TODAY'S GAME

The Durham Bulls will play game three of a four game series against the Columbus Clippers on Saturday at Durham Bulls Athletic Park after game two was postponed due to rain. Right-hander Aaron Slegers makes his home debut for the Bulls and will face off against Clippers right-hander Michael Peoples.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls fell 12-4 in their 2019 home opener against Columbus. Infielder Jake Cronenworth extended his hit-streak to seven games and infielder Mike Brosseau hit his team leading third home run. Clippers pitcher Sean Brady made his second ever start in Triple-A, allowing two earned runs on five hits and earning the win.

BULLS vs. CLIPPERS

In 2019, the Bulls are 0-1 against the Clippers, having been outscored 12-4.

In 2018, the Bulls went 2-5 against the Clippers. The Bulls offense was lifted by catcher Adam Moore, who tallied six RBI's over the seven games played. Despite being shutout in three of seven games, the Bulls still notched 36 runs, thanks to nine and 15-run victories over the course of the season against the Clippers. Columbus starter Adam Plutko recored two of his seven wins to pace the Clippers pitching staff in the season series.

BULL-ET POINTS

- **Andrew Velazquez** hit a home run in the first at-bat of the season. The last time this occurred was in 2017, when Johnny Field opened the season with a home run at Gwinnett.
- Velazquez set a career high in RBI's with five on April 4th.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez recorded two four-hit games on back-to-back days (April 4th-April 5th).
- **Jake Cronenworth** tied his career high in hits with four on April 5th and April 6th, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A)
- Cronenworth extended his season-opening hit streak to seven games on April 11th.
- **Mike Brosseau** leads the Bulls with three home runs, ranking tied for fifth in the International League
- **Nate Lowe** hit his second home run on April 7th in just four games, the fastest he has ever reached this mark. Lowe hit 27 home runs last season.
- The Bulls suffered their worst home opening defeat since 2015 (losing 8-0 vs. Norfolk)
- Durham is 3 games back for the first time since September 1st, 2016
- The Bulls pitching staff did not walk a batter on April 9th, the first time that's been done since Game Three of the Governors' Cup Finals against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on September 13th, 2018.
- The 11 runs by the Bulls offense is the most on Opening Day since 2013 (11 at Norfolk).

THE GOOD AND THE BAD

Bulls pitching has struggled to stop the flow of runs, but have been punching batters out at an impressive rate. Bulls relievers have stood out the most, with 50 strikeouts in 38.2 innings pitched. **Hoby Milner** has been effective, striking out 10 batters over just 5.1 innings and **Emilio Pagan** remains the most dependable reliever on the staff, with seven strikeouts in four relief appearances and no earned runs. As a whole, the Bulls pitching staff has notched 72 strikeouts and limited opposing batters to just 16 walks, which is good for best in the International League. Making the mark all the more impressive is the fact that Bulls pitchers have pitched 59.0 innings, good for second fewest in the International League.

POWER SURGE

Infielder **Mike Brosseau** entered the 2019 season having hit 20 home runs over his three season MiLB career. Brosseau now has three home runs in just six games this year, tallying seven RBI's in the process. The undrafted free agent has been a rising star in the Rays system, and is now feasting on both left and right-handed pitching in the International League.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

The Bulls offense is prolific and much of it has to do with how well-rounded the lineup is. Five players are hitting over .340 and five different players have tallied at least one home run. Nine of the 13 players have notched an extra-base-hit, 12 of the 13 position players have recored a hit and all 13 have reached safely in the first six games. Leadoff hitter Andrew Velazquez leads the team in RBI's with nine and the power hitters Nate Lowe and Mike Brosseau have combined for five home runs and 12 RBI's, providing a fearsome middle of the order. That is on top of Jake Cronenworth, who leads the International League in several categories including batting average (.533), hits (16) and doubles (6), while ranking third in total bases (22).

NOTE-A-BULLS

Infielder **Jake Cronenworth** was named the International League's Batter of the Week on April 8th. Cronenworth went 13-for-18 with three RBI's, five doubles and eight runs scored over four games against the Charlotte Knights.

The award is the first of it's kind for Cronenworth, who has never won a Batter of the Week honor. However, Cronenworth has won Midseason All-Star honors in the New York-Penn League (2015), Midwest League (2016) and Florida State League (2017).

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed six earned runs on eight hits in his Bulls debut. Walked one batter and struck out three, while allowing a career high three home runs in a 12-10 loss at Charlotte.

2019 SPRING TRAINING: Made one appearance against Columbus in 2018, going 6.0 innings, allowing three earned runs and striking out four while earning a no-decision. Slegers and Rochester ultimately lost the game in extra innings 4-3.

2019 SPRING TRAINING: Made four appearances out of the bullpen for Pittsburgh, going 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP). Struck out three and walked three in that span.

2018 SEASON: Split the season between Rochester (AAA) and Minnesota, going 5-7 with a 3.80 ERA (85.1 IP) with Rochester (15 games) and going 1-1 with 5.27 ERA (13.2 IP) with Minnesota (four games). Placed on the Major League Disabled List on July 14th, missing over two months with right shoulder inflammation

BRING DURABILITY TO DURHAM: Despite missing two months last season, Slegers has been incredibly durable throughout his career. Slegers ranked fourth in the International League in innings pitched in 2017 and fifth in the Southern League in 2016. Slegers has 686.1 IP over just 121 games (112 starts) in his MiLB career.

2017 SEASON: Split the season between Rochester (AAA) and Minnesota, going 15-4 with a 3.40 ERA (148.1 IP) with Rochester (21 games) and going 0-1 with a 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP) with Minnesota (four games). Made Major League debut on August 17th, going 6.1 IP, allowing two hits, two earned runs, walking two and striking out three in a win against Cleveland.

TOWERING ABOVE THE REST: After his Major League debut in 2017, Slegers tied Randy Johnson, Chris Young and Eric Hillman in a tie for second place on the Tallest Major League Players in history (6'10"), behind only Jon Rauch (6'11").

2016 SEASON: Spent the entire season with Chattanooga (AA), going 10-7 with a 3.41 ERA (145.1 IP) in 25 games. Went 6-1 with a 2.23 ERA (72.2 IP) in road games (12 games), versus 4-6 with a 4.58 ERA (72.2 IP) in home games (13 games).

2015 SEASON: Split the season between Fort Myers (A+) and Chattanooga (AA), going 8-6 with a 2.87 ERA (119.1 IP) with Fort Myers (19 games) and going 1-4 with a 4.91 ERA (36.2 IP) with Chattanooga (six games). Notched only career nine inning, complete game shutout on May 24th.
