2019 Staten Island Yankees Media Policies

MEDIA INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

Media Credentials for the Staten Island Yankees home games at Richmond County Bank Ballpark are available upon request. Season credentials will only be issued to legitimate news gathering organizations that cover the Staten Island Yankees on a daily basis. Those denied a season media credential can apply for a daily credential.

Please complete the Staten Island Yankees media credential application, which can be downloaded on SIYanks.com. It includes the Minor League Baseball Terms and Conditions of Credentials for Minor League Baseball Events form. Completion of the media credential request does not guarantee credentials will be issued. All requests will be reviewed by the Staten Island Yankees media department. Under no circumstances are media credentials to be transferred from person to person without the express permission and approval by the Staten Island Yankees media department. Failure to do so could lead to dismissal of the media member from Richmond County Bank Ballpark and the confiscation of the individual/organization's media credential. All credential applications can be sent to Michael Galayda at mgalayda@siyanks.com.

Daily credentials will be issued to those individuals or organizations who do not qualify for season credentials or for those who want to cover a certain game/event at Richmond County Bank Ballpark. The Staten Island Yankees require at least a 48-hour notice for all daily credential requests. All weekend request must be made by the prior Thursday.

Approved media credentials can be picked up at our Main Box Office window at the corner of Wall Street and Richmond Terrace during normal business hours, daily media credentials must be picked up on the day of the game. A valid Photo ID will be required upon pickup.

PARKING

If you plan to drive to Richmond County Bank Ballpark you can park at the Impark New York Wheel Parking Garage. (155 Richmond Terrace, Staten Island, NY 10301) Parking is \$8 on non-game days and \$6 during Staten Island Yankees games.

FIELD ACCESS

Appropriately credentialed media are permitted access to the field and dugout areas, but are required to stay on the warning track, particularly when the team is taking batting practice. During the game, only permitted photographers can have access to the photo wells in the dugout. Any non-permitted photographers found in the photo wells will be removed from the stadium with the possibility of having their credentials revoked.



GAME DAY INFORMATION

Game day information, including Game Notes, Stat Packs, and more will be available in the press box prior to every home game. The 2019 Staten Island Yankees Media Guide is available on SIYanks.com

MEDIA INTERVIEWS

Staten Island Yankees' players and coaches will be available for interviews, pre-game, after batting practice for 45 minutes (home games only).

Anyone found mulling around the locker room, or in the locker room after the 45 minutes is up, will be removed from the ballpark and have their credential revoked. About 10-15 minutes after the game has concluded coaches and players will be available for interviews. All approved credentialed must speak to the manager/coaches before they speak to the players. Media wishing to conduct an off-site interview, a featured story, or a phone interview should contact the Staten Island Yankees 72 hours prior to the interview time. No one will be permitted to interview the starting pitchers pre-game on the day of their start. To make an interview request please contact Michael Galayda at mgalayda@siyanks.com.

AUTOGRAPH POLICY

Under no circumstances are credentialed media permitted to ask players or coaches for autographs, whether it be on the field or in the clubhouse. Violation of this policy will result in the dismissal of the media member from the ballpark and confiscation of the violator's media credential.

