#### TODAY'S GAME

The Durham Bulls will play game two of a four game series against the Norfolk Tides. Right-hander Andrew Kittredge makes his first start of the season and fifth appearance, facing off against Tides right-hander Gabriel Ynoa.

#### LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls started quickly, but fell 10-6 in their first game against the Norfolk Tides this season. Jake Smolinski hit his first home run of the season and Andrew Velazquez became the first Bull with double digit RBI's. DJ Stewart and Ryan Mountcastle took over for Norfolk and hit back-to-back home runs in the third inning to change the momentum in the Tides favor.

#### Bulls vs. Tides

In 2019, the Bulls are 0-1 against the Tides, having been outscored 10-6.

In 2018, the Bulls went 16-6 against the Tides, outscoring the Tides 112-90. 13 different pitchers recorded a win for the Bulls, including Kyle Bird who recored two of his three wins. Reliever Jaime Schultz tallied two wins and a save and Hoby Milner recorded two additional saves. The 16 wins were the most against any opponent for the Bulls last season.

#### BULL-ET POINTS

- Andrew Velazquez hit a home run in the first at-bat of the season. The last time this occurred was in 2017, when Johnny Field opened the season with a home run at Gwinnett.
- Velazquez set a career high in RBI's with five on April 4th.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez recorded two four-hit games on back-to-back days (April 4th-April 5th).
- Jake Cronenworth tied his career high in hits with four on April 5th and April 6th, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A)
- Cronenworth lost his eight game hit streak on April 14th, but extended his season-opening on-base streak to nine games.
- Nick Solak extended his on-base streak to nine games on April 15th
- Mike Brosseau leads the Bulls with three home runs, ranking tied for fifth in the International League.
- Brosseau notched a single in the 5th inning on a 10-pitch atbat, on April 14th the longest for a Bulls hitter this season. His longest prior at-bat this season was six pitches.
- Nate Lowe hit his second home run on April 7th in just four games, the fastest he has ever reached this mark. Lowe hit 27 home runs last season.
- Colin Poche allowed five runs on April 15th, the most of his career, passing the three runs he allowed in 2016 with Hillsboro.
- The Bulls pitching staff did not walk a batter on April 9th, the first time that's been done since Game Three of the Governors' Cup Finals against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on September 13th, 2018.

#### HOT AND COLD

Bulls pitching has recorded just 85 innings pitched good for the third lowest in the International League. However, they rank tied for second in strikeouts with 112, and have recorded the second fewest walks in league with 29. So where is the problem?

The Bulls have allowed 19 home runs in just ten games, good for the most in the league and second highest rate per game in the league, behind Buffalo. Most have come early in the game, with starting pitchers allowing 11 of 19 home runs in just 32 innings.

#### STEADY RELIEF

While the first inning has become a problem for the Bulls pitching staff (a team high 14 runs allowed), the Bulls have gotten terrific production from their middle relievers. Mike Franco is in the midst of a five inning scoreless streak in which he has struck out eight batters and walked no one. Ryan Merritt tied a team high for a reliever with seven strikeouts on April 14th (which tied Casey Sadler, who also accomplished the feat in middle relief). If the first inning blues can begin to change, the Bulls have a strong lineup of multi-inning relievers to fall back on.

#### VERSATILITY IS KEY

Andrew Velazquez is already off to a fast start for the Bulls this season. His 10 RBI's lead the team, while also hitting .333 with a home run, five doubles and a triple in just nine games. However, Velazquez's bat isn't the only one doing the talking.

Velazquez has moved all over the diamond on defense, playing second base, shortstop and center field. Over the course of his career, Velazquez has also played third base, left field and right field. He also recorded the Bulls' second outfield assist of the season on April 15th. His speed is also a factor, as Velazquez is just six stolen bases away from 150 in his MiLB career over 610 games played.

#### NOTE-A-BULLS

Pitcher Oliver Drake makes his return to Norfolk, where he recorded 33 saves over three seasons (2011, 2015-16) with the club, good for the most by any player since they became an Orioles affiliate in 2007.

Infielder Jake Cronenworth continues to lead the International League in batting average (.486), hits (17) and doubles (6), while ranking second in OBP (.526).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Pitched his second straight scoreless relief outing, allowing just two hits over one inning against Columbus. Didn't walk a single batter and struck out one.

**TAKE Two:** Kittredge made two appearances against Norfolk last season, including his only start of the season. Kittredge allowed two earned runs over 3.1 innings, striking out five batters.

**2019 SPRING TRAINING:** Played in nine games for Tampa Bay, going 0-0 with a 1.50 ERA in 12 innings. Struck out 10 batters, while walking just four and allowed seven total hits.

**TRENDING UP:** After a shaky opening day appearance, Kittredge has allowed four hits and struck out five batters over his last three appearances. He has also not walked a single batter and given up no earned runs.

**2018 Season:** Split the season between Durham and Tampa Bay, going 6-0 with a 2.74 ERA (46.0 IP) in 21 games for Durham and 3-2 with a 7.75 ERA (38.1 IP) in 33 games for Tampa Bay.
