Team Clubhouses


Home and Visiting team clubhouses are located in the lower level of the 601 Morris Street building. Proper credentials and passes are required for entrance into either clubhouse.

Ground Rules

- 1. Any batted or thrown ball that enters the dugout or strikes any equipment inside the dugout area is considered to be a dead ball and one base will be awarded.
- 2. Any thrown ball that strikes the protective screen in front of the dugouts will be considered a live ball. Should it enter the dugout area and return to the field of play or become lodged, it will be considered a dead ball and one base will be awarded.
- 3. Any batted or thrown ball that becomes lodged under either bullpen area bench is considered a dead ball.
- 4. Any batted or thrown ball that becomes lodged in the tarp or enters the tarp cylinder shall be considered a dead ball
- 5. No defensive player shall be permitted to place any footing on the tarp cylinder. A player may lean on the tarp.
- 6. A fairly batted or thrown ball lodged in the protective padding on the outfield wall shall result in two bases awarded.
- 7. A batted ball that hits the padding and bounces over the wall shall result in the awarding of two bases.
- 8. Any batted ball that becomes lodged in or beneath the outfield gate will be considered a dead ball and two bases shall be awarded
- 9. A fly ball that hits the yellow line on the outfield wall and then goes over the wall is a home run. A fly ball that hits the yellow line on the outfield wall and then goes back on the field is in play. Any ball that strikes a sign above the yellow line and returns to the field of play is deemed a home run.





Media Policies and Information

PRESS CREDENTIALS

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers are allowed in the camera wells on the field during games provided they have a proper field photo pass issued by the West Virginia Power on display. Any secondary use of any picture, audio description, film/tape or drawing of an event at Appalachian Power Park (including, but not limited to, the use in delayed editorial or non-editorial, advertising, sales promotion or merchandising) by a holder of a media pass is prohibited without prior specific written approval of the West Virginia Power Media Relations Department.

CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse and dugouts will be closed to all media one hour prior to all games and will reopen 10 minutes following the end of the game to those with proper credentials. At times, certain additional restrictions may be imposed. The training room, weight room, and players' lounge are closed to media at all times.

FIELD AND DUGOUTS

The playing field and dugouts must be clear of all media 30 minutes prior to game time and remain so until postgame unless otherwise instructed.

BALLPARK DESCRIPTION

All media members are required to reference the ballpark as "Appalachian Power Park" in all written and audiovisual produced pieces, as well as all social media posts from their media outlet. Anyone found in violation of this rule will be asked to make a correction to that specific journalism piece.

PRESS BOX

The press box is behind home plate with a room for media on the third base side.

INTERVIEWS

Pre-game interviews should be arranged prior to Power batting practice on game days. Post-game interviews are available 10 minutes after the game.

MEDIA NOTES AND GUIDES

Game information and statistics are available in the press box approximately two hours before game time. Anyone needing information earlier should contact the Media Relations department. Box scores are available in the press box postgame. Media guides will be provided upon request by a media relations rep.

David Berg - Manager

Berg, 48, is in his third season with the Mariners organization, and his first as a manager within Seattle's system. He spent the 2017 and 2018 seasons as the hitting coach for the Triple-A Tacoma Rainiers. However, the University of Miami product comes to West Virginia brimming with managerial experience, having held the manager role for six of his seven seasons in the Marlins coaching ranks, including two years in the South Atlantic League with the Greensboro Grasshoppers in 2012 and 2014. Berg was also the manager for short-season Jamestown (2010-2011) and Double-A Jacksonville (2015-2016).

then-Florida Marlins, Berg played five minor league seasons before making his MLB debut with the Marlins MLB Debut: April 2, 1998 (Marlins) on April 2, 1998, at that point becoming the lowest-ever Marlins draft pick to debut in the big leagues. The Roseville, Calif., native hit a career-best .313 during his rookie season in the Sunshine State. After a four-year stint with the Marlins, Berg signed with Toronto in 2002, driving in a MLB career-high 39 RBI in 109 games during his first year north of the border.

