### TODAY'S GAME

The Durham Bulls play game one of a two game series at the Gwinnett Stripers at Coolray Field in Lawrenceville, Georgia. Durham enters the game having lost the opening series to Charlotte three games to one, while Gwinnett enters having defeated Norfolk three games to one. The Bulls will send left-hander Ryan Merritt on the hill for the first time to face Stripers left-hander Kolby Allard.

### LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls dropped the series finale against the Charlotte Knights by a final score of 12-10. The Bulls offense tallied three home runs and 15 hits, led by Nate Lowe and Mike Brosseau, who each notched one home run and two RBI's. Right-hander Aaron Slegers pitched the longest outing of the season among Bulls starters, lasting 3.2 innings.

### BULLS vs. STRIPERS

In 2018, the Bulls and Stripers met 22 times, splitting the season series 11-11. The Bulls got off to a hot start, winning six of the first seven games against Gwinnett, before the series evened out in the second half. Anthony Banda won two of his four games against Gwinnett, while the Bulls bullpen was a balanced attack, with Ian Gibaut, Ryne Stanek, Hunter Wood and Diego Castillo each recording a save.

### BULL-ET POINTS

- **Andrew Velazquez** hit a home run in the first at-bat of the season. The last time this occurred was in 2017, when Johnny Field opened the season with a home run at Gwinnett.
- Velazquez set a career high in RBI's with five on April 4th.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez recorded two four-hit games on back-to-back days (April 4th-April 5th).
- **Jake Cronenworth** tied his career high in hits with four on April 5th and April 6th, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A)
- **Mike Brosseau** and **Nick Solak** have each recorded their first Triple-A hits, RBI's and home runs this year.
- **Kean Wong** notched International League Midseason and Postseason All-Star honors last season.
- **Nate Lowe** hit his second home run on April 7th in just four games, the fastest he has ever reached this mark. Lowe hit 27 home runs last season.
- Lowe earned the 2018 Tampa Bay Rays Minor League Player of the Year award.
- The 11 runs by the Bulls offense is the most on Opening Day since 2013 (11 at Norfolk).
- The Bulls feature three players ranked in the Rays Top 30 Prospects by MiLB.com including **Nate Lowe** (#8), **Nick Solak** (#12) and **Colin Poche** (#17).

### HOMECOMING

**Quinton McCracken** returns to the Durham Bulls for the first time as a coach, after spending the 2000 season with the team as a player. A veteran of 12 Major League seasons, McCracken was a part of the 1998 inaugural Tampa Bay Devil Rays team, and spent three seasons in the Devils Rays system. McCracken hit .260 with two home runs and 28 RBI's in 85 games with the Bulls.

McCracken is also a local product, having attended Duke University prior to his Major League career. McCracken joins the Bulls after spending 2018 with the Miami Marlins as a Minor League Coordinator. Beforehand, McCracken spent six seasons with the Houston Astros as the Director of Player Personnel.

### OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

Despite the 1-3 start, the Bulls are off to one of their best offensive starts in history. The Bulls offense is one of the top in the International League and team history. Durham leads the league in hits (57), batting average (.361), doubles (15), total bases (95), OBP (.423) and OPS (1.024). In addition, the 33 runs scored is the most in the first four games since the Bulls joined Triple-A.

### SPREADING THE WEALTH

The Bulls offense is prolific and much of it has to do with how well-rounded the lineup is. Five players are hitting over .375 and five different players have tallied at least one home run. Nine of the 12 players have notched an extra-base-hit, 11 of the 12 position players have recored a hit and all 12 have reach safely in the first four games. Leadoff hitter Andrew Velazquez leads the team in RBI's with eight and the power hitters Nate Lowe and Mike Brosseau have combined for four home runs and nine RBI's, providing a fearsome middle of the order.

### NOTE-A-BULLS

Infielder **Jake Cronenworth** was named the International League's Batter of the Week on April 8th. Cronenworth went 13-for-18 with three RBI's, five doubles and eight runs scored over four games against the Charlotte Knights. Those statistics also lead the International League, along with 18 total bases and a .737 OBP.

The award is the first of it's kind for Cronenworth, who has never won a Batter of the Week honor. However, Cronenworth has won Midseason All-Star honors in the New York-Penn League (2015), Midwest League (2016) and Florida State League (2017).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Struck out one batter over two innings in the Battle of the Bull City against the Duke Blue Devils. Did not allow a hit or walk anyone in first appearance at Durham Bulls Athletic Park.

**2019 SPRING TRAINING:** Went 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP) in six Spring Training appearances. Recorded six strikeouts and one walk plus notching a save in a March 26th win over Detroit.

**2018 SEASON:** Spent the entire season with Columbus (AAA), going 3-3 with a 3.79 ERA (71.1 IP) in 15 games. Was placed on the Major League 60-Day Disabled List by Cleveland on March 29th with a left knee sprain and was outrighted to Columbus on July 21st.

**2017 SEASON:** Spent most of the season with Columbus (AAA), going 10-5 with a 3.03 ERA (116.0 IP) in 19 games. Made one rehab appearance with Lake County (A). Played five games in Cleveland, going 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (20.2 IP).

**2016 SEASON:** Went 12-8 with a 3.56 ERA (154.1 IP) between Columbus (24 games) and Cleveland (4 games). Made Major League debut on May 30th, going 4.1 IP, allowing one hit and no runs, while striking out two. Earned first Major League win in first his first start on September 30th, going 5.0 IP, allowing one earned run and striking out four

**MR. CLUTCH:** Became just the second pitcher in MLB history to debut in MLB Postseason after just one Major League game. Called upon to make a spot start, Merritt started Game 5 of the ALCS in Toronto, pitching 4.1 IP of scoreless baseball, allowing two hits and striking out three in a series clinching win.

**2015 SEASON:** Split the season between Akron (AA) and Columbus (AAA), going 10-7 with a 3.57 ERA (141.0 IP) with Akron (22 games) and going 2-0 with a 4.20 ERA (30.0 IP) with Columbus (five games)

**2014 SEASON:** Notched Carolina League Midseason and Postseason All-Star honors with Carolina (A+). Went 13-3 with a 2.58 ERA (160.1 IP) in 28 games, while striking out a career high 127 batters.

**STAYING IN CONTROL:** Owns a career BB per 9 inning rate of 1.39/9 IP, making him one of the most accurate and steady pitchers in the Rays system. Merritt has carried that over to the Major League as well, with just four walks in 31.2 IP, plus none in the postseason.
