TODAY'S GAME: Game one of the three-game series against the St. Lucie Mets (NYM). First of four series between the two teams in 2018. Florida finished 2017 with a 3-11 record against St. Lucie, including 2-5 at Osceola County Stadium.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP Jeremy Walker makes his third start of the 2018 in game one of the three-game series against the St. Lucie Mets. The 22-year-old product from Gardner-Webb finished his 2017 season on a four-game winning streak for the Rome Braves (A-), going 3-0 with a 1.23era (4er/29.1ip) in the month of August with two complete games, and posting 19 strikeouts compared to just three walks.

The 6'5" hurler allowed six runs on seven hits in just 1.2 frames against the Fort Myers Miracle on April 11. The North Carolina native surrendered a home run, walked a man and struck out one in his first loss of the season.

Tuesday will be Walker's first career start against the Mets.

PITCHING CONTINUES DOMINANCE IN FINALE WITH PALM BEACH: For a third consecutive game, starting pitching dominated Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium for the Florida Fire Frogs to close out a three-game weekend set with the Palm Beach Cardinals, with the road team taking a 3-1 victory to avoid the sweep.

Bryse Wilson and Ian Oxnevad dueled their way through five innings, with neither starter yielding much on the bases.

Wilson retired the first five men he faced before allowing a double to Andy Young, but then struck out J.B. Woodman for his fourth strikeout in just two frames. The Atlanta Braves 13th-ranked prospect (MLB.com) did not surrender any more hits through his remaining three innings, and finished the day with five strikeouts

All of the scoring in the game took place in the sixth inning, with Jordan Rodgers capping off the frame with a two-run shot off of reliever Jacob Patterson for his firs home run of 2018.

BRYSE IS NICE: Bryse Wilson could not have asked for a better start to the 2018 season, as the 20-year-old has not allowed a run through 8.2 innings of work through two starts. The 2016 draft pick has collected 10 strikeouts and walked just one man during that same span, while giving up six hits.

GET THIS PARTY STARTEDI: Florida's starting pitching was stellar through the weekend, as the combination of Joey Wentz , lan Anderson and Bryse Wilson combined to allow just four hits in 15 innings, while keeping Palm Beach off the scoreboard in the process. The trio of prospects struck out 16 over the three games.

GLAD TO BE HOME: The Fire Frogs ended their seven-game road trip with a 2-5 mark against Fort Myers (1-3) and Palm Beach (1-2). The Atlanta Braves Advanced-A affiliate returns to Osceola County Stadium. Florida averaged just 2.5 runs/game during the trip. and had five games decided by two runs or less

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT: With 11 games played this season, eight have already been decided by two runs or less for Florida. The Fire Frogs have gone 3-5 this season in close contests, and are 25-49 in just over a year in those games. All three of the Fire Frogs victories have been decided by two runs or less (two by one run, one by two runs).

HIGHLY RANKED PROSPECTS: Entering the 2018 season, the Atlanta Braves have the second rated farm system in Minor League Baseball, according to MLB.com...lan Anderson is ranked the top prospect on the Fire Frogs and 49th in Minor League Baseball by MLB.com. Cristian Pache, Joey Wentz and Bryse Wilson are also Fire Frogs players ranked in the top 15 in the Braves organization, according to MLB.com.
