# THE OWNER'S BOX

## STEVEN A. COHEN

### OWNER, CHAIRMAN AND CEO

- Steve Cohen is the chairman and majority owner of the New York Mets, Brooklyn Cyclones, Syracuse Mets and St. Lucie Mets. He bought the team in 2020 and is working on revamping the team's operations to help turn it into a perennial World Series contender with a first-class experience for Mets fans.
- Grew up in Great Neck, New York, where he would take the Long Island Railroad to Mets games and sit in the upper deck.
- Mr. Cohen is the founder, chairman and chief executive officer of Point72 Asset Management, an alternative investment firm with more than 1,600 employees around the globe. He founded S.A.C. Capital Advisors, the predecessor investment firm to Point72, in 1992. The Firm has built a reputation as an industry-leader in talent development, innovation and the use of alternative data analytics.
- In 2016, Mr. Cohen leveraged his lengthy career in the public markets to found Point72 Ventures, which focuses on early-stage investments in private companies in fintech, artificial intelligence and machine learning, enterprise technologies and digital healthcare.
- Mr. Cohen is also an avid philanthropist and has founded and holds active leadership roles in several nonprofit organizations.
- Mr. Cohen and his wife, Alexandra, founded the Steven & Alexandra Cohen Foundation in 2001. The Foundation is committed to achieving lasting and meaningful change through commitments to children's health, education, veterans, and the arts. He created Cohen Veterans Network and Cohen Veterans Bioscience in 2015 to improve the mental healthcare, treatment, and quality of life for veterans and their families.
- He serves on the Board of Trustees at the Museum of Contemporary Art (MOCA) in Los Angeles, the Emeritus Board of the Robin Hood Foundation, and the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) Board of Trustees.
- Mr. Cohen received a BS in economics from the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School. He began his investing career at Gruntal & Co. in New York, where he managed proprietary capital for 14 years before starting his own investment business.
- He currently lives with his wife in Greenwich, Connecticut. He has seven children and is an avid art collector.



## ALEXANDRA M. COHEN

*OWNER & PRESIDENT OF AMAZIN' METS FOUNDATION*

- Alexandra M. Cohen is the President of the Steven & Alexandra Cohen Foundation, the non-profit organization that she and her husband Steven cofounded in 2001.
- She directs strategic initiatives and leads the day-to-day operations of the Foundation, which is committed to inspiring philanthropy and community service by creating awareness, offering guidance and leading by example to show the world what giving can do.
- Over the past two decades, they have given more than \$958 million in gifts to organizations that improve children's healthcare and education, serve the underserved, support the arts, protect the environment, and further research in the areas of Lyme and tickborne disease and Psychedelics therapy. Their giving often reflects a personal connection with the causes and communities they support.
- Mrs. Cohen was born in Harlem, New York and grew up in Washington Heights. After studying Communications at New York's Manhattan College, she worked in the financial industry until she married Steven Cohen in 1992. Since then, Mrs. Cohen focused on raising her family and driving their philanthropic endeavors.
- Mrs. Cohen is a member of the Honorary Council of the Bob Woodruff Foundation and the New York Restoration Project Chairman's Council

*VICE CHAIRMAN*

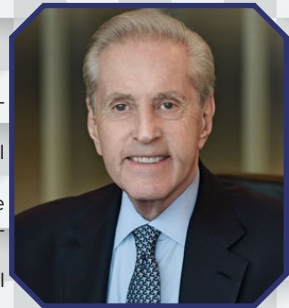
- Andrew B. Cohen is the Vice Chairman, member of the board of directors since 2012, and a minority owner of the New York Mets Baseball Club.
- He is the Chief Investment Officer and Co-Founder of Cohen Private Ventures which invests long-term capital, primarily in direct private investments and other opportunistic transactions, and manages family office activities, on behalf of Steven A. Cohen and his family.
- Prior to his position with Cohen Private Ventures, he was an Analyst and Portfolio Manager at the Firm from 2002 to 2005, investing in public equities and debt securities.
- Began his career at Morgan Stanley where he was an Analyst in the real estate department and principal investing group (MSREF) and then an Associate in the mergers and acquisitions group post business school.
- He is a member of the board of directors of several public and private companies.
- Received his B.A. from the University of Pennsylvania and his M.B.A. from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.
- Andrew resides in Manhattan with his wife and two children.

- Co-founder and Chairman of the Board of Sterling Equities, Inc., a real estate firm that is involved in the acquisition, development, ownership, operations and management of commercial, residential, industrial and retail properties throughout the United States.

