TODAY's GAME

The Durham Bulls play game three of a four game series against the Charlotte Knights at BB&T Ballpark in Charlotte, North Carolina after dropping the first two games of the series. Right-hander Emilio Pagan will make his second appearance of the season and first start as a Bull and will do battle against Knights right-hander Jordan Stephens.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls fell 10-6 in game two of the four game series against Charlotte. Jake Smolinski was the only Bull to not record a hit in game one and rebounded to lead the team with two hits and 3 RBI's. Andrew Velazquez brought his series total to eight hits, one home run and seven RBI's in just two games, but the Charlotte offense proved to be too much. The Knights launched three home runs for the second straight game.

BULLS vs. KNIGHTS

In 2019, the Bulls are 0-2 against the Knights. The Bulls have been outscored 22-17, allowing an average of 11 runs per game, while averaging 8.5 runs per game on offense.

In 2018, the Bulls and Knights did battle 24 times, splitting the season series 12-12. Thursday's starter Donn Roach led the way for Charlotte, recording three of his nine wins in 2018 against Durham. Ryan Weber notched two of his nine wins, while Ian Gibaut tallied three saves for the Bulls during the series. The Bulls went 5-8 at DBAP against Charlotte last season and 7-4 at BB&T Ballpark. The Bulls outscored the Knights 102-87 over the regular season battle.

BULL-ET POINTS

- **Andrew Velazquez** hit a home run in the first at-bat of the season. The last time this occurred was in 2017, when Johnny Field opened the season with a home run at Gwinnett.
- Velazquez set a career high in RBI's with five on Thursday.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez has two four-hit games on back-to-back days.
- **Jake Cronenworth** tied his career high in hits with four on Friday, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A)
- **Mike Brosseau** and **Nick Solak** have each recorded their first Triple-A hits and RBI's in this series.
- **Kean Wong** notched International League Midseason and Postseason All-Star honors last season.
- **Nate Lowe** earned the 2018 Tampa Bay Rays Minor League Player of the Year award.
- The 11 runs by the Bulls offense is the most on Opening Day since 2013 (11 at Norfolk).
- The Bulls feature three players ranked in the Rays Top 30 Prospects by MiLB.com including **Nate Lowe** (#8), **Nick Solak** (#12) and **Colin Poche** (#17).

HOMECOMING

Quinton McCracken returns to the Durham Bulls for the first time as a coach, after spending the 2000 season with the team as a player. A veteran of 12 Major League seasons, McCracken was a part of the 1998 inaugural Tampa Bay Devil Rays team, and spent three seasons in the Devil Rays system. McCracken hit .260 with two home runs and 28 RBI's in 85 games with the Bulls.

McCracken is also a local product, having attended Duke University prior to his Major League career. McCracken joins the Bulls after spending 2018 with the Miami Marlins as a Minor League Coordinator. Beforehand, McCracken spent six seasons with the Houston Astros as the Director of Player Personnel.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

Despite the 0-2 start, the Bulls are off to one of the best offensive starts in history. The 17 runs scored in the first two games is the highest mark in since joining Triple-A. Of the 12 position players to register an at bat this season, 10 of 12 have at least one hit and half of the team has at least one RBI. The Bulls .394 team batting average is the highest in the International League, as is their team on-base percentage of .452.

LEADING THE CHARGE

Andrew Velazquez had a 2018 to remember after climbing his way from Double-A Montgomery to Tampa Bay. Now he is picking up right where he left off in 2019. Velazquez ranks first in the International League in RBI's (7) and total bases (14), while ranking third in batting average (.727). For context, Velazquez did not reach 7 RBI's last season until May 1st and took eight games to reach eight hits.

NOTE-A-BULLS

Manager **Brady Williams** begins his tenure with the Durham Bulls after spending the past five seasons with the Montgomery Biscuits (AA). Williams has spent 10 seasons as an MiLB manager, all of which have been in the Tampa Bay Rays system, compiling a 776-699 (.526) record entering 2019.

The son of former Major League Manager Jimy Williams and the brother of current Reading Fightin Phils (Double-A Philadelphia) Manager Shawn Williams, Brady has baseball in his blood. Williams spent five seasons playing Minor League Baseball after being selected in the 45th round of the 1999 MLB Draft by the Boston Red Sox.

LAST TIME OUT: Pitched 1.1 innings in relief of starter Jake Faria in his 2019 season debut. Did not allow a hit or a walk and struck out two batters in the 12-11 loss at Charlotte.

2019 SPRING TRAINING: Went 0-1 with a 3.46 ERA (13.0 IP) with the Tampa Bay Rays in his first Spring Training with the club. Struck out 14 batters while walking just four.

A FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING: A reliever his entire career, Pagan will make the first start of his professional career, both in MiLB and MLB action. Pagan has made 174 relief appearances in Minor League Baseball and 89 appearances in Major League Baseball.

2018 SEASON: Spent most of the season with Oakland, going 3-1 with a 4.35 ERA (62.0 IP) in 55 games. Went 0-0 with a 1.23 ERA (14.2 IP) in the month of June (13 games), striking out 21. Pagan set Major League career highs in innings pitched (62.0) and strikeouts (63).

MAN ON THE MOVE: Pagan is now on his third organization, after playing for the Seattle Mariners and Oakland Athletics organizations prior to joining Tampa Bay. Despite the movement, Pagan has been valued highly enough that he has been traded in deals for Major League starters Ryon Healy and Jurickson Profar.
