The two sides squared off back in early July with Fabian Herbers netting a brace but three-consecutive goals by Penn FC proved too difficult to overcome by Steel FC away from home.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On the win at Nashville

"It was a good away win for us. I thought we started the game very well and did a great job of controlling the flow of the game and that's what we talked about going in with. They aren't necessarily a team that tries to dominate the ball so we tried to double down on possessing the ball well in the first half and it led to some good looks at goal and eventually the goal and two yellow cards to their right wing back. It was a great start to the game and gave us enough of a platform, even though I don't think we put our foot down toward the end of the first half or the second half, go help us go and win the game which we are only the second team to get that done in Nashville. It just continues the momentum and it doesn't matter how young we go or how much we rotate, right now we are into a really good rhythm as a group."

On starting four teenagers on the road and getting a win "We understood that we were going to be extremely young in that game but they are also guys that have gotten some good experience with us and they each have a couple hundred minutes under their belt this year. Ultimately what it's all about is experience so when we think a guy is good enough and starts to accumulate that experience then we start to rely on them to produce in those environments. That was a big one. Ben [Ofemu] was good, Faris was good, Brenden [Aaronson] was good and Matt [Real] has been good for the last two months solid I would say."

How does the return of Tommy Heinemann change Penn FC "He's big and a handful and he's good in the air. He runs hard off the ball and runs hard on the defensive side of the ball. I think he allows them to be a little more aggressive as a group, especially if he's paired with Lucky [Mkosana] or someone like that. Aaron Dennis is in decent form right now. They have a lot of good options across the front and have a number of different combinations that they can throw at you."

MATCH RECAP

Bethlehem Steel FC saw its season-long five-match unbeaten streak come to an end on the road, falling on the road at rival Penn FC, 3-2.

Steel FC jumped out to the early lead with a strike from Union midfielder Fabian Herbers in the 17th minute of play. The German international collected a pass from Santi Moar, taking four touches before firing a shot pass Penn FC's Romu Peiser. The assist was Moar's 11th of his career, becoming the club's all-time leader.

The lead didn't last for long as the hosts used their aerial awareness to strike for two goals in five minutes. After Steel FC goalkeeper Jake McGuire made a diving save on a shot from Isaac Osae, the rebound was chased down by Frederick Opuku at the far post and fired into the back of the net at the tight angle. The hosts took the lead in the 25th minute once again off a McGuire save. Off a set piece, McGuire tipped Paulo Junior's off the crossbar but Lucky Mkosasa found himself open inside the box and finished it off the play for his sixth goal of the year.

After getting outshot by a 17-5 margin in the first half, Steel FC return to the pitch looking for an equalizer early in the final period which the hosts took advantage of. Forcing a turnover in the midfield, Mkosana changed the point of attack with a pass to Isaac Osae at the edge of the box. Unmarked on the quick buildup, the Ghanian beat the keeper with a hard right-footed shot into the upper 90.

Seeking some magic much like the contest against New York Red Bulls II, Steel FC trimmed the Penn FC lead to one in the 82nd minute. Pushing hard for a result, outside back Olivier Mbaizo came forward with a run into the 18-yard-box and was taken down by Calvin Rezende. Herbers calmly beat the keeper with a conversion from the penalty spot which ultimately ended the scoring.

Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 30-36-24 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his three seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 88 different starting XI combinations in 90 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 74 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.



Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.
