**Today's Start:** 23-year-old Jeremy Walker makes his 18th start of 2018 in the series opener against the Dunedin Blue Jays on Monday night.

**Last Outing:** The 6'5" hurler suffered his ninth loss of the season in a 6-2 defeat to the Daytona Tortugas on July 11 at Jackie Robinson Ballpark. The product of Gardner-Webb allowed six runs (four in the first) on nine hits (two home runs), two walks and five strikeouts on 97 pitches - 60 strikes.

**vs. Dunedin:** Monday will be Walker's third start against the Blue Jays in 2018. The 2016 fifth-round draft pick has allowed five runs through 10 innings on nine knocks, four free passes and nine punchouts against the Toronto Blue Jays' affiliate. The right-hander did not factor into the decision in a 7-6, 10-inning victory at Dunedin Stadium on May 23, allowed two runs on three hits and seven strikeouts in the quality start.

**2018:** Set a career-high with eight innings of work against the Jupiter Hammerheads on 6/19, scattering five hits while handing out a free pass and punching out four on 96 pitches (69 strikes).

**2017:** Played his first full professional season with Single-A Rome and went 7-11 with a 3.97 ERA (61 ER/138.1 IP) and 100 strikeouts over 27 starts... Ranked in the Top 10 among Atlanta farmhands in innings (5th, 138.1) and wins (T5th, 7). Pitched to a 4-4 record and a 1.90 ERA (13 ER/61.2 IP) over his final 11 starts of the season after going 3-7 with a 5.63 ERA over his first 16 turns... Tossed back-to-back 7.0-inning complete games on 8/6 and 8/12, including the first shutout of his career on 8/12 at Greenville.

**2016:** Made his professional debut with rookie-level Danville after being a fifth-round selection in the First-Year Player Draft and went 3-3 with a 3.18 ERA (14 ER/39.2 IP) and 39 strikeouts over 13 games (five starts)... Compiled a 4.63 strikeout-walk ratio, the sixth-best mark in the Atlanta system... Pitched to a 1-0 record with a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP) over eight relief appearances, compared to a 2-3 mark and a 3.63 ERA (9 ER/22.1 IP) in five starts.