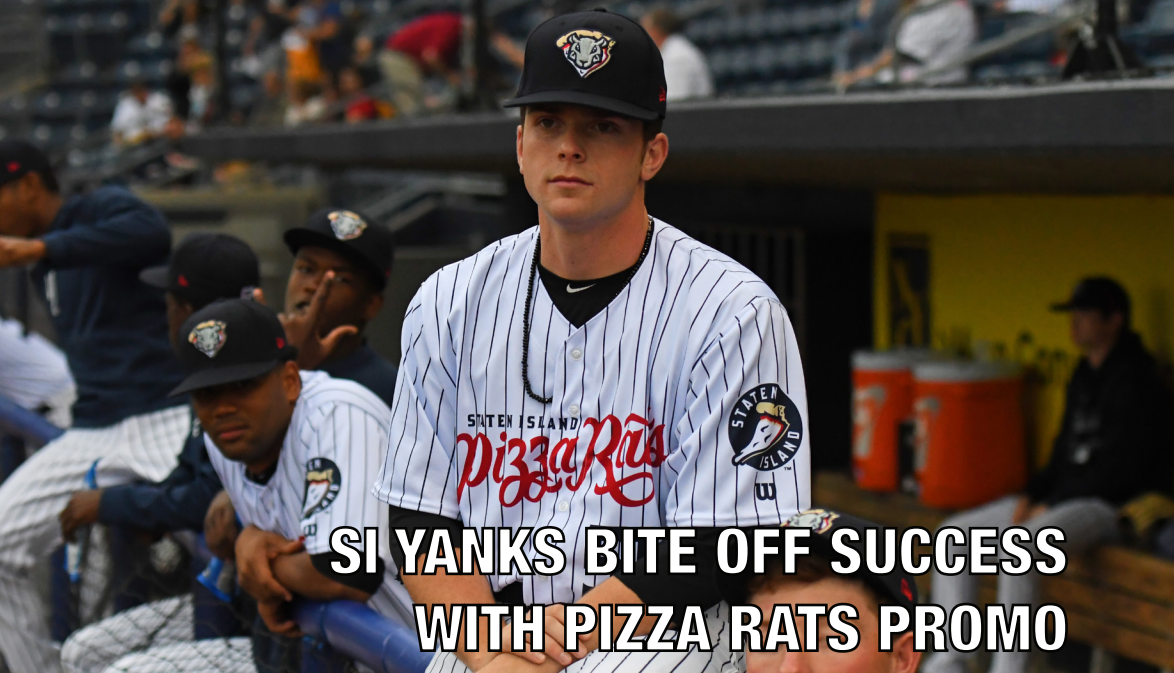

Without a doubt, the Staten Island Yankees bitten off success last season with their “Pizza Rats” promotion. Earning nation-wide notoriety for the promotion that saw the team adopt the moniker for every Saturday home game.

Born out of a 2016 attempt to rename the team permanently: famed design firm Brandiose designed the logos. After going through 2,000 entries, the Yankees narrowed down the possible names to five options including Heroes, Pizza Rats, Bridge Trolls, Rock Pigeons and Killer Bees.



The unusual name drew press coverage from all over including Sports Illustrated, ESPN, FOX News, MLB, Cheddar, and more. The name took the internet by storm, with over 96% of posts online being positive.

“We thought the Pizza Rats brand was fun and unique when we were in the planning stages, but when we announced it last year, it took off like we never imagined,” said Staten Island Yankees President/Operating Partner Will Smith.

Just how popular was the promotion? The Staten Island Pizza Rats hats were among the top selling hats in all Minor League Baseball. The team sold more 500% more Pizza Rats merchandise than all the merchandise they sold the year before in just the first two days alone. Overall, merchandise sales increased by over 1,000% in the previous season.

The ever-popular Pizza Rats promotion is returning for the 2019 season as once again on Saturday games they will take the field beginning on opening night. The team will take the field in new red uniforms, different caps, and a new food item will be on the menu. During every Saturday game, Chank’s Pizza Cones will be available, giving fans pizza on-the-go without the mess.

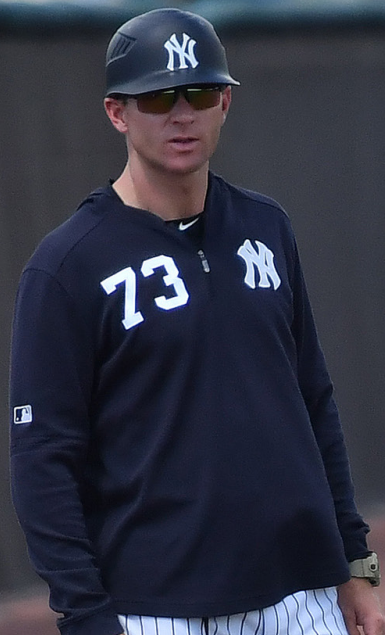


The second season of Pizza Rats baseball is already off to a delicious start with fresh, hot merchandise in the team store and sure to be just as popular this year as last.

BORN: 5/15/87 in Margate, Fla. **RESIDES:** Odessa, Fla.

COACHING CAREER: In his third season with the Yankees organization and his first with Staten Island... made his managerial debut last season with the GCL Yankees West, owning a 25-27 record... made his debut in 2017 as the defensive coach for the GCL Yankees East.

