#### **SCORING IN BUNCHES**

After notching two more goals last week against Toronto FC II, Steel FC finds itself just two away from rewriting the club's all-time ledger of 46. It's been a team effort for the offense, with 21 players have found the back of the net in 2018.

#### **KEEP IT CLEAN**

#### **YOUTH MOVEMENT**

Bethlehem Steel FC announced last week that the club has acquired midfielder Tesera Antonio Georges Lokwa (preferred name Antonio Lokwa) pending receipt of his P-1 Visa. A native of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Lokwa joins Steel FC on loan from Czech club MKF Vyškov for the remainder of the 2018 season. The deal was completed prior to the transfer window closure on August 8th and will occupy an international spot for Steel FC.

#### STEEL FC HOSTS OTTAWA IN CRUCIAL CONTEST

Bethlehem Steel FC begins a crucial week with major playoff implications at home against Ottawa Fury FC. Steel FC enters with plenty of momentum, having won four of its last five matches which includes three-consecutive clean sheets on the road. With one point seperating fifth place and ninth place on the Eastern Conference table, the match could determine each side's plans in October.

#### **PREVIOUS MEETING**

The two sides met up in Canada in late May, with the hosts striking in the first minute for a win. Kevin Oliveira and Steevan Dos Santos provided the winning attack for the Canadian side, with Oliveira scoring 40 seconds in

### COACH'S CORNER

#### **Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:**

#### On the match against Toronto FC II

"Pleased with the performance, I thought we could have scored before we eventually did through Michee [Ngalina] but happy that the guys kept pushing. I thought we threatened regularly throughout the 90 minutes which we would expect to in that game. Toronto was good, they are re-energized under their new coach and they had won two of their previous three games and really pushed Pittsburgh to the brink in that game at Pittsburgh where Pittsburgh ended up winning 1-0. I'm happy that we took care of business and that Aidan [Apodaca] was able to come on and find his second goal of the season a few minutes later to put the game away. It's alw ays good to win away from home and it's never easy."

#### Expectations of Ottawa

"I expect it to be a playoff game. They are men across the board, there aren't many young guys on their team so they are experienced and know how to play in games like this and know how to make the game difficult. They are happy to concede possession and sit behind the ball and try to beat you when you are caught higher up the field, they ever do it at their home field. They have a very clear identity and playing style and players that can execute which is why they are one of the league leaders in clean sheets. It shows in the way they play, they are really committed to making the game slow and ugly."

#### On the message to the forwards about attacking Ottawa

"We certainly won't change our style of play because we think we can be highly effective when we are on. We've talked to them about being willing to play in tight spaces and being willing to play in between the lines and take their lumps. It's a big, physical team but that doesn't mean that we can't break them down and we have the creative players in our front four and have enough pace in our front four to threaten anyone we line up against. Our hope is that we can strike first and make them come out and play, that would be the best result for us coming into halftime."

Bethlehem Steel FC fell in its final match of May, falling to Ottawa Fury FC, 1-0. As fans at TD Place made their way to their seats, Ottawa jumped on the scoreboard just with a goal from Kevin Oliveira just 42 seconds in. Steevan Dos Santos began the run after winning the ball in the midfield that was flicked toward Adonijah Reid. Reid backheeled it back to Dos Santos and found Oliveira on the wing and running toward the goal. With Steel FC defenders rushing back to their own net, Oliveira lifted a shot that kissed off the far post and into the net.

Despite the very early deficit, Steel FC looked to respond with chances from midfielders James Chambers and Adam Najem. The duo earned chances minutes apart as Najem flicked a pass to Chambers who fired a left-footed curler that was saved by Ottawa goalkeeper Maxime Crépeau. Two minutes later, Chambers repaid the favor to Najem but once again Ottawa made the stop.

With the first half winding down, both teams created a dangerous chance but were unable to notch goals. Aidan Apodaca found space on a counter attack in the 42nd minute and chipped the keeper only to see his effort cleared at the goal line.

Steel FC pushed for an equalizer in the second half, pushing attack after attack over the final 45 minutes but were unable to snap Ottawa's shutout streak which extended to five matches. Philadelphia Union Academy forward Jeremy Rafanello created a pair of dangerous chances in his team and league debut with his first coming in the 70th minute. Building off a defensive stand at the edge of the box, Najem fired a cross toward the 18-year-old. With a defender leaning in, the forward took a touch and saw his right-footed blast tipped over the bar. In stoppage time, Union defender Matt Real first a cross into the box but the Ottawa's Crépeau beat the 18-year-old to it.

### 2018 BETHELEHEM STEEL FC TECHNICAL STAFF



### Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 28-36-24 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his three seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 86 different starting XI combinations in 88 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 74 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.



### Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.




