ROUGHING UP THE KICKERS

Richmond and the Philadelphia Union organization have crossed paths numerous times in 2018, with the Kickers playing three teams in the club's 'Path to the Pros' pathway. Steel FC is 2-0 against Richmond in USL play while the Kickers got past Reading United, from the PDL, in penalty kicks in the second round of the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup. The MLS-side defeated Richmond by a 5-0 scoreline in June in the fourth round in which Michee Ngalina made his Union debut.

FIRST DOOP IN THE ONION BAG FOR TRIO

While the club turned things around to finish July against Atlanta United 2, the match saw three players notch their first professional goals. Third round draft pick Aidan Apodaca earned his first tally in the first half while Faris and Brenden Aaronson put the match away with goals in the final 45. Aaronson's goal made him just the second active member of the Philadelphia Union Academy to score with Steel FC, joining Ben Ofeimu.

RECORD IN THE MIDST

With four assists collected in Sunday's match against Atlanta, Bethlehem Steel FC tied the club record for most assists in a single season. With 27 helpers in 2018, the same as 2017, the club has already had three more players grab an assist compared to last season.

STEEL FC SEEKS SWEEP OF KICKERS IN ROAD TRIP STARTER After finishing July with a franchise-tying four goals, Bethlehem Steel FC begins August with a road trip to Richmond looking for the season sweep of the Kickers. Steel FC dropped its Virginia-based opponent by a combined 7-2 margin the two previous meetings of 2018.

PREVIOUS MEETING

The two sides last met at Goodman Stadium in May with Steel FC overcoming an early Richmond goal for a 3-1 victory. After Heviel Cordovés opened the scoring in the 14th minute, Steel FC responded with a goal from Matt Real. The second half saw the home team pull away with a 63rd minute strike from Santi Moar while Chris Nanco converted from the penalty spot late in the contest.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On the win over Atlanta United 2...

"We were happy with the sustained pressure we were able to maintain in the Atlanta game at home. In fact, everything else kind of stemmed from that sustained pressure on the defensive side of it and that's something we have to try and replicate as we try and get three points out of each of the next couple games."

On Brenden Aaronson getting named to USL Team of the Week

"I think it's great and Brenden certainly deserved it because it wasn't just the goal and the assist, he was able to consistently find space and play forward and do all the things that we ask of our Number 10. A really promising performance but it's just a tiny microcosm of what we see over the course of six months to a year with him. He was good for us last year as a 16-year-old, now he's 17 and I look at him that same way I'd look at any of the pro players. He's adjusted to the level and I think he's very much part of our team for the rest of the season."

On changes made by Richmond since changing coaches

"There are a few players playing in different positions. Braeden Troyer for instance is playing as a holding midfielder at times when he didn't do as much of under Leigh [Cowlishaw]. They are building out of the back consistently which they didn't always do under the old coach. There have been a few adjustments and they are pressing a little higher up the field so there are changes. We haven't look at any older film because there have been adjustments made."

MATCH RECAP

Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 25-35-24 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his three seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 82 different starting XI combinations in 84 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 74 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.



Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.