The infielder also spent time in the Red Sox and Rangers organizations before retiring following the 2006 season. He sports a career .269 MLB average in 582 games, while boasting a .288 clip in 665 MiLB contests. Berg joined the Marlins coaching ranks in 2010, and led his teams to winning seasons in three of his first four years as a manager. He currently resides in Roanoke, Texas.

Alon Leichman - Pitching Coach

Leichman is also in his third year amongst the Mariners' coaching ranks. The Israel native was the pitching coach for the DSL Mariners last season after spending 2017 as Seattle's Coordinator of Organizational Learning. Prior to coming to Seattle, Leichman led the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox of the Cape Cod Baseball League to a 2016 championship.

Before heading to the United States, Leichman was a member of the Israeli National Baseball team that competed in the European Baseball Championship in 2010, 2012 and 2016. To help his team reach the national tournament in 2016, Leichman hurled a complete game one-hit shutout in the C-Level qualifier in 2014. The UC-San Diego product represented his native country in the 2013 World Baseball Classic, but did not make an appearance, and also served as the team's bullpen coach during the 2017 WBC. Leichman was the first Israeli to represent his country at the MLB European Academy, which included MLB coaches such as Barry Larkin, Rod Carew, Lee Smith and Bruce Hurst. After coming to the States, College(s): Cypress College ('10-'13) Leichman went to Cypress College from 2010-2013, spending three years as a member of the baseball team, including a medical redshirt in 2011 due to

Tommy John surgery. He rebounded in 2013 to guide the Chargers to a CCCAA state title, including logging a complete game shutout to win the Super Regional in a spot start. Leichman then headed to San Diego, where he held a three-year stint as a Triton and earned his history degree. He led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances after posting a career 3.50 ERA in 122 innings with 85 strikeouts compared to 20 walks.

Eric Farris - Hitting Coach

Farris elevates to the Power from short-season Everett, where he was the team's hitting coach last season. Farris is in his third year in the Mariners organization as well, spending the 2017 campaign within the Mariners' Player Development and Scouting departments. Under Farris' tutelage last year, the AquaSox posted the third-best average (.253) and home runs (56) in the Northwest League, as well as totaling the fourth-most runs, hits, doubles and RBI.

A fourth-round choice by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2007 draft, the Arizona native spent six years with the Brewers, including making his MLB debut on July 28, 2011, after Rickie Weeks suffered a sprained left ankle. Farris played in 14 MLB games with Milwaukee between 2011 and 2012 before signing a minor league deal with the Minnesota Twins just prior to the start of the 2013 season. After three years in Minnesota, the infielder played one year with the independent Somerset Patriots in 2016 before announcing his retirement and joining the coaching ranks.

The Hamilton High School alumnus posted a career .281 average across 962 MLB Debut: July 28, 2011 (Brewers) MiLB games, 103 of which he spent with the Power in 2008. Farris hit .293 for West Virginia that season, smacking three home runs and bringing in 54 runs while swiping 32 bases in 42 tries. He is the 21st former Power player to make his MLB debut, and the fourth from the 2008 squad (Jonathan Lucroy, Zach Braddock and Eric Fryer). Farris had a banner 2009 campaign as well, earning Midseason and Postseason All-Star honors with Advanced-A Brevard County after boasting a .298 average with seven homers and 49 RBI and stealing 70 bases in 76 attempts. Farris attended college at Loyola Marymount after declining a 42nd-round selection by the Atlanta Braves in 2004.

Gallagher joins the Power as the team's Athletic Trainer after holding the same title in Everett in 2018. The Olympia, Wash., native came to Seattle in 2018 after earning a Masters of Science in Kinesiology at the University of Mary. He also graduated undergrad from the University of Mary with a Bachelor of Science in Athletic Training and a Minor in Wellness. He was a part of the Marauders' Athletic Training staff as a Graduate Assistant Athletic Trainer while he pursued his Masters.

