think he changes our ability to press higher up the field in a big way. On top of being a high IQ guy, he covers so much ground."

On the mood of the team

"The mood is positive, obviously we have a tough game coming up against Nashville but we are confident right now and when you are confident, that momentum can carry you across the line and carry you into the playoffs. Today we knew it to be a really important day for us so a lot of relief coming out of it. Honestly, building up to these games you know they are going to be tight and tense so to start the game well was really important for us. We talked to Marcus [Epps] about impacting the game before the game and that was a great, weighted through ball that he plays to Santi [Moar]. Santi has carried us for two years now and to pop up with two goals on a big day is a really important contribution."

An early penalty kick in the visitor's favors proved the difference as Bethlehem Steel FC came up short against Nashville SC, 1-0.

Nashville SC forward Michael Cox converted on the fifth-minute penalty that saw Bethlehem Steel FC defender Brandon Aubrey was sent off for the foul. Despite being a man down, Steel FC outshot the USL-newcomers and had more possession but unable to find the equalizer.

Down a man and a goal with 84 minutes remaining, Steel FC stuck to its game plan to outshoot Nashville 8-4 in the first half while notching 54 percent of the possession. Moments after the goal, Steel FC midfielders James Chambers and Santi Moar linked up for a combination that led to a shot by forward Brandon Allen that was off the mark. Midway through the opening half, Philadelphia Union midfielder Marcus Epps dribbled through Nashville and laid a pass off to Moar but the curler missed the far post.

The second half saw both squads pushing for the next goal. Philadelphia Union goalkeeper Jake McGuire was tested early in the half, stopping a breakaway inside the box in the 46th minute. One of Steel FC's best scoring chances came in the 55th minute off a set piece opportunity. Chambers fired a low shot around the Nashville wall that forced a diving block by Matt Pickens. Adam Najem raced for the rebounded tap-in opportunity but was denied by the keeper at the line as well.

In the waning moments of the match, another free kick presented a chance to equalize. Moar tried from distance in the 80th minute but the 23-year-old's shot was parried away the Pickens to seal Nashville's first victory in club history.

Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 29-36-24 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his three seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 87 different starting XI combinations in 89 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 74 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.



Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.






