STEEL FC HEADS NORTH FOR SHOWDOWN WITH TORONTO FC II

Bethlehem Steel FC wraps up its busy four-match stretch in 13 days with a clash of MLS-affliates, battling Toronto FC II in a neutral site contest in Rochester, New York. Steel FC seeks to continue its USL Cup Playoff momentum in the midweek contest, sitting above the playoff line but has played the most matches in the Eastern Conference.

PREVIOUS MEETING

The two sides met late in 2017 with Steel FC offfense exploding for a 4-2 victory. Santi Moar bagged the quickest brace in club history, scoring two goals in three minutes to push Steel FC to a first-half lead. Steel FC added to the scoresheet with goals from Derrick Jones and Seku Conneh to round out the performance that pushed the club closer to its first USL Cup Playoff appearance.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

Looking back on the match against Pittsburgh

"We were really disappointed, I was disappointed even looking back at my own comments. I think we expected a lot of ourselves and we knew it was a big opportunity but we just didn't have the juice in our legs that were needed to play the way we wanted to play and accomplish what we were hoping to accomplish on that day. Really proud of the fact that we dug in and got ourselves back into the game and sorry that it broke down the way it did."

On preparing for Toronto FC II

"They've won two of their last three games and one of them was against Nashville. They only narrowly lost 1-0 to Pittsburgh in Pittsburgh in between there. They definitely are a dangerous team, a team that has turned the corner in terms of their mentality and in terms of their ability to keep games tight. We are well aware that we are up for a massive battle. Any road game is but especially a team with a belief, they present an entirely different challenge than how they were five or six weeks ago."

On playing at a neutral site and the challenges it presents "We're looking at it as their home game. We have to travel five and a half hours to get there, I don't think it's quite as bad for them. It's on turf which they play on a lot more frequently than we do. In a lot of ways, this is still their home game."

Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 27-36-24 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his three seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 85 different starting XI combinations in 87 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 74 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.



Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.




