Today's Start: 22-year-old Tucker Davidson makes his 22nd start of the season in the series opener against the Fort Myers Miracle on Thursday night. The Amarillo, Texas native entered the 2018 season as the 13th- (Baseball America) and 23rd- (MLB.com) ranked prospect in the Atlanta Braves organization, and is currently 25th (MLB.com).

Last Outing: The southpaw suffered his ninth loss of the season in a 7-1 defeat to the Miracle on Aug. 3. The 6-foot-2 hurler allowed two runs on two hits, while setting a career high with six walks and striking out six. Of the six free passes, four came in a 37-pitch first inning.

vs. Fort Myers: Thursday will be Davidson's third career start against the Miracle. The Midland College product has allowed six runs on eight knocks, 11 walks and eight punchouts across 6.2 frames for an 0-2 record against the Minnesota Twins' affiliate.

2018: Set a career-high with eight strikeouts against the Daytona Tortugas on July 13...Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning of the same game before the bid was broken up by a Tyler Stephenson single.

2017: Played his first full professional season with Single-A Rome, and went 5-4 with a 2.60 ERA (30 ER/103.2 IP) and 101 strikeouts over 31 games (12 starts)...His 2.60 ERA tied for the second-best mark among Atlanta's starting pitcher prospects (min. 75.0 IP)...Logged a 1-2 record and a 2.38 ERA in 19 relief appearances, and a 4-2 mark with a 2.76 ERA in 12 starts...Allowed left-handed batters to hit just .180 (23-for-128) against him...Surrendered fewer than two earned runs in 29 of his 31 appearances.

College: Was slated to play for North Carolina State before Atlanta drafted him in the 19th round (559th overall)...Went 6-2 with a 2.27 ERA in 71.1 innings, with 75 strikeouts and 20 walks...Allowed just three home runs his sophomore season...Had a 67.8 strike percentage...Selected to the All-Western Junior College Athletic Association first team.


