TODAY'S GAME

The Durham Bulls play game two of a four game series against the Charlotte Knights at BB&T Ballpark in Charlotte, North Carolina. Right-hander Andrew Moore will make his season debut for the Bulls and will matchup against Knights left-hander Jordan Guerrero.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls fell 12-11 to Charlotte in a game that saw 32 combined hits. Andrew Velazquez led the way for the Bulls offense, with a leadoff home run in the first inning and career high five RBI's. Nate Lowe started his season off with a bang, notching a home run and three RBI's after tallying 27 home runs and 102 RBI's last season.

BULLS VS. KNIGHTS

In 2019, the Bulls are 0-1 against the Knights. The Bulls have been outscored 12-11.

In 2018, the Bulls and Knights did battle 24 times, splitting the season series 12-12. Thursday's starter Donn Roach led the way for Charlotte, recording three of his nine wins in 2018 against Durham. Ryan Weber notched two of his nine wins, while Ian Gibaut tallied three saves for the Bulls during the series. The Bulls went 5-8 at DBAP against Charlotte last season and 7-4 at BB&T Ballpark. The Bulls outscored the Knights 102-87 over the regular season battle.

BULL-ET POINTS

- Andrew Velazquez hit a home run in the first at-bat of the season. The last time this occurred was in 2017, when Johnny Field opened the season with a home run at Gwinnett.
- Velazquez set a career high in RBI's with five on Thursday.
- Oliver Drake played for a Major League record five teams last season and six grand total (Milwaukee, Cleveland, Los Angeles (AL), Toronto, Minnesota and Salt Lake (AAA)).
- Kean Wong notched International League Midseason and Postseason All-Star honors last season.
- Wong was also named the 2018 Durham Bulls Team MVP
- Nate Lowe earned the 2018 Tampa Bay Rays Minor League Player of the Year award.
- The 11 runs by the Bulls offense is the most on Opening Day since 2013 (11 at Norfolk).
- Of the current roster, 11 players were acquired by the Tampa Bay Rays in a trade, nine players were drafted, four were signed as minor league free agents and one was selected in the Triple-A portion of the Rule 5 Draft.
- The Bulls feature three players ranked in the Rays Top 30 Prospects by MiLB.com including **Nate Lowe** (#8), **Nick Solak** (#12) and **Colin Poche** (#17).

Homecoming

Quinton McCracken returns to the Durham Bulls for the first time as a coach, after spending the 2000 season with the team as a player. A veteran of 12 Major League seasons, McCracken was a part of the 1998 inaugural Tampa Bay Devil Rays team, and spent three seasons in the Devils Rays system. McCracken hit .260 with two home runs and 28 RBI's in 85 games with the Bulls.

McCracken is also a local product, having attended Duke University prior to his Major League career. McCracken joins the Bulls after spending 2018 with the Miami Marlins as a Minor League Coordinator. Beforehand, McCracken spent six seasons with the Houston Astros as the Director of Player Personnel.

DEBUTS IN DURHAM

A number of players are making their Durham Bulls debut this season. Some players are joining the Tampa Bay Rays organization for the first time. These include RP Oliver Drake, SP Ryan Merritt, RP Emilio Pagan, SP Casey Sadler, RP Luis Stantos, SP Aaron Slegers, OF Jake Smolinski and RP Cole Sulser. Others are joining the Bulls by reaching Triple-A for the first time in their career. This includes INF Mike Brosseau, OF Nathan Lukes and INF Nick Solak.

THREE-PEAT?

After winning back-to-back Governors' Cup titles, the Bulls will look to earn a three-peat for the first time in their team history. A three-peat has not been accomplished since the span of 1979-1981, when the Columbus Clippers won back-to-back-to-back titles. The Bulls previously won back-to-back titles in 2002 and 2003 under International League Hall of Fame Manager Bill Evers.

Note-A-Bulls

Manager **Brady Williams** begins his tenure with the Durham Bulls after spending the past five seasons with the Montgomery Biscuits (AA). Williams has spent 10 seasons as an MiLB manager, all of which have been in the Tampa Bay Rays system, compiling a 776-699 (.526) record entering 2019.

The son of former Major Leauge Manager Jimy Williams and the brother of current Reading Fightin Phils (Double-A-Philadelphia) Manager Shawn Williams, Brady has baseball in his blood. Williams spent five seasons playing Minor League Baseball after being selected in the 45th round of the 1999 MLB Draft by the Boston Red Sox.
