

LAST GAME RECAP

The Texas AirHogs stalled Milkmen scoring for a second night. Milwaukee went hitless until the eighth inning, when Garrett Copeland got his 19th double of the year, which resulted to be the only hit.

Riley Pittman scored the Milkmen's only run off a balk in the eighth inning. Milwaukee finished with two men left on base and drawing two walks.

Milkmen starter, Jordan Kraus, took the loss on the night. He pitched 6 1/3 innings, allowing 7 hits, 3 runs, 2 walks and 5 strikeouts



PLRYER SPOTLIGHT

Jordan Kraus has been one of the Milkmen's top pitchers during this inaugural season. The Olmsted Falls, Ohio native and Wheeling Jesuit alumni currently holds the most wins of anyone on the team (and at time of writing is tied with former Milkmen pitcher T.J. House) with seven wins. This is all the more impressive when you consider Kraus initially started the season as a reliever. His numbers have been very consistent all season, which is fitting considering "consistent" is probably the very word his teammates would use to describe his style of play.

Kraus, like many of his teammates has seemingly been born and bred for baseball, first getting involved at a very young age through tee ball. Even though he hasn't pitched for any major league level clubs yet, Kraus has immense independent pro baseball experience in both the Pecos and Frontier Leagues. Kraus also has experience living in the Midwest, specifically around Cleveland, so living and playing in Milwaukee hasn't really been too difficult an adjustment.

Kraus says he can't envision what he would be doing or where he would be without professional baseball. He says that even after hanging up his mitt for the final time he will still be married to the game, although whether he would spend his post-playing days as a coach or something completely different he couldn't say, just that baseball was his career and life. Kraus doesn't model his game after anyone either, he is focused on being one of a kind and that copying someone else "takes away from what I do best, so I just try to remain unique, my own pitcher."

Kraus said he doesn't have what he considers special talents, but he does like to golf when not training on his off days.

Kraus says his future goals for his career like everyone else in the American Association all revolve around the opportunity to play affiliate ball and eventually make it on to a major league roster. Regardless of his future, on thing is clear about Jordan Kraus, he is a baseball lifer and no matter where he plays he will be dedicated to being at the top of his craft.