PLAYING CAREER: Was selected by the Yankees in the third round of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft... appeared in 43 Major League games for the Yankees in 2013... made his Major League debut on 5/15/13, becoming the first Yankee to debut on his birthday... over nine minor league seasons with the Yankees (2008-13), Orioles (2014), Marlins (2015) and Blue Jays (2016), batted .282 (707-for-2507) with 347R, 167 doubles, 22 triples, 45HR and 341RBI in 701 games.

PERSONAL: He and his wife, Camille, have two sons, Jethro and Brooks... attended the University of Virginia, where he was named to the Baseball America Freshman All-America Second Team and a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American.

COACHING CAREER: Enters his fourth season with Staten Island and the organization... last season, SI pitchers logged an organizational-low 2.60 ERA... in 2017, Staten Island pitchers led the New York-Penn League with a 2.64 ERA, which led U.S.-based minor league teams and represented the team's best ERA since 2009 (2.53)... led the league in shutouts (11), the most in the NYPL since 2010 (Auburn, 12)... his 2016 staff finished third in the New York-Penn League with a 2.82 ERA and tied for the lead with 10 shutouts... prior to joining the Yankees organization, served as the head coach for St. Petersburg H.S. (Fla.) for three seasons (2011-14) and operated a baseball training facility in the Tampa Bay area.

PLAYING CAREER: Was selected by Tampa Bay in the 89th round of the 1996 First-Year Player Draft... is the latest-round draft pick to reach the Majors, surpassing Pulaski hitting coach Scott Seabol, selected three picks before him by the Yankees in the 88th round of the same draft... in three Major League seasons with the Devil Rays (2001-02) and Brewers (2004), was 3-5 with a 4.34 ERA and five saves over 79 relief appearances... pitched 11 minor league seasons in the Devil Rays, Braves, Brewers, Rockies, Cubs, Reds and Astros organizations, before rounding out his career with two years (2008-09) with York of the independent Atlantic League

PERSONAL: He and his wife, Erin, have two children: Emerson and Anderson... pitched two seasons at Crowder College (Mo.)... graduated from Wheaton H.S. (Mo.).

Va.) in 2004 and Single-A Lansing from 2005-06... was a hitting coach at Rookie-level Medicine Hat (2002), Double-A New Haven (2003), Double-A New Hampshire (2007-08) and Triple-A Las Vegas (2009)... began his coaching career with six seasons in the Marlins organization, starting as the bullpen coach at Double-A Portland (1994-95) and continuing as Portland's hitting coach in 1996... spent three seasons at short-season Single-A Utica as the hitting coach (1997) and the manager (1998-99)... also coached in the independent leagues with Catskill (2000) and Adirondack (2001).

