### TODAY'S GAME

The Durham Bulls wrap up a four game series against the Norfolk Tides on Thursday afternoon in Norfolk, VA. Right-hander Aaron Slegers takes the hill and will face Tides left-hander Keegan Akin.

### LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls snapped a three game losing streak with a 5-4 win over the Tides. Down for much of the game, the Bulls rallied to score two runs in the ninth inning off Luis Gonzalez and Oliver Drake locked down a save against his former team. Mike Brosseau and Christian Arroyo each tallied two RBI's and Mike Franco extended his scoreless streak to 8.0 innings in the win.

### BULLS vs. TIDES

In 2019, the Bulls are 1-2 against the Tides, having been outscored 21-17.

In 2018, the Bulls went 16-6 against the Tides, outscoring the Tides 112-90. 13 different pitchers recorded a win for the Bulls, including Kyle Bird who recored two of his three wins. Reliever Jaime Schultz tallied two wins and a save and Hoby Milner recorded two additional saves. The 16 wins were the most against any opponent for the Bulls last season.

### BULL-ET POINTS

- **Andrew Velazquez** set a career high in RBI's with five on April 4th.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez recorded two four-hit games on back-to-back days (April 4th-April 5th).
- **Jake Cronenworth** tied his career high in hits with four on April 5th and April 6th, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A).
- Cronenworth lost his eight game hit streak on April 14th, but extended his season-opening on-base streak to 11 games on April 17th.
- Cronenworth tallied his 5th stolen base on April 17th. He did not reach that mark until June 17th last season.
- **Nick Solak** extended his on-base streak to 11 games on April 17th.
- **Mike Brosseau** notched a single in the 5th inning on a 10-pitch at-bat, on April 14th the longest for a Bulls hitter this season. His longest prior at-bat this season was six pitches.
- Brosseau reached double digit RBI's on April 16th. He didn't reach that mark until May 4th last season.
- **Colin Poche** allowed five runs on April 15th, the most of his career, passing the three runs he allowed in 2016 with Hillsboro.
- The Bulls pitching staff did not walk a batter on April 9th, the first time that's been done since Game Three of the Governors' Cup Finals against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on September 13th, 2018.

### HOT AND COLD

Bulls pitching has recorded just 102.2 innings pitched good for the lowest mark in the International League. However, they rank fourth in strikeouts with 129, just eight behind Rochester, and have recorded the fewest walks in league with 34. So where is the problem?

The Bulls have allowed 21 home runs in just 12 games, good for the most in the league. Most have come early in the game, with starting pitchers allowing 11 of 21 home runs in just 37 innings. Bulls pitching as a whole has allowed 70 of their 82 runs in the first six innings.

### STEADY RELIEF

While the first few innings have become a problem for the Bulls pitching staff (48 of 82 runs allowed have come in the first four innings), the Bulls have gotten terrific production from their middle relievers. **Mike Franco** is in the midst of an eight inning scoreless streak in which he has struck out 10 batters and walked no one. **Ryan Merritt** tied a team high for a reliever with seven strikeouts on April 14th (which tied **Casey Sadler**, who also accomplished the feat in middle relief). **Oliver Drake** has allowed just two hits all season, holding opposing batters to a .087 BAA and is on a six inning scoreless streak of his own. If the early inning blues can begin to change, the Bulls have a strong lineup of multi-inning relievers to fall back on.

### VERSATILITY IS KEY

**Andrew Velazquez** is already off to a fast start for the Bulls this season. His 11 RBI's rank second on the team, while also hitting .308 with a home run, five doubles and a triple in just 11 games. However, Velazquez's bat isn't the only one doing the talking.

Velazquez has moved all over the diamond on defense, playing second base, shortstop and center field. Over the course of his career, Velazquez has also played third base, left field and right field. He also recorded the Bulls' second outfield assist of the season on April 15th. His speed is also a factor, as Velazquez is just six stolen bases away from 150 in his MiLB career over 610 games played.

### NOTE-A-BULLS

Pitcher **Oliver Drake** makes his return to Norfolk, where he recorded 33 saves over three seasons (2011, 2015-16) with the club, good for the most by any player since they became an Orioles affiliate in 2007.

Infielder **Jake Cronenworth** continues to lead the International League in batting average (.67), hits (21), ranking tied for third in doubles (6) and ranking third in OBP (.500).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Pitched five innings, allowing one earned run on six hits, while walking three and striking out three in a win against Columbus. Became the second Bulls starter to go at least five innings this season (Jake Faria).

**LONG AWAITED RETURN:** Slegers will make his first appearance against the Tides since 2017. In his last start, Slegers went 7.1 innings, allowing two earned runs on eight hits, while striking out six in the win.

**2019 SPRING TRAINING:** Made four appearances out of the bullpen for Pittsburgh, going 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP). Struck out three and walked three in that span.

**2018 SEASON:** Split the season between Rochester (AAA) and Minnesota, going 5-7 with a 3.80 ERA (85.1 IP) with Rochester (15 games) and going 1-1 with 5.27 ERA (13.2 IP) with Minnesota (four games). Placed on the Major League Disabled List on July 14th, missing over two months with right shoulder inflammation

**BRING DURABILITY TO DURHAM:** Despite missing two months last season, Slegers has been incredibly durable throughout his career. Slegers ranked fourth in the International League in innings pitched in 2017 and fifth in the Southern League in 2016. Slegers has 686.1 IP over just 121 games (112 starts) in his MiLB career.

**2017 SEASON:** Split the season between Rochester (AAA) and Minnesota, going 15-4 with a 3.40 ERA (148.1 IP) with Rochester (21 games) and going 0-1 with a 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP) with Minnesota (four games). Made Major League debut on August 17th, going 6.1 IP, allowing two hits, two earned runs, walking two and striking out three in a win against Cleveland.

**TOWERING ABOVE THE REST:** After his Major League debut in 2017, Slegers tied Randy Johnson, Chris Young and Eric Hillman in a tie for second place on the Tallest Major League Players in history (6'10"), behind only Jon Rauch (6'11").

**2016 SEASON:** Spent the entire season with Chattanooga (AA), going 10-7 with a 3.41 ERA (145.1 IP) in 25 games. Went 6-1 with a 2.23 ERA (72.2 IP) in road games (12 games), versus 4-6 with a 4.58 ERA (72.2 IP) in home games (13 games).

**2015 SEASON:** Split the season between Fort Myers (A+) and Chattanooga (AA), going 8-6 with a 2.87 ERA (119.1 IP) with Fort Myers (19 games) and going 1-4 with a 4.91 ERA (36.2 IP) with Chattanooga (six games). Notched only career nine inning, complete game shutout on May 24th.

**2014 SEASON:** Split the season between Cedar Rapids (A) and Fort Myers (A+), going 7-7 with a 4.53 ERA (113.1 IP) with Cedar Rapids (20 games) and going 2-1 with a 3.32 ERA (19.0 IP) with Chattanooga (three games).
