Today's Start: 20-year-old Kyle Muller makes his 15th start at the High-A level (20th in 2018) in the opener of the doubleheader against the Charlotte Stone Crabs on Tuesday. The southpaw made six starts with the Rome Braves, going 3-0 with a 2.40 ERA across 30 innings of work (8er).

Last Outing: The Dallas native suffered his second loss of the season in a 4-2 defeat to the Clearwater Threshers on July 20 at Spectrum Field. The left-hander was working on a three-hitter through seven shutout innings before allowing a grand slam to Jose Pujols in the eighth to end his night after a career-high, 7.1 innings of work. The Jesuit College Prep product struck out seven men in the outing, including a stretch of five-in-a-row from the second out in the second until the final out in the third.

vs. Charlotte: Tuesday will be Muller's second career start against the Stone Crabs. The 6-foot-7 hurler faced off against the Tampa Bay Rays' affiliate at home on July 4, and tossed three innings of no-hit ball before allowing two runs in the fourth and two more in the fifth before rain suspended the contest in the middle of inning number five.

2018: Entered the season as the Atlanta Braves 12th-ranked prospect, according to MLB.com...Transferred to the Florida Fire Frogs on May 8...Set a career high with 12 strikeouts against the Daytona Tortugas on July 9...Set a career-high with 7.1 innings pitched in a 4-2 loss to the Clearwater Threshers on 7/20.

2017: Played his first full professional season with rookie-level Danville, going 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA (22 ER/47.2 IP) and 49 strikeouts over 11 games, all starts...Allowed two or fewer earned runs in eight of his 11 starts...Opponents batted just .232 against him, including a .184 (7-for-38) mark by left-handed batters...Entered the season tabbed by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 13 prospect, while Baseball America named him No. 17.

2016: Played his first professional season with the GCL Braves and earned the club's Pitcher of the Year honors...Closed his rookie campaign as the 11th-best prospect in the Gulf Coast League as named by Baseball America...Prior to being drafted, earned 2016 Gatorade National Player of the Year honors after pitching to a perfect 8-0 record with a 0.46 ERA and 133 strikeouts in 76.0 innings at Jesuit College Prep, and entered the First-Year Player Draft as the 25th-best player in the class according to Baseball America...Hit .396 with 15 home runs in his final season at Jesuit Prep...Taken as the 44th-overall selection in the 2016 draft (taken after Ian Anderson and Joey Wentz)...Signed for \$2.5 million.

Today's Start: 23-year-old Jeremy Walker makes his 20th start of 2018 in the finale of the doubleheader against the Charlotte Stone Crabs on Tuesday.

Last Outing: The 6'5" hurler did not factor into the decision of a 2-1 loss to the Clearwater Threshers on July 21 at Spectrum Field. The right-hander allowed an unearned run in the first innings, but held the Threshers off the scoreboard through his remaining six innings of work, scattering five hits and striking out four on 90 pitches (64 strikes).

vs. Charlotte: Tuesday will be Walker's first career start against the Stone Crabs.

2018: Set a career-high with eight innings of work against the Jupiter Hammerheads on 6/19, scattering five hits while handing out a free pass and punching out four on 96 pitches (69 strikes).

2017: Played his first full professional season with Single-A Rome and went 7-11 with a 3.97 ERA (61 ER/138.1 IP) and 100 strikeouts over 27 starts... Ranked in the Top 10 among Atlanta farmhands in innings (5th, 138.1) and wins (T5th, 7), Pitched to a 4-4 record and a 1.90 ERA (13 ER/61.2 IP) over his final 11 starts of the season after going 3-7 with a 5.63 ERA over his first 16 turns...Tossed back-to-back 7.0-inning complete games on 8/6 and 8/12, including the first shutout of his career on 8/12 at Greenville.

2016: Made his professional debut with rookie-level Danville after being a fifth-round selection in the First-Year Player Draft and went 3-3 with a 3.18 ERA (14 ER/39.2 IP) and 39 strikeouts over 13 games (five starts)...Compiled a 4.63 strikeout-walk ratio, the sixth-best mark in the Atlanta system...Pitched to a 1-0 record with a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP) over eight relief appearances, compared to a 2-3 mark and a 3.63 ERA (9 ER/22.1 IP) in five starts.