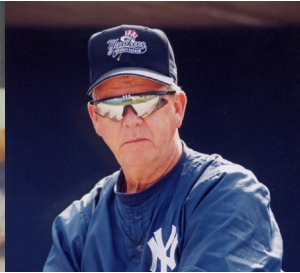

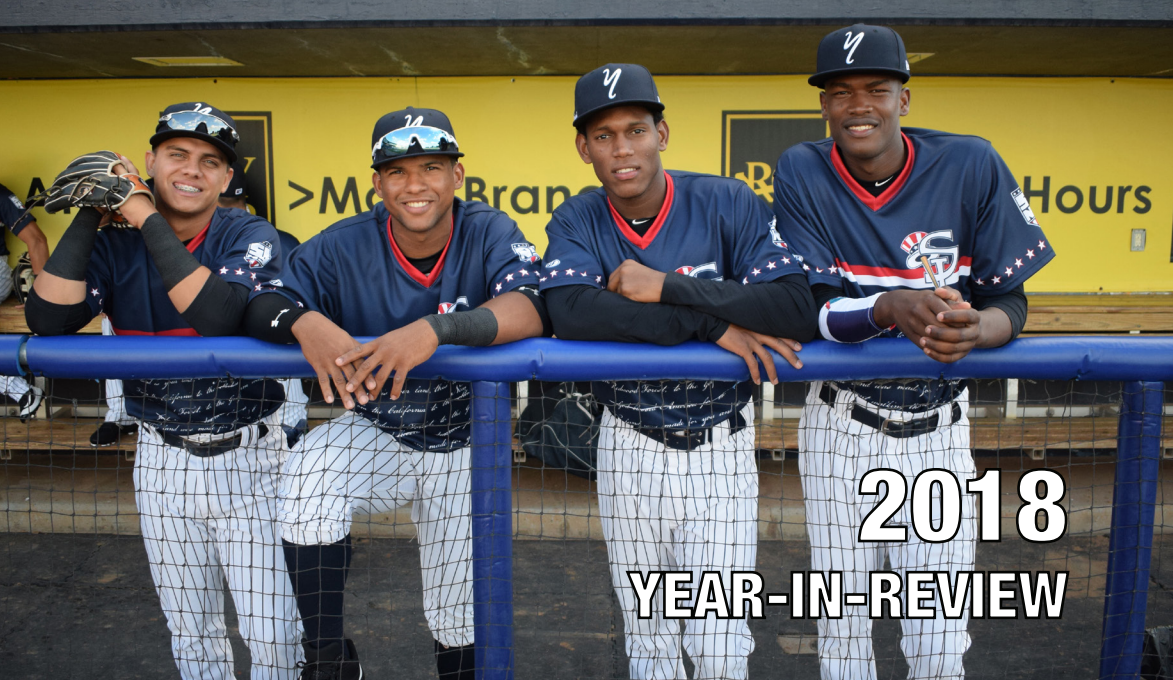

YEAR-IN-REVIEW
2019



The 2018 season did not bring a championship or playoff berth for the Staten Island Yankees. But the season was not without positives. Despite a slow start, the Yankees were in playoff contention up until the end of the season.

Staten Island started the season going 4-11 in June with losses to the Brooklyn Cyclones, Lowell Spinners, Aberdeen IronBirds, Tri-City Valley Cats, and Connecticut Tigers.

Thanks to stellar pitching the Staten Island Yankees turned their season around. The team was defined by the stellar pitching staff that at one point was on pace to have the third-best team ERA in league history. Despite struggling after the All-Star Break the Baby Bombers finished the season leading the league in ERA (2.60), WHIP (1.19), and strikeout-to-walk ratio; while also being second in strikeouts (684) and walks allowed (201).

The pitching staff featured several of the best pitching prospects that the Yankees organization had to offer including 2017 first-round draft pick Clarke Schmidt, second-round pick Matt Sauer, standout international signee Roansy Contreras, and more. The staff was led by Travis Phelps who was in his third season as pitching coach.

"I take tremendous pride in it," Phelps said at the end of the season. "It goes back to last year [2018] when [Jonathan] Loaisiga was here. He's pitching in the big leagues now and guys I've had the last couple of years are in Double-A, Triple-A, and knocking on the door of the big leagues. You spend so much time with them. You love seeing them grow, having success, and being a part of it. You are not the reason, but you are a part of that growth."

Schmidt made two starts for the Yankees as part of his return from Tommy John surgery and impressed many with his quality pitches and maturity on the hill. Sauer led the team with 67 innings pitched, pitching to a 3.90 ERA with 45 strikeouts. It was right-handed pitcher Harold Cortijo who was the unsung hero of the starting rotation, starting nine games and striking out 60 batters over 51 1/3 innings.

The staff saw a lot of turnover from promotions, injuries, and trades. Right-handed pitcher Luis Rijo was traded in the middle of the game on July 30 along with Tyler Austin to the Minnesota Twins for pitcher Lance Lynn. Thus, helping the big club on their road to the 2019 playoffs. The strong Staten Island pitching staff once again was called upon to help fortify the big-league club in September when Juan De Paul was traded along with Abiatal Avelino to the San Francisco Giants for outfielder Andrew McCutchen.

Pitchers like Nolan Martinez, Daniel Alvarez, Alex Mauricio, Brooks Kiske, Roansy Contreras, Shawn Semple, Christian Morris, and Chase Hodson earned promotions meaning a large portion of the pitching staff changed throughout the season. "We've had a lot of rollover," pitching coach Travis Phelps said at the end of the season, "we have continued to maintain our ability to shut teams down. I think our guys have done a tremendous job this year."

New pitchers like Luis Gil, Tanner Myatt, Daniel Bies, Austin Gardner, and more came in and continued the success on the mound. Staten Island also reunited with right-handed pitcher Domingo Acevedo who returned for a two-game rehab stint while Erik Swanson joined the Yankees on a minor league rehab stint as well.

Out of the bullpen though it was right-handed Aaron McGarity who had one of the most impressive seasons. McGarity made 13 appearances and allowed just one earned run the entire season while striking out 32 over 25 2/3 innings of work. The only run he allowed came in his second inning of work on August 28 against the Hudson Valley Renegades, ending a 21-inning streak of not allowing an earned run.

