Manager: Omar Ramirez

Chukars are game birds that typically fly together in a team. The Idaho Falls Chukars are a team that comes together to play a game. Both types of Chukars need leaders. Idaho Falls has Manager Omar Ramirez.

Omar Ramirez will be the skipper at Idaho Falls for a second season after serving as the Chukars' hitting coach in 2011. In his first season as manager, the Chukars finished in a tie for third place in the South Division. The 35 wins were the most for Idaho Falls since the 2009 season. As the hitting coach, the Chukars finished second in the Pioneer League in batting average.

The second year manager anticipates another thrilling season. "We will be an exciting team to watch," Omar Ramirez added, "Especially in the middle." The Chukars have been in the top half of the Pioneer League in attendance each of the past four seasons.

Omar Ramirez was the hitting coach at Burlington (R) in 2009 and Burlington (A) in 2010. Ramirez, the Indians' 31st round pick in 1990 out of Hill Junior College in Texas, played outfield for eight seasons in the minors with the Indians and Astros before retiring following the 2001 season. Ramirez resides in his hometown of Santiago, Dominican Republic.

Hitting Coach: Damon Hollins

Damon Hollins is in his fourth season with the Royals as a hitting coach, his first at Idaho Falls. He began his coaching career in the same capacity at Burlington (R) in 2010, then coached at Kane County in 2011 and Wilmington in 2012. Hollins, a fourth-round selection by Atlanta in 1992, played in the Majors for the Braves (1998, 2004), Dodgers (1998) and Rays (2005-06). He spent the 2007 season in Japan with the Yomiuri Giants before playing for the Omaha Royals in 2008. Hollins resides in Litchfield Park, Ariz., with his wife, Patrice. They have three children, Tahari, Ameerah, and Averi.

Pitching Coach: Steve Merriman

Steve Merriman joins the Royals organization from the University of Michigan, where he was the pitching coach in 2012. The stint was the third at Michigan for Merriman, who was the Wolverines' hitting coach in 1995 and the pitching coach/recruiting coordinator in 2002. Merriman coached in the Mets organization from 2004-06 and in the Diamondbacks organization from 2007-09. He worked for the Major League Scouting Bureau from 2009 to 2011, serving as an area scout in the midwest. Merriman also spent time as an associate scout for the Colorado Rockies (2002-2004) and was a bullpen catcher and bullpen practice pitcher for the Detroit Tigers (1996-99). The resident of Wyoming, Mich., holds a bachelor's of science in education from Central Michigan and a master's of education in sports administration from Wayne State.

Athletic Trainer: Robbie Oates

Robbie Oates begins his first professional season with the Royals as the trainer in Idaho Falls. Oates spent last season as an athletic training intern with the Major League club in Kansas City. Oates earned his bachelor of science in athletic training from Wilmington College in Wilmington, Ohio. He was born and raised in Mansfield, Ohio, where he lives today.

Strength & Conditioning Coach: Henry Torres III

Henry Torres III enters his first season in the organization as a strength and conditioning coach. His previous experience includes a summer internship at All Sports Speed and Conditioning with former NFL player BayBay McClinton, where he trained collegiate and professional athletes from various sports. Torres also held the position of student assistant strength and conditioning coach with the University of Texas at San Antonio football and baseball programs. As a member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, he also mentored several members of the UTSA baseball team. A 2012 graduate of UTSA, Torres earned a bachelor's of science degree in kinesiology with a specialization in exercise science. He currently resides in San Antonio, Texas.
