### TODAY'S GAME

The Durham Bulls play the series finale against the Charlotte Knights at BB&T Ballpark in Charlotte, North Carolina after winning game three on Saturday. Right-hander Aaron Slegers will make his first start in the Tampa Bay Rays organization and first start as a Bull and will face-off against Knights right-hander Spencer Adams.

# LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls won their first game of the season by a final score of 6-2. Emilio Pagan made the first start of his professional career, going 1.2 innings, allowing one hit and three walks, but striking out four. The bullpen stepped up for the Bulls, with Hoby Milner and Mike Franco combining for 6.1 innings, allowing two runs and striking out nine. Jake Gronenworth tied a career high for the second straight game with four hits, bringing his series total to 11 hits.

# BULLS VS. KNIGHTS

In 2019, the Bulls are 1-2 against the Knights. The Bulls have been outscored 24-23, allowing an average of 8 runs per game, while averaging 7.67 runs per game on offense.

In 2018, the Bulls and Knights did battle 24 times, splitting the season series 12-12. Thursday's starter Donn Roach led the way for Charlotte, recording three of his nine wins in 2018 against Durham. Ryan Weber notched two of his nine wins, while Ian Gibaut tallied three saves for the Bulls during the series. The Bulls went 5-8 at DBAP against Charlotte last season and 7-4 at BB&T Ballpark. The Bulls outscored the Knights 102-87 over the regular season battle.

# BULL-ET POINTS

- Andrew Velazquez hit a home run in the first at-bat of the season. The last time this occurred was in 2017, when Johnny Field opened the season with a home run at Gwinnett.
- Velazquez set a career high in RBI's with five on Thursday.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez recorded two four-hit games on back-to-back days (Thursday-Friday).
- Jake Cronenworth tied his career high in hits with four on Friday and Saturday, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A)
- Mike Brosseau and Nick Solak have each recorded their first Triple-A hits, RBI's and home runs in this series.
- Kean Wong notched International League Midseason and Postseason All-Star honors last season.
- Nate Lowe earned the 2018 Tampa Bay Rays Minor League Player of the Year award.
- The 11 runs by the Bulls offense is the most on Opening Day since 2013 (11 at Norfolk).
- The Bulls feature three players ranked in the Rays Top 30 Prospects by MiLB.com including **Nate Lowe** (#8), **Nick Solak** (#12) and **Colin Poche** (#17).

# Homecoming

Quinton McCracken returns to the Durham Bulls for the first time as a coach, after spending the 2000 season with the team as a player. A veteran of 12 Major League seasons, McCracken was a part of the 1998 inaugural Tampa Bay Devil Rays team, and spent three seasons in the Devils Rays system. McCracken hit .260 with two home runs and 28 RBI's in 85 games with the Bulls

McCracken is also a local product, having attended Duke University prior to his Major League career. McCracken joins the Bulls after spending 2018 with the Miami Marlins as a Minor League Coordinator. Beforehand, McCracken spent six seasons with the Houston Astros as the Director of Player Personnel.

### OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

Despite the 1-2 start, the Bulls are off to one of the best offensive starts in history. The 23 runs scored in the first three games is the most since 2017. Of the 12 position players to register an at bat this season, 11 of 12 have at least one hit and seven of the 12 have at least one RBI. The Bulls .356 team batting average is the highest in the International League, while their team on-base percentage ranks second at .415.

# DYNAMIC DUO

Andrew Velazquez and Jake Cronenworth are off to very hot starts to the 2019 sesaon. Velazquez ranks first in the International League in RBI's (7) and ranks third in total bases (14), behind his teammate Cronenworth (16) who leads the league. Cronenworth also leads the International League in hits (11), doubles (5), runs scored (7), batting average (.786), OPS (1.929) and ranks second in slugging percentage (1.142). Last season, Cronenworth tallied his 11th hit on May 13th.

# NOTE-A-BULLS

Manager **Brady Williams** begins his tenure with the Durham Bulls after spending the past five seasons with the Montgomery Biscuits (AA). Williams has spent 10 seasons as an MiLB manager, all of which have been in the Tampa Bay Rays system, compiling a 776-699 (.526) record entering 2019.

The son of former Major Leauge Manager Jimy Williams and the brother of current Reading Fightin Phils (Double-A-Philadelphia) Manager Shawn Williams, Brady has baseball in his blood. Williams spent five seasons playing Minor League Baseball after being selected in the 45th round of the 1999 MLB Draft by the Boston Red Sox.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Allowed one earned run on three hits in 2.0 IP for Pittsburgh in a Spring Training loss to Toronto on March 8th. In addition, walked two batters, good for a Spring Training high.

**RETURN TO CHARLOTTE:** Slegers will play his third season in the International League but make his first appearance against Charlotte since 2017. Slegers went 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (12.0 IP) against Charlotte (two games) in 2017.

**2019 Spring Training:** Made four appearances out of the bullpen for Pittsburgh, going 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP). Struck out three and walked three in that span.

**2018 SEASON:** Split the season between Rochester (AAA) and Minnesota, going 5-7 with a 3.80 ERA (85.1 IP) with Rochester (15 games) and going 1-1 with 5.27 ERA (13.2 IP) with Minnesota (four games). Placed on the Major League Disabled List on July 14th, missing over two months with right shoulder inflammation

Bring Durability to Durham: Despite missing two months last season, Slegers has been incredibly durable throughout his career. Slegers ranked fourth in the International League in innings pitched in 2017 and fifth in the Southern League in 2016. Slegers has 686.1 IP over just 121 games (112 starts) in his MiLB career.

**2017 Season:** Split the season between Rochester (AAA) and Minnesota, going 15-4 with a 3.40 ERA (148.1 IP) with Rochester (21 games) and going 0-1 with a 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP) with Minnesota (four games). Made Major League debut on August 17th, going 6.1 IP, allowing two hits, two earned runs, walking two and striking out three in a win against Cleveland.

Towering above The REST: After his Major League debut in 2017, Slegers tied Randy Johnson, Chris Young and Eric Hillman in a tie for second place on the Tallest Major League Players in history (6'10"), behind only Jon Rauch (6'11").

**2016 SEASON:** Spent the entire season with Chattanooga (AA), going 10-7 with a 3.41 ERA (145.1 IP) in 25 games. Went 6-1 with a 2.23 ERA (72.2 IP) in road games (12 games), versus 4-6 with a 4.58 ERA (72.2 IP) in home games (13 games).