"If I had to say, one guy who has taken a game to a different level, it would be him," Phelps said about McGarity. "His ability to work ahead, change speeds, and work down in the zone. He has done a great job working down in the zone and locating his fastball. Whenever he does that, his slider and changeup have continued to improve in confidence every time he goes out there to the point where he has a good idea of what he is doing and how to set up hitters when he gets ahead of them."

Defensively, the 2018 Staten Island Yankees were among the best the New York-Penn League had to offer. They committed the second-fewest errors (67) in the league and was fourth in the league in double plays turned with 62.

On the offensive side of the game, the Staten Island Yankees struggled. Their team batting average (.213) was the second lowest in the league, they had the lowest on-base percentage (.285), and the third lowest slugging percentage (.325).

At the plate, the Yankees had 29 different players stand in the batter's box. Among them were 2018 second round draft pick Josh Breau who got his first base hit with the team off Mets pitcher Noah Syndergaard. Breau went on to hit .280/.295/.370 in 27 games, serving as the primary backstop for the team.

Breau was not the only catcher, though. In total, the Staten Island Yankees used nine different catchers throughout the season. Among them was Ryan Lidge, the cousin of former major leaguer Brad Lidge.

Andres Chaparro and Kyle Gray were tied for the team lead in home runs, each with seven. Gray's ability to barrel up the ball lead to a breakout August that saw him slug six home runs with 16 RBIs and seven walks.



Chaparro was among the several Yankees prospects that saw themselves make significant adjustments to their game during the 2018 season.

Yankees hitting coach Ken Joyce raved about some of the improvements that the hitters made throughout the season.

"To me, [Eduardo] Torrealba has made some good adjustments, [Jesus] Bastidas got a little bit better. At times [Junior] Soto, Gray, even though the results aren't there with the average, I thought he made great strides hitting seven home runs coming in here to pro ball. Up and down the lineup, there are certain ways each guy improved," Joyce told Pinstriped Prospects.

Torrealba ended his 2018 season with a steady string of games, hitting .378/.452/.473 over 24 games in August with five doubles, a triple, 12 RBIs, and eight walks.

One offensive highlight though was the return of Staten Island Yankees alumni Mike Ford who joined the team for a six-game rehab stint as he was working his way back from an oblique injury. Ford, Swanson, and Acevedo were among five players to join the Baby Bombers on minor league rehab assignments.

The Staten Island Yankees were in the playoff hunt right up until the end, finally being knocked out of the playoffs by the Brooklyn Cyclones in the last series. But despite that disappointment, they had many bright spots. Whether it was the stellar pitching, strong defense, or the big-name prospects that joined the team they certainly gave fans their money worth.

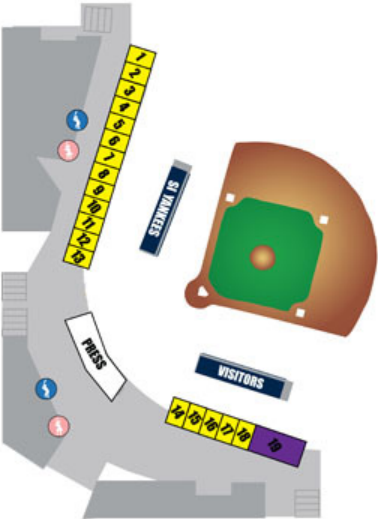


Richmond County Bank Ballpark Seating Chart

Directions

Richmond County Bank Ballpark is located on the most northern tip of Staten Island, adjacent to the Staten Island Ferry terminal.

The easiest way to get to the ballpark from New York City is via NYC Subway and the free Staten Island Ferry.

Subway Directions

From Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens and Long Island

Take the 4 or 5 to Bowling Green, the R or W to Whitehall Station, or the 1 to South Ferry, then a 25-minute ride on the historic Staten Island Ferry. Exit the Ferry from the upper deck and then follow the signs to the ballpark.

Staten Island Ferry Schedule: The Ferry, which is free, departs every 15 minutes weekdays from 5:00 PM-7:00 PM; every 20 minutes from 7:00 PM-8:00 PM; and thereafter every 30 minutes. On weekends, the ferry departs every 30 minutes until 7:00 PM and every 60 minutes thereafter. NO cars permitted on the ferry.