# COACHING STAFF

## ED BLANKMEYER

### MANAGER

- Enters his second season in the organization...Was also slated to manage Brooklyn in 2020.
- Ran the Mets Alternate Training Site during the 2019 season after Kevin Boles was added to the Major League staff.
- Spent 24 seasons as the head of coach at St. John's University where he accumulated an all-time record of 829-500-4, making him the winningest coach in the program's history.
- In his coaching career has had over 130 players sign professional contract...Has coached 11 first round picks and seen 21 players play in the majors including Craig Biggio, Mo Vaughn, Matt Morris, John Valentin and Joe Panik.
- Guided the Red Storm to five BIG EAST Tournament titles, six BIG EAST regular season titles... During his tenure, the Red Storm made the NCAA Tournament 11 times, including one NCAA Super Regional appearance.
- Is the winningest coach in the history of BIG EAST play with 347 conference victories...Earned BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors a conference-record eight times and was named the ABCA Northeast Region Coach of the Year four times.
- Blankmeyer was a member of the USA Baseball coaching staff in 2010 helping the Collegiate National Team win the silver medal at the V FISU World University Baseball Championships in Tokyo, Japan...Blankmeyer also made coaching stints with USA Baseball in 2015, serving as manager of the Collegiate National Team in the summer and acting as an assistant coach for the Premier12 squad in the fall...Helped guide Team USA to a silver medal at the inaugural WBSC Premier12.
- Blankmeyer, 66, and his wife, Susan, reside in Convent Station, NJ...They have two daughters, Brittany Leigh and Alison Joy, and one son, Taylor Edward.



## MARIANO DUNCAN

### BENCH COACH

- Enters his third season in the organization...Served in the same role with Kingsport (R) in 2019.
- Spent the 2018 in the Detroit Tigers system, serving as the hitting coach for West Michigan (A).
- Previously spent eight seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization, serving as the hitting coach for the Triple-A Iowa (2017), hitting coach with Class-A Daytona/Myrtle Beach (2013-2016) and two seasons with Double-A Tennessee (2011-2012).
- Duncan began his coaching career with the Gulf Coast League Dodgers in 2003 and spent eight seasons in the Dodgers organization, serving as a coach with Triple-A Las Vegas (2005), Double-A Jacksonville (2004) and the first base coach for the Los Angeles Dodgers from 2006-2010.
- The former infielder played 12 Major League seasons with the Dodgers (1985-89), Reds (1989-91, 1995), Phillies (1992-95), Yankees (1996-97) and Blue Jays (1997).
- Duncan was a member of two World Series champions, the 1990 Cincinnati Reds and the 1996 New York Yankees.
- Inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008.

- Is in his first season as a coach with the Mets.
- Previously served as a pro scout with the Cubs from 2017-2020.
- Played parts of eight years in the Cubs, Phillies and Mets organizations from 2000-2007.
- Played parts of eight years in the Independent Atlantic, Northern and American Associations from 2008-2015.
- Resides in Prince George, VA.



**ROYCE RING**  
*PITCHING COACH*

- Is in his first year of his second stint as pitching coach for Brooklyn...Was slated for the same role with St. Lucie in 2020...Was Columbia's (A) pitching coach in 2019...Previously spent 2017-18 with Brooklyn (A)...Spent the 2016 season as the pitching coach at Kingsport (R).
- Spent the 2014 and 2015 seasons as the pitching coach with the Gulf Coast (R) Mets.
- Pitched for the Mets in 2005-2006, compiling an 0-2 record with a 3.47 ERA in 26 games.
- Played in the majors from 2005-2010 with the Mets, Braves, Padres and Yankees and had a 3-3 record with a 5.29 ERA...Spent 2011 in the minor leagues with Seattle and Boston before going to Colorado's organization in 2012...Played independent ball in 2013.
- Acquired by the Mets in 2003 along with pitcher Edwin Almonte and infielder Andrew Salvo from Chicago (AL) in a trade that sent Roberto Alomar to the White Sox.
- Selected in the first round (18th overall) by the White Sox in the June, 2002 First-Year Player Draft.
- Royce, 40, lives in Woodinville, Washington with his wife and two daughters.

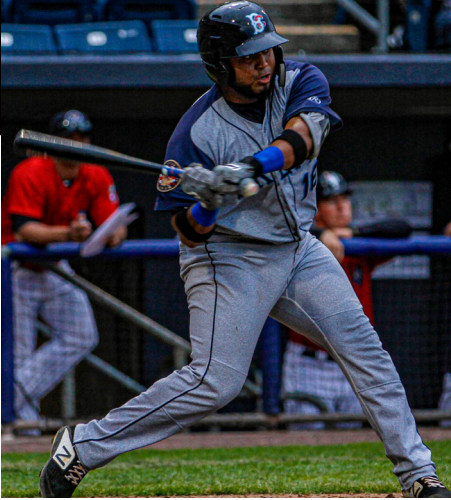

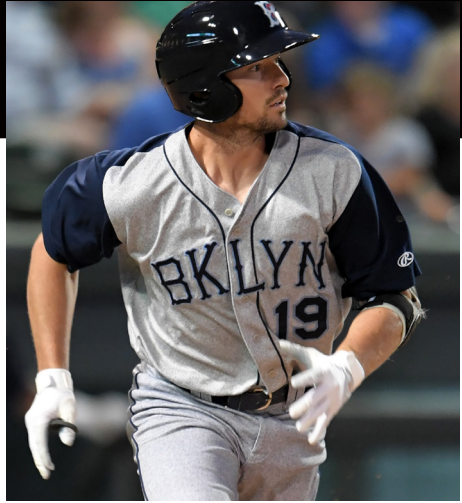

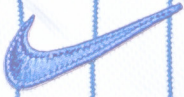
