Today's Start: 20-year-old Kyle Muller makes his 10th start at the High-A level in the opener of the two-game series against the Charlotte Stone Crabs. The southpaw made six starts with the Rome Braves, going 3-0 with a 2.40 ERA across 30 innings of work (8er).

Last Outing: The Dallas native did not factor into the decision of a 4-3 loss to the Dunedin Blue Jays on June 28. The southpaw limited the Blue Jays to two runs on nine hits, a walk and five strikeouts across six frames for his third consecutive quality start.
vs. Charlotte: Tuesday will be Muller's first career start against the Stone Crabs.

2018: Entered the season as the Atlanta Braves 12th-ranked prospect, according to MLB.com...Transferred to the Florida Fire Frogs on May 8.

2017: Played his first full professional season with rookie-level Danville, going 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA (22 ER/47.2 IP) and 49 strikeouts over 11 games, all starts...Allowed two or fewer earned runs in eight of his 11 starts...Opponents batted just . 232 against him, including a . 184 (7-for-38) mark by left-handed batters...Entered the season tabbed by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 13 prospect, while Baseball America named him No. 17.

2016: Played his first professional season with the GCL Braves and earned the club's Pitcher of the Year honors...Closed his rookie campaign as the 11thbest prospect in the Gulf Coast League as named by Baseball America...Prior to being drafted, earned 2016 Gatorade National Player of the Year honors after pitching to a perfect 8-0 record with a 0.46 ERA and 133 strikeouts in 76.0 innings at Jesuit College Prep, and entered the First-Year Player Draft as the 25th-best player in the class according to Baseball America...Hit 396 with 15 home runs in his final season at Jesuit Prep...
