Team Clubhouses

Home and Visiting team clubhouses are located in the lower level of the 601 Morris Street building. Proper credentials and passes are required for entrance into either clubhouse.

Appalachian Power Park

Ground Rules

1. Any batted or thrown ball that enters the dugout or strikes any equipment inside the dugout area is considered to be a dead ball and one base will be awarded.
2. Any thrown ball that strikes the protective screen in front of the dugouts will be considered a live ball. Should it enter the dugout area and return to the field of play or become lodged it will be considered a dead ball and one base will be awarded.
3. Any batted or thrown ball that becomes lodged under a bullpen area bench is considered to be a dead ball.
4. Any batted or thrown ball that becomes lodged in the tarp or enters the tarp cylinder shall be considered a dead ball
5. No defensive player shall be permitted to place any footing on the tarp or tarp cylinder. A player may lean on the tarp.
6. A fairly batted or thrown ball lodged in the protective padding on the outfield wall shall result in two bases awarded.
7. A batted ball that hits the padding and bounces over the wall shall result in two bases awarded.
8. Any batted ball that becomes lodged in or beneath the outfield gate will be considered a dead ball and two bases shall be awarded
9. A fly ball that hits the yellow line on the outfield wall and then goes over the wall is a home run. A fly ball that hits the yellow line on the outfield wall and then goes back on the field is in play. Any ball that strikes a sign above the yellow line and returns to the field of play is deemed a home run.

Media Policies and Information

PRESS CREDENTIALS

Press credentials will be issued only to accredited members of the media. Requests should be mailed, faxed or emailed on company letterhead to West Virginia Power Media Relations, 601 Morris St.- Suite 201, Charleston, WV, 25301, faxed to 304-344-0083 or emailed to dkahn@wvpower.com.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers are allowed in the camera wells on the field during games provided they have on display a proper field photo pass issued by the West Virginia Power. Any secondary use of any picture, audio description, film/tape or drawing of an event at Appalachian Power Park (including, but not limited to, the use in delayed editorial or non-editorial, advertising, sales promotion or merchandising) by a holder of a media pass is prohibited without prior specific written approval of the West Virginia Power.

CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse and dugouts will be closed to all media one hour prior to all games and will reopen 10 minutes following the end of the game to those with proper credentials. At times, certain additional restrictions may be imposed. The training room, weight room, and players' lounge are closed to media at all times.

FIELD AND DUGOUTS

The playing field and dugouts must be clear of all media representatives 30 minutes prior to game time and remain so until after the game unless otherwise instructed.

PRESS BOX

The press box is behind home plate with a room for media on the third base side.

INTERVIEWS

Pre-game interviews should be arranged prior to and following Power batting practice on game and practice days. Post-game interviews are available 10 minutes after the game.

MEDIA NOTES

Game information and statistics are available in the press box approximately two hours before game time. Anyone needing information earlier should contact the media relations department. Box scores and play-by-play sheets are available in the press box after the game.

Wyatt Toregas - Manager

After guiding the Power to a 69-67 record in 2017, Toregas returns to the helm in Charleston for 2018. Prior to joining the Power last season, the 35-year-old spent two seasons as the first-ever manager of the West Virginia Black Bears, the Pittsburgh Pirates' short-season affiliate in the New York-Penn League. In the club's inaugural campaign after relocating from Jamestown in 2015, Toregas led the Black Bears to the NYPL title. Through three years as a skipper, the Virginia Tech product boasts a 149-139 mark. Toregas embarked on his coaching career in 2011, when he became the first base coach for the Indianapolis Indians, the Pirates' Triple-A affiliate.



Toregas played eight seasons professionally (2004-2011) with the Cleveland Indians and Pirates. The Fairfax, Virginia, native was drafted in the 24th round of the 2004 MLB Draft following three successful seasons as a Hokie, where he sported a .316 batting average with 22 home runs and 150 RBI in 167 games. Throughout his eight-year playing career, Toregas competed in 22 contests at the Major League level.

