GOLDEYES RIDE EARLY OFFENCE TO BEAT HOUSTON: The Winnipeg Goldeyes beat the Houston Apollos 13-7 at The Ballpark at Jackson on Friday night. Winnipeg took a 3-0 lead in the bottom of the first on a three-run home run from Kyle Martin. Jay Gonzalez, Tyler Hill, and Wes Darvill each had run-scoring hits in the second, while Max Murphy added an RBI groundout later in the inning to make it 7-0. Logan Hill led off the bottom of the third with a home run, and the Goldeyes stretched the lead to 9-0 when Gonzalez scored on a wild pitch. Houston rallied for five two-out runs in the top of the fourth, and had the tying run on deck in the top of the fifth before the Goldeyes re-extended the lead to 11-5 with a four-run bottom of the fifth. Winnipeg scored on a two-run double from Murphy, an Apollos' throwing error, and a Gonzalez sacrifice fly. Daniel Kubiuk was credited with the win in relief after pitching a scoreless top of the eighth. Mike Webb started and took a no-decision, allowing five earned runs on six hits over 4.2 innings. Webb walked three and struck out four.

ALL-TIME AGAINST THE APOLLOS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 1-0 all-time against the Houston Apollos, including a 1-0 record at The Ballpark at Jackson. The Apollos are playing as a traveling team to help fill out the American Association schedule in 2021. The league was left with an off number of teams with the addition of the Kane County Cougars and the loss of the St. Paul Saints and Texas AirHogs. The Apollos are largely comprised of Pecos League all-stars, and operate in similar fashion to the Salina Stockade traveling club the American Association hosted in 2017. The Apollos are managed by David Peterson who began his managerial career with the Stockade when they were members of the Pecos League in 2016. Peterson then managed the Stockade for a portion of the 2017 season in the American Association. The Apollos were members of the Pecos League in 2020, and their history dates back to 2002 when the club participated in various annual summer tournaments. Former Goldeyes' outfielder Breland Almadova is currently playing for the Apollos.

SERIES MATCHUP: The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 14-18, tied for fifth place in the American Association North Division, and 6.5 games behind the Milwaukee Milkmen. The Goldeyes just lost two of three to the Cleburne Railroaders at The Ballpark at Jackson. The Goldeyes are fourth in the American Association in hitting (.279), 10th in pitching (5.99), and third in fielding (.982). The Houston Apollos are 5-29, in sixth place in the South Division, and 18.0 games behind the Sioux City Explorers. The Apollos just lost two of three to the Sioux Falls Canaries at Sioux Falls Stadium. The Apollos are 12th in the league in batting (.237), 12th in pitching (8.27), and 12th in defence (.964). This is the first of two head-to-head series this season between Winnipeg and Houston.

TONIGHT'S STARTERS: In game one, the Goldeyes go with rookie right-hander Jorge Gonzalez who is 0-2 with a 5.76 ERA in six starts this season. Gonzalez took a no-decision at Kansas City on Sunday, allowing four earned runs on four hits in 5.1 innings. Gonzalez walked three and struck out five. The Monarchs won the game 9-8.

Prior to this season, Gonzalez last pitched in 2019 as a true rookie for the Pacific Association's San Rafael Pacifics. Gonzalez was 0-0 with a 3.75 ERA in one start and six relief appearances, striking out 19 batters in just 12.0 innings, and helped the Pacifics win the Pacific Association championship.

Gonzalez pitched collegiately at Texas A&M University, International where he was 1-2 with a 5.86 ERA in two starts and 17 relief appearances over 43.0 innings for the Dustdevils in 2017.

Gonzalez is in his second season of professional baseball, and is 0-2 lifetime with a 5.18 ERA in 13 games, seven of them as a starting pitcher.

Today will be Gonzalez's first career appearance against Houston. Gonzalez is 0-0 with a 4.00 ERA in two career starts at The Ballpark at Jackson.

The Goldeyes have not yet announced their starter for game two.

In game one, the Apollos go with left-hander Pierce Smith who will be making his Apollos' debut. Smith pitched for the Pecos League's Garden City Wind in 2019, going 3-0 with a 3.18 ERA in 14 relief appearances. Smith struck out 22 and walked nine in 17.0 innings.

Smith pitched two seasons at the University of Mississippi (Oxford, Mississippi) from 2018-19, appearing in two games. Smith also pitched at Chattahoochee Valley Community College (Phenix City, Alabama) and Darton State College (Albany, Georgia). At Darton State, Smith helped the Cavaliers reach the NJCAA World Series in 2016.

Today will be Smith's first career appearance against Winnipeg, as well as his first career appearance at The Ballpark at Jackson.

In game two, the Apollos go with right-hander Tucker Smith who is 1-1 with a 4.01 ERA in six starts this season. Smith took the loss at Cleburne last Sunday, allowing four runs, two earned, on eight hits in 6.0 innings. Smith walked none and struck out eight. Smith has allowed three or fewer earned runs in all six of his starts this season.

Smith is a true rookie who just completed his college career at Georgia Southwestern State University (Americus, Georgia). Smith was a combined 15-11 with a 2.51 ERA in 36 starts for the Hurricanes from 2018-21, striking out 215 batters in 250.2 collegiate innings.

