#### TODAY'S GAME

The Durham Bulls will play the series finale of a rain shortened four game series against the Columbus Clippers. Right-hander Casey Sadler makes his first start of the season and will face off against Clippers right-hander Asher Wojciechowski.

#### LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls won their first home game of the season, by a final score of 4-3. Infielder Jake Cronenworth extended his hit-streak to eight games with an RBI single and starting pitcher Aaron Slegers became the second starter to go five or more innings this season. Emilio Pagan secured his team leading second save of the season in the ninth inning.

#### BULLS VS. CLIPPERS

In 2019, the Bulls are 1-1 against the Clippers, having been outscored 15-8.

In 2018, the Bulls went 2-5 against the Clippers. The Bulls offense was lifted by catcher Adam Moore, who tallied six RBI's over the seven games played. Despite being shutout in three of seven games, the Bulls still notched 36 runs, thanks to nine and 15-run victories over the course of the season againt the Clippers. Columbus starter Adam Plutko recored two of his seven wins to pace the Clippers pitching staff in the season series.

#### BULL-ET POINTS

- Andrew Velazquez hit a home run in the first at-bat of the season. The last time this occurred was in 2017, when Johnny Field opened the season with a home run at Gwinnett.
- Velazquez set a career high in RBI's with five on April 4th.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez recorded two four-hit games on back-to-back days (April 4th-April 5th).
- Jake Cronenworth tied his career high in hits with four on April 5th and April 6th, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A)
- Cronenworth extended his season-opening hit streak to eight games on April 13th.
- Mike Brosseau leads the Bulls with three home runs, ranking tied for fifth in the International League.
- Brosseau notched a single in the 5th inning on a 10-pitch at-bat, the longest for a Bulls hitter this season. His longest prior at-bat this season was six pitches.
- Nate Lowe hit his second home run on April 7th in just four games, the fastest he has ever reached this mark. Lowe hit 27 home runs last season.
- The Bulls suffered their worst home opening defeat since 2015 (losing 8-0 vs. Norfolk).
- The Bulls pitching staff did not walk a batter on April 9th, the first time that's been done since Game Three of the Governors' Cup Finals against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on September 13th, 2018.

#### THE GOOD AND THE BAD

Bulls pitching has struggled to stop the flow of runs, but have been punching batters out at an impressive rate. Bulls relievers have stood out the most, with 58 strikeouts in 42.2 innings pitched. **Hoby Milner** has been effective, striking out 10 batters over just 5.1 innings and **Emilio Pagan** remains the most dependable reliever on the staff, with ten strikeouts in five relief appearances and no earned runs. As a whole, the Bulls pitching staff has notched 83 strikeouts and limited opposing batters to just 21 walks, which is good for best in the International League. Making the mark all the more impressive is the fact that Bulls pitchers have pitched 68.0 innings, good for the fewest in the International League.

#### POWER SURGE

Infielder **Mike Brosseau** entered the 2019 season having hit 20 home runs over his three season MiLB career. Brosseau now has three home runs in just six games this year, tallying seven RBI's in the process. The undrafted free agent has been a rising star in the Rays system, and is now feasting on both left and right-handed pitching in the International League.

#### SPREADING THE WEALTH

The Bulls offense is prolific and much of it has to do with how well-rounded the lineup is. Six players are hitting over .300 and five different players have tallied at least one home run. Nine of the 13 players have notched an extra-base-hit, every position player has recored a hit and all 13 have reached safely in the first six games. Leadoff hitter Andrew Velazquez leads the team in RBI's with nine and the power hitters Nate Lowe and Mike Brosseau have combined for five home runs and 12 RBI's, providing a fearsome middle of the order. That is on top of Jake Cronenworth, who leads the International League in several categories including batting average (.515), hits (17) and doubles (6).

#### NOTE-A-BULLS

Infielder **Jake Cronenworth** was named the International League's Batter of the Week on April 8th. Cronenworth went 13-for-18 with three RBI's, five doubles and eight runs scored over four games against the Charlotte Knights. The award is the first of it's kind for Cronenworth, who has never won a Batter of the Week honor. However, Cronenworth has won Midseason All-Star honors in the New York-Penn League (2015), Midwest League (2016) and Florida State League (2017).

Catcher **Mac James** tallied his first hit of the season at the perfect moment, recording an RBI single that put the Bulls in front for good on April 13th. James is up to five RBI's in 18 games with the Bulls.

<u>LAST TIME OUT</u>: Pitched four innings in relief of starter Ryan Merritt, allowing one earned run on five hits. Sadler walked just one batter while striking out seven batters, a season high for a reliever.

**FAMILIAR FOE:** Sadler faced Columbus six times in 2018 while with Indianapolis, allowing a combined six earned runs on 17 hits (two starts) over 16.2 innings pitched.

**2019 Spring Training:** Made nine appearances for Tampa Bay, including one start on March 10th. Went 1-1 with a 3.94 ERA (16.0 IP) while walking five and striking out 14 batters.

**2018 Season:** Spent most of the season with Indianapolis (AAA), going 6-5 with a 3.39 ERA (77.0 IP) in 27 games. Made two appearances with Pittsburgh, allowing four earned runs over 4.1 IP, striking out three. Went 2-1 with a 2.08 ERA (21.2 IP) during day games (seven games), versus 4-4 with a 3.90 ERA (55.1 IP) during night games (20 games).

**LONG ROAD BACK:** After pitching with Pittsburgh during the 2015 MLB season, Sadler underwent Tommy John Surgery in 2016. Sadler finally returned to the Major League level on August 9th, 1,215 days after his last appearance in the Major's with Pittsburgh.

**2017 SEASON:** Spent most of the season rehabbing from Tommy John Surgery. Split the season between Bradenton (A+), Altoona (AA) and Indianapolis (AAA), going 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP) with Bradenton (six games), going 2-2 with a 3.91 ERA (48.1 IP) with Altoona (10 games) and going 1-1 with a 6.38 ERA (18.1 IP) with Indianapolis (10 games).

2016 Season: Missed the entire season due to Tommy John Surgery
