Meet the Joliet Slammers

The Joliet Slammers enter the 2013 season under new ownership. Joliet Community Baseball and Entertainment, LLC is led by CEO Josh Schaub (pictured at top with Joliet City Manager Tom Thanas), an attorney and associate scout for the Milwaukee Brewers and Treasurer Nick Semaca, a Director with global consulting firm McKinsey and Company.

Joliet native Chris Franklin (second picture on the right) returned to Silver Cross Field in November to be named General Manager. After working for the Joliet JackHammers during the 2006 season, Franklin followed then General Manager, Steve Malliet to work five and a half years with the River City Rascals of the Frontier League. Franklin served three of those years as the Rascals General Manager, reaching the Frontier League championship series in all three years and winning the title in 2010.

Former Frontier League *Coach of The Year* Mike Breyman reunited with Franklin in January as he was named the Slammers new Field Manager. Breyman served on the Rascals coaching staff during the 2010 and 2011 seasons as their Hitting Coach. Breyman brings with him a wealth of knowledge and success in the Frontier League both as a player and as a coach. He most recently helped lead the Gateway Grizzlies to the Frontier League playoffs in 2012 as their Hitting Coach.

J.L. Bird and Spikes, the Slammers mascots, are always looking for ways to support Joliet and its surrounding communities.

Professional Baseball - Joliet Slammers (51 regular season, 2 exhibition, and playoffs)

The Joliet Slammers are members of the Frontier League of Professional Baseball. The Frontier League is the oldest continuously operating independent professional league, entering its 21st season in 2013.

College Baseball - University of St. Francis (15 spring and 10 fall)

Silver Cross Field plays home to the "Fighting Saints" men's baseball team. The Saints are members of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) and the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC).

High School Baseball (Over 20 high school baseball games)

For the seventh consecutive year, Silver Cross Field will play host to the Illinois High School Association (IHSA) boys State Baseball Championships (3A & 4A). Over 8,000 fans attended the 2012 games.

Other area high schools that will play this spring at Silver Cross Field including Joliet Central, Joliet West, Joliet Catholic Academy, Lockport, Providence Catholic, Herscher, Minooka, Plainfield Central, Plainfield South, Lemont, and more.
