## TODAY's GAME

The Durham Bulls begin a four game series against their division rival Norfolk Tides on Monday night at Harbor Park Stadium in Norfolk, Virginia. Right-hander Jake Faria makes his third start of the season and will face the recently optioned left-hander from Baltimore, Josh Rogers.

## LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls suffered a late inning loss in the series finale against the Columbus Clippers, by a final score of 3-1. The Bulls tied the game in the eighth inning off a Nate Lowe double, but gave up a two-run home run to Clippers catcher Eric Haase to ultimately suffer another series loss.

## BULLS vs. TIDES

In 2018, the Bulls went 16-6 against the Tides, outscoring the Tides 112-90. 13 different pitchers recorded a win for the Bulls, including Kyle Bird who recorded two of his three wins. Reliever Jaime Schultz tallied two wins and a save and Hoby Milner recorded two additional saves. The 16 wins were the most against any opponent for the Bulls last season.

## BULL-ET POINTS

- **Andrew Velazquez** hit a home run in the first at-bat of the season. The last time this occurred was in 2017, when Johnny Field opened the season with a home run at Gwinnett.
- Velazquez set a career high in RBI's with five on April 4th.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez recorded two four-hit games on back-to-back days (April 4th-April 5th).
- **Jake Cronenworth** tied his career high in hits with four on April 5th and April 6th, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A)
- Cronenworth lost his eight game hit streak on April 14th, but extended his season-opening on-base streak to nine games.
- **Nick Solak** extended his on-base streak to eight games on April 14th
- **Mike Brosseau** leads the Bulls with three home runs, ranking tied for fifth in the International League.
- Brosseau notched a single in the 5th inning on a 10-pitch at-bat, on April 14th the longest for a Bulls hitter this season. His longest prior at-bat this season was six pitches.
- **Nate Lowe** hit his second home run on April 7th in just four games, the fastest he has ever reached this mark. Lowe hit 27 home runs last season.
- The Bulls suffered their worst home opening defeat since 2015 (losing 8-0 vs. Norfolk).
- The Bulls pitching staff did not walk a batter on April 9th, the first time that's been done since Game Three of the Governors' Cup Finals against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on September 13th, 2018.

## HOT AND COLD

Bulls pitching has recorded an International League low of 77 innings pitched. However, they rank third in strikeouts with 100, and have recorded the fewest walks in league with 23. So where is the problem?

The Bulls have allowed 17 home runs in just nine games, good for the third most in the league and second highest rate per game in the league, behind Buffalo. Most have come early in the game, with starting pitchers allowing nine of 17 home runs in just 28.1 innings.

## STEADY RELIEF

While the first inning has become a problem for the Bulls pitching staff (a team high 14 runs allowed), the Bulls have gotten terrific production from their middle relievers. **Mike Franco** is in the midst of a five inning scoreless streak in which he has struck out eight batters and walked no one. **Ryan Merritt** tied a team high for a reliever with seven strikeouts on April 14th (which tied **Casey Sadler**, who also accomplished the feat in middle relief). If the first inning blues can begin to change, the Bulls have a strong lineup of multi-inning relievers to fall back on.

## SPREADING THE WEALTH

The Bulls offense is prolific and much of it has to do with how well-rounded the lineup is. Six players are hitting over .300 and five different players have tallied at least one home run. Nine of the 13 players have notched an extra-base-hit and every position player has recorded a hit and reached safely in the first nine games. Leadoff hitter Andrew Velazquez leads the team in RBI's with nine and the power hitters Nate Lowe and Mike Brosseau have combined for five home runs and 13 RBI's, providing a fearsome middle of the order. The Bulls also have five players with an OBP of over .400, proving the team can reach base in a number of ways.

## NOTE-A-BULLS

Catcher **Mac James** tallied his first hit of the season at the perfect moment for his team, recording an RBI single that put the Bulls in front for good on April 13th. James is up to five RBI's in 18 games with the Bulls.

Infielder **Jake Cronenworth** continues to lead the International League in batting average (.486), hits (17) and doubles (6), while ranking second in OBP (.526).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Won his first game of the season, pitching five shutout innings and allowing just four hits. Faria walked no one and struck out a season high seven batters in the 3-0 win.

**MLB ACTION:** Spent parts of 2017 and 2018 pitching with Tampa Bay, compiling a 9-8 record and a 4.27 ERA over 33 games. Tallied 1.2 Wins Above Replacement in his Major League Career thus far.

**2019 SPRING TRAINING:** Went 1-0 with a 4.15 ERA (8.2 IP) over four appearances, making one start. Held opposing batters to a .258 BAA, while striking out eight and walking two.

**FAVORITE PLACE TO PLAY:** Faria was stellar in two appearances against the Tides last season, allowing just five hits and no runs over 11.2 innings pitched. Faria struck out 12 batters and walked four over that span.

**2018 SEASON:** Split the season between Durham and Tampa Bay, going 2-1 with a 4.60 ERA (seven games) with Durham and 4-4 with a 5.40 ERA (17 games) with Tampa Bay. Was placed on the Major League Disabled list with a left oblique strain on May 23rd and was activated and returned to Durham on August 16th after rehabbing with Charlotte (A+).

**2017 SEASON:** Split the season between Durham (6-1, 3.07 ERA) and Tampa Bay (5-4, 3.43 ERA) in 27 games. Made Major League debut on June 7th, going 6.1 IP, allowing one earned run and striking out five.
