The Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks and Milwaukee Milkmen will conclude their second of four series' with a 1:00 p.m. game on Sunday afternoon. With their 11-10 loss on Saturday night the RedHawks have now fallen to 1-5 on the year against the Milkmen and are now .500 in their 28 all-time games against the Wisconsin ball club. REDHAWKS TIE XBH SEASON HIGH IN LOSS

The Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks tied their season high for extra-base hits in a game with three doubles and four home runs in Saturday night's 11-10 loss against the Milwaukee Milkmen. The 'Hawks had six doubles and a home run in an 11-3 win over the Houston Apollos on May 30. Catcher Kevin Krause led Fargo-Moorhead on Saturday with two doubles, a home run, and four RBIs in the loss. Leo Pina (2B, HR, 3 RBIs), Correlle Prime (HR), and Alex Boxwell (HR) also had an extra-base hit. It was Prime's second straight game with a home run and has now hit a home run in three of his last four games.

Brent Jones returns to the RedHawks in 2021 for his sixth season of professional baseball and third in Fargo-Moorhead. The Cornell graduate appeared in 16 games last season for the RedHawks, going 1-1 with a 2.66 ERA and 21 strikeouts in 23.2 innings pitched. His 2.66 ERA was the lowest among RedHawks pitchers, despite the low inning count. Jones held opponents to three hits or fewer in all but one of his 16 appearances last season. In 2019, Jones made 39 appearances, all in relief, for Fargo-Moorhead and went 0-4 with a 3.10 ERA. In 40.2 innings of work, Jones allowed 33 hits, 14 earned runs, struck out 53 batters, and walked 18.

After playing college baseball at Cornell, Jones was drafted by the Diamondbacks in the 4th Round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He played two seasons in the Arizona farm system and reached the Single-A level with the Kane County Cougars in 2015 before taking a two-year break from professional baseball. Jones returned to baseball in 2018 with the Sussex County Miners of the Can-Am League and made 11 relief appearances before signing with Fargo-Moorhead ahead of the 2019 season.

Jones became the highest selection from Cornell at the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft, when the Arizona Diamondbacks picked him in 2014. He became a hot commodity in scouting circles after throwing 96 mph during the Big Red's Scout Day in the fall, then backed it up with an impressive senior season as one of the team's top starters. Jones led the team with nine starts, posting a 2.50 earned-run average with 47 strikeouts next to just 13 walks in 50.1 innings. He also led the team with two complete games, running his career total to five. He surrendered more than two earned runs in just one of his nine starts. Jones was particularly dominant in Ivy League play with a 1.69 ERA. During his three seasons with the Big Red, Jones went 10-6 with a 3.54 ERA, 112 strikeouts, 48 walks, and 53 earned runs against in 134.2 innings pitched. He gave up only one home run during his collegiate career. Jones majored in engineering at Cornell.

Jones was selected as an All-District pitcher in high school at Albuquerque Academy, an All-Metro pitcher and outfielder and All-State pitcher in New Mexico — all first-team honors as a senior. He was named an AP Scholar with Honor and is an accomplished musician, being selected for the New Mexico All-State Guitar Ensemble.
