MATCH NOTES

Weekly Storylines:

- Fury FC extended their unbeaten streak to five games going into Wednesday's match and have won three out of their last five games.
- Fury FC and goalkeeper Maxime Crépeau now have five consecutive clean sheets.
- Midfielder Kevin Oliveira's strike in just the 44th second of the game was Fury FC's fastest league play goal in club history.
- This will be Fury FC's second consecutive home game. They are 2W-2D-1L at TD Place this season.
- Toronto FC II have lost their last five games and are currently the only team in the Eastern Conference without a win.

Scouting Toronto FC II: They have a 0W-2D-9L record so far this season. They have a porous defence that has conceded 24 goals in their 11 games so far. They have let in 14 goals in their last five games. But they are also able to score goals and have managed to find the net 10 times this season. If they can find a way to plug the defence, they will be a threat. They are currently without a win and bottom of the Eastern Conference standings.

Head-to-Head: This will be the fourth time these two sides will have met in the USL. Fury FC have won two of those encounters while Toronto FC II have won one. The games have been low-scoring affairs with Fury FC's 2-0 win being the only time two goals were scored in a game between these two sides.

Injuries/Suspensions: Cristian Portilla: ribs (May 25 - Out 2-4 weeks); Jimmy-Shamar Sanon: international duty with Haiti; Gerardo Bruna: knee (May 22 - Questionable); Maxim Tissot: quadricep (March 26 - Questionable); Michael Salazar: leg (April 21 - Out 2-4 weeks); Shamit Shome: recalled to Montreal Impact.

MATCH PREVIEW

With every passing game and with every gritty performance, the believers are stacking up for Ottawa Fury FC. It will be a confident Fury FC team that will head into this mid-week battle with Toronto FC II. After an early stumble, the Ottawa side is producing one determined performance after the other helping the fans buy into the vision of the team. While Fury FC Head Coach Nikola Popovic had preached for patience from the fans and to see this as a long-term project from the get-go, he will be happy with the results that the team is already delivering.

Fury FC will head into their 11th game of the season on a high. They have been unbeaten in their last five games, having won three of those. Their defensive organisation and goalkeeper Maxime Crépeau have proved to be impenetrable with five consecutive clean sheets. The offence is also finding its teeth. In the last game, where they defeated top-of-the-table Bethlehem Steel FC 1-0, they had 14 shots on goal, which is the most they have had in a game this season. The team is functioning well as a unit with everyone eager to contribute: the five goals scored so far have come from five different players. In the last game it was the turn of Kevin Oliveira to put his name in the scoring charts. The midfielder did that in style by scoring just 44 seconds into the game. This is the fastest league play goal in Fury FC history.

The game against Toronto FC II will be Fury FC's second consecutive home game. They have lost just one game at TD Place this season and have been undefeated in the other four, having won two out of those encounters. They will be looking to add another W against their name this Wednesday. Their opponents are currently on a five-game losing streak and are currently the only team in the Eastern Conference, and one of the only two teams in the USL, to not have won a game so far this season.

Toronto FC II will be eager to start their recovery after an extremely sluggish start to the season. They have lost nine games and have conceded 24 goals so far. Their shaky defence let in 14 goals in the last five games. But they have also been able to score 10 goals and despite them being at the bottom of the Eastern Conference standings, Fury FC should be wary about such an opponent.

These two sides have met each other three times before in the USL with Fury FC having a 2W-0D-1L record in those games. The previous games have been low-scoring affairs but one suspects that this game could follow a different script.

This is the second of Fury FC's three-game home stand after which they will be on the road for a lengthy five-game span. They will be looking to maximise their home field advantage and continue their unbeaten run.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING

Head Coach Nikola Popovic

"We have to focus on the performance. It wasn't so bad when we were on the not so good run, but now it's not perfect, we still have a lot of things to work on. It is encouraging that we are getting better and better. Now we have to be consistent to continue like this: this [undefeated] run will mean nothing if we go back to our old ways."

On his quick goal last match... "I'm happy! I had been trying in many games before and the ball would not go, and this one came fast! But I'm most happy about the three points."
