TODAY'S GAME

The Durham Bulls return home to Durham Bulls Athletic Park for a doubleheader against the Gwinnett Stripers. Left-hander Ryan Merritt will take the ball for game one against Stripers left-hander Kolby Allard. The Bulls will send right-hander Cole Sulser for game two to face off against Stripers right-hander Elian Leyva.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls blew a four run lead in the bottom of the eighth inning in a 8-5 loss at Norfolk. Aaron Slegers became the first Bulls pitcher to go seven innings, allowing just three hits and two earned runs. Mike Brosseau added his team leading 13th RBI, but the Tides recorded six runs in the bottom of the eighth to go in front for good.

BULLS vs. STRIPERS

In 2019, the Bulls are 1-1 against the Stripers, having been outscored 7-5. Pitchers Jake Faria and Casey Sadler each recorded seven strikeouts over the two game span, with the Bulls notching their first shutout of the season. Andrew Velazquez and Mike Brosseau each notched an RBI, while Mac James recorded his first RBI of the season.

BULL-ET POINTS

- **Andrew Velazquez** set a career high in RBI's with five on April 4th.
- After tallying just two four-hit games in his career, Velazquez recorded two four-hit games on back-to-back days (April 4th-April 5th).
- **Jake Cronenworth** tied his career high in hits with four on April 5th and April 6th, marking the first he's accomplished this since 2016 with Bowling Green (A).
- Cronenworth lost his eight game hit streak on April 14th, but extended his season-opening on-base streak to 12 games on April 18th.
- Cronenworth tallied his 5th stolen base on April 17th. He did not reach that mark until June 17th last season.
- **Nick Solak** extended his on-base streak to 12 games on April 18th.
- **Mike Brosseau** reached double digit RBI's on April 16th. He didn't reach that mark until May 4th last season.
- **Colin Poche** allowed five runs on April 15th, the most of his career, passing the three runs he allowed in 2016 with Hillsboro.
- **Aaron Slegers** recorded the first Bulls quality start of the season on April 19th, allowing just three hits and two runs over seven innings.
- The Bulls recorded their 1,400th loss in their International League history on April 18th.
- The Bulls pitching staff did not walk a batter on April 9th, the first time that's been done since Game Three of the Governors' Cup Finals against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on September 13th, 2018.

WELCOME ADDITION

The Bulls were expected to break camp with infielder **Christian Arroyo** on their roster, until a need arose in Tampa Bay that saw Arroyo earn the call up. Arroyo was optioned to Durham on April 9th and since that time has been stellar. Arroyo is hitting .333 with one home run and six RBI's in just eight games with the Bulls. Arroyo played 46 games with the Bulls last season recording two home runs and 20 RBI's and is on pace for far more this season.

STREAK CHECK

While the results for the Bulls have been mixed, there are a number of on-going streaks for both pitchers and hitters. Infielders **Jake Cronenworth** and **Nick Solak** are on season opening 12-game on-base streaks and **Andrew Velazquez** is in the middle of six-game hit streak, tied for the second longest of the season.

In the bullpen, reliever **Mike Franco** continues to impress, with eight straight scoreless innings, in which he has allowed four hits and struck out 10. **Oliver Drake** has been incredible as well, one six inning scoreless streak, allowing just one hit and striking out 10.

VERSATILITY IS KEY

Andrew Velazquez is already off to a fast start for the Bulls this season. His 11 RBI's rank second on the team, while also hitting .309 with a home run, six doubles and a triple in just 12 games. However, Velazquez's bat isn't the only one doing the talking.

Velazquez has moved all over the diamond on defense, playing second base, shortstop and center field. Over the course of his career, Velazquez has also played third base, left field and right field. He also recorded the Bulls' second outfield assist of the season on April 15th. His speed is also a factor, as Velazquez is just five stolen bases away from 150 in his MiLB career over 610 games played.

NOTE-A-BULLS

Infielder **Jake Cronenworth** continues to lead the International League in batting average (.440), hits (21), doubles (7). Infielder **Nate Lowe** ranks tied for second in the International League in walks (11).

Pitcher **Austin Pruitt** (240) is chasing the Bulls Triple-A all-time strikeout record, with just 33 needed to pass the leader Jason Stanbridge (272).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his first appearance out of the bullpen, striking out a season high seven batters and allowing just two hits. Merritt set the season high for strikeouts by a reliever in the outing.

2019 SPRING TRAINING: Went 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP) in six Spring Training appearances. Recorded six strikeouts and one walk plus notching a save in a March 26th win over Detroit.

2018 SEASON: Spent the entire season with Columbus (AAA), going 3-3 with a 3.79 ERA (71.1 IP) in 15 games. Was placed on the Major League 60-Day Disabled List by Cleveland on March 29th with a left knee sprain and was outrighted to Columbus on July 21st.

2017 SEASON: Spent most of the season with Columbus (AAA), going 10-5 with a 3.03 ERA (116.0 IP) in 19 games. Made one rehab appearance with Lake County (A). Played five games in Cleveland, going 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (20.2 IP).

2016 SEASON: Went 12-8 with a 3.56 ERA (154.1 IP) between Columbus (24 games) and Cleveland (4 games). Made Major League debut on May 30th, going 4.1 IP, allowing one hit and no runs, while striking out two. Earned first Major League win in first his first start on September 30th, going 5.0 IP, allowing one earned run and striking out four

MR. CLUTCH: Became just the second pitcher in MLB history to debut in MLB Postseason after just one Major League game. Called upon to make a spot start, Merritt started Game 5 of the ALCS in Toronto, pitching 4.1 IP of scoreless baseball, allowing two hits and striking out three in a series clinching win.

2015 SEASON: Split the season between Akron (AA) and Columbus (AAA), going 10-7 with a 3.57 ERA (141.0 IP) with Akron (22 games) and going 2-0 with a 4.20 ERA (30.0 IP) with Columbus (five games)

2014 SEASON: Notched Carolina League Midseason and Postseason All-Star honors with Carolina (A+). Went 13-3 with a 2.58 ERA (160.1 IP) in 28 games, while striking out a career high 127 batters.

STAYING IN CONTROL: Owns a career BB per 9 inning rate of 1.39/9 IP, making him one of the most accurate and steady pitchers in the Rays system. Merritt has carried that over to the Major League as well, with just four walks in 31.2 IP, plus none in the postseason.
