TODAY'S GAME: Finale of a three-game series against the Dunedin Blue Jays (TOR) from Dunedin Stadium (0-2)...Game three of a six-game road trip against Dunedin and the Clearwater Threshers (0-2)...Florida is coming off a 2-1 series victory over the Threshers from Osceola County Stadium...Fourth and final series (10 games) against the Toronto Blue Jays' affiliate, with six coming at Dunedin Stadium (3-1)...The Atlanta Braves' affiliate took all three games against Dunedin on the road from May 22-23.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 23-year-old Jon Kennedy makes his second start of the season at the High-A level in the finale of the three-game series against the Dunedin Blue Jays on Wednesday night...The native of Melbourne, Australia has appeared in 20 games as a reliever with Florida in 2018, posting a record of 5-4 out of the bullpen with a 2.09 ERA (10er/43.0ip)...The 6-foot-5 hurler's last start came on July 10 against the Daytona Tortugas at Jackie Robinson Ballpark, allowing two runs - one earned - on six hits and six strikeouts across five frames in the no-decision.

OFFENSE STALLS IN LOSS TO BLUE JAYS: The Florida Fire Frogs could only muster two hits in a 4-0 loss to the Dunedin Blue Jays on Tuesday morning at Dunedin Stadium, suffering their sixth shutout loss of the season (first of the second half).

Cristian Pache and Marcus Mooney picked up both knocks on the day, with Mooney's snapping a strink of 15 consecutive batters set down by Zach Logue.

STARTING NINE: Cristian Pache's singled with one out in the top of the third, stretching the 19-year-old's hitting streak to nine games (tying a season-high), and advancing his on-base streak to 12 games...During the hitting streak, the Atlanta Braves' eighth-ranked prospect (MLB.com) is batting .368 (14-for-38) with two home runs...During the on-base streak, the center fielder is hitting .396 (19-for-48) with three long balls and six RBI.

BURROWS BURNING JULY: With two more scoreless innings on Tuesday morning, Thomas Burrows has allowed just two runs - one earned - through 10.1 innings in July (five games)...The product of Alabama is 3-0 during the fourth month of the season, collecting 16 strikeouts compared to just four walks.

COACHING STAFF

MANAGER, LUIS SALAZAR



- Luis Salazar is in his first season as the Fire Frogs skipper and his eighth season overall as a manger in the Braves organization.
- Salazar spent his first five seasons (2011 to 2015) with the organization as the High-A skipper before man-aging the Double-A Mississippi Braves for the last two seasons (2016 and 2017).
- Salazar, who has 20-plus years of minor-league coaching and managerial experience, owns an overall managerial record of 769-836 (.479) over 14 seasons.
- Salazar guided his team to three consecutive Carolina League playoff appearances in 2012, 2013 and 2014...In 2012, his club claimed the Carolina League title, winning the Mill Cup Championship.
- From 2002 to 2009, he spent eight seasons as a coach in the Los Angeles Dodgers farm system, including five as a manager...

He managed Single-A Vero Beach in 2006 and from 2005 to 2006, he led the rookie-level Gulf Coast League Dodgers.

- He spent three seasons, 2007 to 2009, as the Dodgers' Double-A hitting coach.
- From 1995 to 2001, Salazar was a member of the Milwaukee Brewers organization, including working the 2011 season as the Milwaukee Brewers' first base coach.
- During his time with the Brewers organization, he spent three seasons (1998-99 and 2000) as the Brewers' Triple-A hitting coach: Louisville (1998 and 1999) and Indianapolis (2000), and in 1996 and 1997, he managed the Single-A Beloit Snappers.