Childs enters his fourth season as a Performance Specialist with the Mariners, also coming to the Power from the AquaSox. The Greenville, S.C., native played college baseball at Lander University and Wingate University before securing his Masters Degree at Appalachian State University in Exercise Science with a concentration in Strength and Conditioning. Childs was previously a strength and conditioning coach at Appalachian State, Clemson and Lander University.







2018 West Virginia Power Season Recap

After starting the season off slowly, the Power rounded into form on the road in the middle of April. The Pirates affiliate left Appalachian Power Park for Hickory, N.C., sporting a 3-4 record, but the Power found

themselves victorious in seven of their ensuing eight games thanks to three consecutive series wins. Two wins from lefty Braeden Ogle bolstered these victories that moved West Virginia from fourth to second place in the Northern Division standings.

Calvin Mitchell led the early charge for West Virginia, getting a hit in 20 of his first 22 games for the Power, including his first six and a stretch of 13 consecutive from April 14 to April 27.

As the calendar moved from April to May, the Power's five-man rotation grew murky. Ogle, Travis MacGregor and Sergio Cubilete

were all sent to the disabled list, prompting a big shake-up that led to Evan Piechota and Hunter Stratton moving from the bullpen to the starting five. In addition to that, West Virginia called up prospect arms Max Kranick and Cody Bolton to help fill out the 25-man roster.

The team kept right on rolling in the early portion of May, ripping off six straight wins against Hickory, Hagerstown and Lakewood that included their first sweep of the season when they broomed the Suns from May 9-11. However, their good fortune did not last long, as West Virginia then fell in 12 of its next 17 ballgames as the season worked its way towards June.

The Power headed into the final month of the first half with a 25-23 record after having three straight games rained out against Lexington, but then the team went on a tear. From June 5 to the end of the first half, West Virginia claimed 11 of its final 15 match-ups.

The team's hot June could not move them past the Kannapolis Intimidators. The team finished the first half 2.5 games behind the Lakewood BlueClaws for first place in the Northern Division and just a half game back of the Intimidators for second place.

After missing out on a first half Northern Division title despite a 37-29 record, the Power surged out of the gates in the second half, blowing by the Crawdads in a three-game series at L.P. Frans Stadium. In that three-game sweep, West Virginia outscored Hickory 22-11 and completed their third brooming of the season.

The team, however, fell on hard times as the calendar turned to July. The Power did not win a series until their final set of the month against the Asheville Tourists, in large part due to the fact that they were 6-17 through 23 July contests before a late turnaround. The worst part of that stretch came on the club's final road trip of the season, when West Virginia went winless in seven games against eventual playoff teams Lexington and Kannapolis from July 19-26. At that point, the Power had dropped eight straight road contests and went winless in a multi-series road trip for the first time since the inaugural seven games in Power history in 2005.



Following a 4-1 finish to July, the Power soared into August and played like a team on a mission. West Virginia did not lose a series in the entire month and rode a 16-11 record towards a potential postseason berth that was in the cards until the final day of the season.

Heading into August 15 and the start of West Virginia's final multi-series homestand, the Power sat 1.5 games behind Kannapolis in the Northern Division Wild Card standings with 19 games to play. West Virginia won 10 of its next 14 games. All that remained was four games against the sub-.500 Charleston RiverDogs. West Virginia needed to win at least two to clinch their first playoff berth since

2015. Unfortunately, that never materialized. Charleston took three of the four games and put an end to the Power's season on the final day.

The Power finished the 2018 season 71-62 thanks to a 34-33 second-half mark, sitting nine games above .500 at years end. The Power registered a winning record of at least nine games above .500 for the first time since 2015 and the sixth time in Power history (2005-present). Four of the previous five teams made the postseason (The 2006 club did not). And as for the 2018 club, they were once again left wondering what might have been.