From Staten Island

The South Shore SIRTOA train terminates at the Staten Island Ferry terminal. The Ballpark is a 90 second walk from the Ferry terminal.

Driving Directions

From Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens and Long Island

Take the lower level on the Verrazano Bridge. Stay right to toll booths. Take the Bay Street Exit and follow school road to Bay Street and make a left on Bay Street. Follow Bay Street toward the ballpark and [click here](#) for info on the nearest parking.

From the Bronx, Westchester, Rockland and North

Via George Washington or Tappan Zee Bridge to New Jersey Turnpike South to Exit 13. Follow directions to Goethals Bridge.

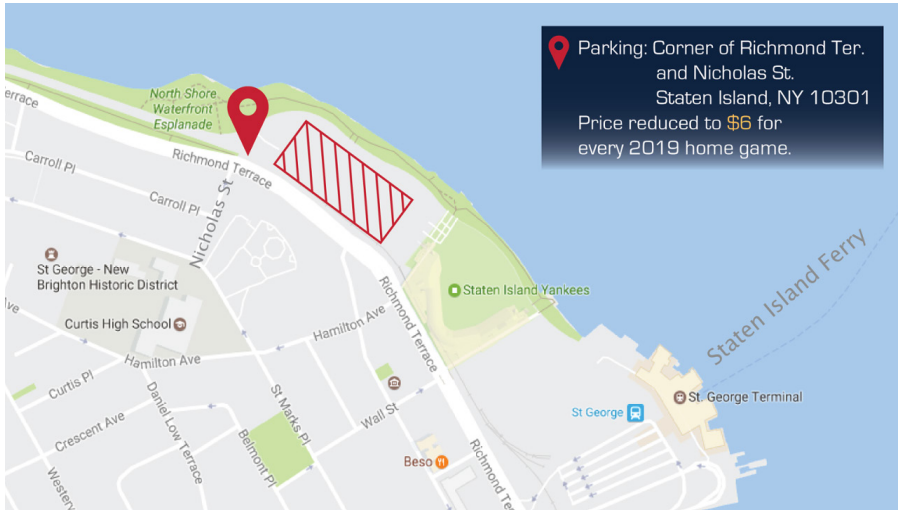
From New Jersey

Via Outerbridge Crossing (Exit 127 on the Garden State Parkway) into Staten Island. Take West Shore Expressway (440) to Staten Island Expressway (278 East). Take 278 to Clove Road exit 13. Make left onto Clove Road. At Victory Blvd., make a right. Follow Victory Blvd. to the end (Bay Street). Make a left onto Bay Street. Follow Bay Street toward the ballpark and [click here](#) for info on the nearest parking.

Via Goethals Bridge (Exit 13 on the New Jersey Turnpike) onto Staten Island Expressway (278 East). Take 278 to Clove Road exit 13. Make left onto Clove Road. At Victory Blvd., make a right. Follow Victory BLVD until you reach Bay Street. Make a left onto Bay Street. Follow Bay Street toward the ballpark and [click here](#) for info on the nearest parking.

Via Bayonne Bridge - Get off at Richmond Terrace. Make a right onto Morningstar Road. Follow for .4 mile to Richmond Terrace, make a right. Follow Richmond Terrace toward the ballpark and [click here](#) for info on the nearest parking.

Self-Park garage for Richmond County Bank Ballpark open with an all-time low parking rate of \$6

As progress continues on the North Shore developments, the Staten Island Yankees are excited to present a less expensive, more convenient parking option for the 2018 season as the new parking garage is open for self-park.

The new parking garage, formerly the ballpark's left field parking lot, will be available at an all-time low price of \$6 for 2018 Staten Island Yankees home games, even less than the lot's regular commuter parking rate. This rate applies to Staten Island Yankees home games ONLY.

The garage can be accessed at the corner of Nicholas Street and Richmond Terrace, with the garage's entrance located a mere 500 feet from Richmond County Bank Ballpark's Hamilton Avenue Gate. The garage's physical address is 155 Richmond Terrace, but 224 Richmond Terrace, the adjacent street corner, can be used for GPS reference. For those accessing the garage via Richmond Terrace, walk-out access to street level is located on the third level, one level up from the Nicholas Street entrance.

For handicap access to the garage, fans can enter via Jersey Street and use shuttles operated by Impark that will transport riders to the ballpark's main gates.