Born on December 2, 1982, Toregas currently resides in Ashburn, Virginia, with his wife Holly and two children, Ava and Alexander. He is a member of Chickasaw Nation, a Native American nation located in Oklahoma. His heritage comes from his grandmother, Jalna Wenonah "Maw" Wolf Toregas, who was an actress and ballroom dancer. She lived to be 103 years old.

Joel Hanrahan - Pitching Coach

Joel Hanrahan makes his Power coaching debut in 2018, jumping up from Morgantown where he spent last season as an assistant pitching coach with the West Virginia Black Bears. In 2017, the 36-year-old helped the pitching staff to a 3.32 ERA, good for sixth-best in the New York-Penn League, led by Scooter Hightower, who finished with a 1.94 mark through 88 innings, both second-best amongst the league's talented arms.

Born in Des Moines, Iowa, Hanrahan chose to forgo a scholarship to play baseball at the University of Nebraska, and instead was selected in the second round (57th overall) in 2000 by the Los Angeles Dodgers. The two-time All-Star never cracked the bigs with the Dodgers, instead making his MLB debut in 2007 with the Washington Nationals. The journeyman also had stints with the Boston Red Sox, Pirates and Detroit Tigers before retiring in 2016 after several Tommy John surgeries prohibited him from making another MLB appearance.

Chris Petersen - Hitting Coach

Chris Petersen is also a newcomer to the Power in 2018. Petersen previously coached the 10U Vipers Travel Ball team in Sarasota, where he currently resides. The Boston native was selected in the ninth round of the 1992 draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Georgia Southern University. Throughout his 13-year career, Petersen ascended to the Majors for a seven-game stretch in 1999 during his tenure with the Colorado Rockies. He also logged time for the Atlanta Braves, Pirates and Arizona Diamondbacks. Petersen competed in the 1990 College World Series with Georgia Southern, as the 5th-seeded Panthers emerged from the Midwest Regional to advance to Omaha.

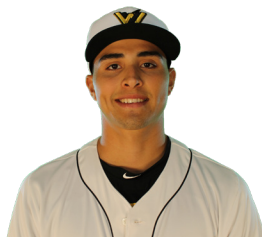


Power Community Commitment Program

2017 West Virginia Power Season Recap

The West Virginia Power spent the summer of 2017 fighting tooth and nail for a South Atlantic League playoff berth. The 136 game season took nearly every twist and turn that one could possibly think of as it continued the old adage that 'It's not about the destination. It's about the journey.'

The initial Power roster had two top-30 prospects in shortstop Stephen Alemais and pitcher Luis Escobar, with just over half of the 25-man roster familiar with new Power skipper Wyatt Toregas, who was at the helm of the West Virginia Black Bears in 2016.

After Opening Day was rained out, the Power lost seven of their first eight contests, but began climbing back by winning six straight road games against Lexington and Hickory, a stretch highlighted by grand slams from Alexis Bastardo and Carlos Munoz.



Despite an 11-14 April mark, a few Power players shined in the season's first month, including Ty Moore, who tallied hits in his first 11 games and stroked a .377 clip during April, while Trae Arbet led the team with four home runs and hit .303.

The Power finally snatched their first home series win in May by taking two of three from the Crawdads, but Mother Nature reared its ugly head for the rest of the month, cancelling a three-game series in Augusta due to rain or unplayable grounds. It marked the first time in the franchise's history that an entire series was cancelled. The club's 13-11 record in May was boosted by the resurgence of Albert Baur, who reached safely in his first 31 games of the season, a new franchise record.

The Power finished the first half of the season with a 30-36 record and in fifth place in the Northern Division, eight games off the pace, but had four players tabbed as first-half All-Stars: Arbet, Moore, Jordan Jess and Cam Vieaux. On July 15, Escobar represented the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 2017 SiriusXM Futures Game at Marlins Park in Florida. The 21-year-old threw a scoreless inning with one walk during his outing.

While Escobar was shining on a prominent platform, the Power descended in the second half, dropping 9 of 14 games to open July to put themselves 11 games under .500.

However, the Power soon turned things around, especially at Appalachian Power Park, where they ripped off a 13-game home winning streak from July 17 to August 17, matching the franchise record set in 2013.