Today will be Smith's first career appearance against Winnipeg, as well as his first career appearance at The Ballpark at Jackson.

TENNESSEE BOUND: Due to the ongoing closure of the Canada/US border, the Winnipeg Goldeyes have partnered with the Jackson Generals professional baseball club to host Winnipeg at The Ballpark at Jackson to begin the 2021 season. The Generals were a Double-A Southern League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, Seattle Mariners, and Arizona Diamondbacks from 1998-2019. The franchise hosted the Southern League All-Star Game on two occasions, and won four Southern League championships. The Generals are located in Jackson, Tennessee, which is 208 kilometres southwest of Nashville and 140 kilometres northeast of Memphis.

GOLDEYES ADD FORIEST: The Goldeyes signed left-handed pitcher Nathan Foriest on Thursday. Foriest made six relief appearances earlier this season for the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, as well as three appearances for the Atlantic League's West Virginia Power. Foriest was drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 35th round in 2015 out of Middle Tennessee State University (Murfreesboro, Tennessee), and has averaged 9.5 strikeouts per nine innings during five professional seasons.

COSTELLO REACQUIRED: The Goldeyes claimed catcher Zack Costello off waivers from the Kane County Cougars on Saturday. Costello appeared in 12 games for the Goldeyes earlier this season before he was released on June 7th.

MAD MAX: Goldeyes' outfielder Max Murphy set a career-high with five base hits on June 16th at Cleburne. Murphy had collected four hits in one game on seven previous occasions. The Goldeyes' record for hits in a single game is six, accomplished by Chad Thornhill (July 27, 1999 at Madison) and Andrew Sohn (July 15, 2017 vs. Kansas City).

TRIPLE THREAT: Goldeyes' infielder Kevin Lachance tied a franchise single-game record with two triples on June 16th at Cleburne. The record was last accomplished by Josh Romanski on July 2nd, 2016 vs. Sioux Falls.

DOUBLE DOWN: Following postponements last Tuesday and Wednesday, the Winnipeg Goldeyes now have 10 double headers that have either been played or remain on their 2021 schedule. The 10 double headers would set a franchise record. The Goldeyes played nine double headers during the 2009 season. The pandemic-shortened 2020 season ranks next with seven double headers.

EYES ON THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION: Since the start of training camp on May 6th, the American Association has sold the contracts of 44 players to Major League organizations. The Goldeyes have had four players picked up since then, including RHP Ryan Dull (Seattle Mariners), RHP Josh Lucas (Arizona Diamondbacks), IF Alexis Pantoja (Arizona Diamondbacks), and RHP Cory Thompson (St. Louis Cardinals).

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION BACK TO FULL STRENGTH: The American Association returns to 12 teams and a 100-game schedule in 2021. The league is split into two divisions, with the top two regular season winning percentages from each division qualifying for the postseason.

ROSTER RULES RETURN, ADJUSTED: After waiving all classification restrictions in 2020, the American Association returns to its traditional roster rules in 2021. Teams may carry up to 11 players classified as LS-4. Seven of those 11 may be LS-5 or higher, while five of them may be classified as veterans. Teams must carry at least five classified rookies on a full, 25-man roster (four rookies if carrying 22 players, or three rookies if carrying 21 players). The American Association recently announced that teams may carry up to 25 players for the entire 2021 season, up from 23 players in previous years.

GOLDEYES ENTER 28th SEASON: The Winnipeg Goldeyes enter their 28th season in 2021. The franchise brought professional baseball back to the city in 1994. The Goldeyes have finished with a winning record in 22 of their first 27 seasons. The Goldeyes have reached the postseason 19 times, and have won four championships (Northern League 1994, American Association 2012, 2016, 2017).

ALUMNI REPORT: RHP Brandon Kintzler (2007-08) is currently signed with the Philadelphia Phillies. Kintzler has pitched in the Major Leagues every season since 2010. RHP Brandon Marklund signed with the Goldeyes as a true rookie in 2019 before having his contract purchased by the Kansas City Royals. RHP Kent Hasler pitched for the Goldeyes in 2020 after the Goldeyes selected him from the Sioux City Explorers in the American Association dispersal draft. Hasler signed with the Milwaukee Brewers in May and was assigned to the Low-A East's Carolina Mudcats. RHP Josh Lucas was signed by the Arizona Diamondbacks in May after making three appearances for the Goldeyes at the end of 2020. Lucas is currently pitching for the Triple-A West's Reno Aces. Shortstop Alexis Pantoja signed with the Goldeyes in February of 2021, and also had his contract purchased by the Diamondbacks in May. Pantoja was assigned to the Double-A Central's Amarillo Sod Poodles. RHP Dylan Rheault (2016, 2020) recently signed as a free agent with the San Diego Padres, and was assigned to the Double-A Central's San Antonio Missions. RHP Frank Duncan (2020) was signed by the Colorado Rockies while a member of the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, and is currently pitching for the Double-A Northeast's Hartford Yard Goats. RHP Cory Thompson (2021) was signed by the St. Louis Cardinals on June 10th.