Their 19-10 August stretch moved the team into a tie for first place. Unfortunately, despite being winners in 22 of their final 34 games, the Power's playoff hopes were dashed in the final game of the regular season when Greensboro defeated Hickory 2-1 to edge out West Virginia by .002 in winning percentage.

West Virginia went 39-31 in the second half of the season and finished the campaign at 69-67. The Power closed the season with a .256 team batting average, fifth-best in the league. Baur led the Power with a .298 batting average and 65 runs batted in, while Hunter Owen and Adrian Valerio paced the team with 11 home runs apiece. Garrett Brown finished the season with a team-high 14 stolen bases.



The Power pitching staff completed the season with a 3.62 ERA, seventh-best in the 14-team league. Eduardo Vera, a reliever-turned-starting pitcher, led the team with a 3.33 earned run average. Escobar ended the season with 168 strikeouts, eclipsing Tyler Glasnow's mark of 164 in 2013. The right-hander also led the club with ten wins.

Off the field, West Virginia players participated in the Pirates Community Commitment Program, spending 372 hours volunteering over the course of the season. Vera was honored with the Pirates Community Commitment Award for most outstanding service on the Power roster after contributing over 30 hours to the Charleston community throughout the year.

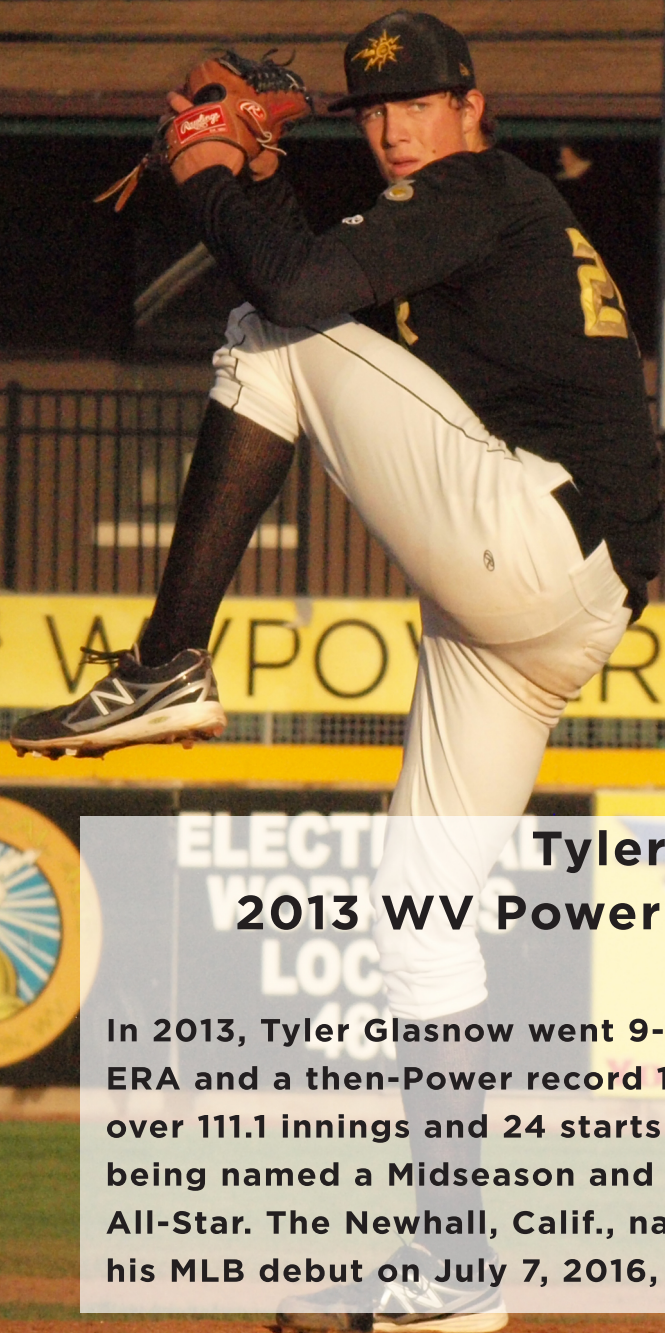
