

The 2021 season started with a bang for the Patriots, as outfielder **Estevan Florial** put on an offensive clinic.

Baseball America's No. 10 Yankees prospect hit .318 with four home runs, six RBI and an on-base percentage of .400.

Somerset's starters and bullpen put on a show, with two shutout wins over the six-game series. **Luis Gil**, the Yankees' fourth overall prospect according to *Baseball America*, threw a gem for his first appearance at TD Bank Ballpark. The righty struck out six batters and allowed just two hits over 3.2 innings of work.

The Patriots took to the road for the beginning of a long two-week stretch away from TD Bank Ballpark.

Patriots' batters had six hits or less in each game, but still managed to show off some timely hitting. **Thomas Milone** belted two home runs in the series, bringing his season total to three.

Gil threw four innings with eight strikeouts, while **Glenn Otto** struck out eight over 5.1 innings. **Greg Weissert** collected his first save of the year when he struck out all three batters he faced Friday night.

The team also got two late home runs from Oswaldo Cabrera and Dermis Garcia to win Saturday night.




Somerset finished their 12-game road trip with a six-game sweep of the Yard Goats.

Dermis Garcia fueled the offense with 11 RBI in the series, and now has a ten-game hitting streak entering this week's series. In both Thursday and Friday night's games, everyone in the lineup had at least one hit.

The story of the series, however, was strikeouts. The staff tallied 80 strikeouts in their sweep of Hartford.

Otto threw a gem on Friday night when he struck out 14 of the 16 batters he saw in his 5.1 inning start.

Glenn Otto has been a force in Somerset's rotation to start the season.

The anticipation surrounding the return of minor league baseball in 2021 could be felt in all parts of the country. After the cancelation of the 2020 season due to the coronavirus pandemic, players were unable to continue their training as planned.

This pause affected the development and production of many players and will affect baseball for years to come, but Somerset Patriots starting pitcher **Glenn Otto** doesn't seem to have missed a beat. Seemingly unaffected by hiatus, the righty has collected 28 strikeouts and managed a 3.78 ERA over his first three starts this year.

Otto attended Rice University in Houston, Texas, where he played the role of a reliever. Over three seasons, he held a 2.61 ERA with 222 strikeouts in 82 appearances. His performance in college caught the eyes of Yankee scouts, who selected him in the fifth round of the 2017 Draft alongside fellow Yankees pitcher Clarke Schmidt. Otto played the majority of his first season with the club at their Low-A Staten Island affiliate.

Otto's 2018 assignment was to the Charleston River Dogs. However, he only made two starts that season, as he suffered from a blood clot in his right shoulder.

"That blood clot, it was very surprising," Otto said this year.



"It was a little scary at times because of the symptoms I had; I had never seen anything like it... I was pitching through a little bit of pain in my hand and some different feelings because I had never heard of anything like that before."

Only about 10% of blood clots happen in the upper body, so it would have been easy for Otto to be cynical about how this injury held him back from continuing on his path to development. Still, he saw it as a learning experience. "I learned a lot through the injury as well. How to prevent injuries, how to prepare myself for starts and workload, so I don't think it was by accident, I am thankful for those injuries because I wouldn't be here without them."

Otto returned to the mound in 2019, where he faced a challenge getting back into his rhythm. His walk rate and ERA shot up, and he seemed to struggle to get batters out. Walks have haunted Otto since college, where he tallied 87. In his first three years in the minors, he gave away 48 free passes.

He has been a fastball curveball pitcher in the past, but this season, he has utilized all four pitches in his arsenal to collect strikeouts in each of his starts this year. This offseason, he developed a slider and worked on a changeup to be his fourth pitch.

“The slider’s been a great pitch for me. I’ve always been comfortable with the curveball throwing it a lot in college as a reliever there,” Otto said when discussing his pitching rotation. “The changeup, it’s a good pitch. It’s definitely my least used pitch, I’ll probably use it 10% of the time, but it’s a reliable pitch going through a lineup a third time.”

Otto has had to change his mentality and skills from those of a reliever to those of a starter.

The addition of these two pitches allows him to go deeper into games with confidence.

In his first start this season, Otto earned his first Double-A win when he tossed six scoreless innings to the tune of two hits and six strikeouts.

This nearly perfect performance awarded him the first MiLB Pitcher of the Week award for the 2021 season. His second start added eight more strikeouts to his season total, but he did not have the same shutdown ability as he did in his premiere. The real show came May 20th, where he struck out 14 of the 16 batters he faced. The performance was the definition of dominance, yet Otto remembers not feeling like he had his best stuff during warm-ups.

DID YOU KNOW?

Otto came within two strikeouts of the single game all-time Patriots record in his last start on 5/20 @ Hartford. Ray Davis holds Somerset’s strikeout record of 16 set on 7/19/00.

"You ask a lot of pitchers, most of the time if they don't feel very good in the bullpen for some reason or the other, they feel great in the game," Otto said after the start. "That first inning, I came out and everything was where I wanted it. I felt in control, and I knew where I needed to go... I think that first inning was when I knew I could do something special."



And special it was. The 14 strikeouts became a career-high for Otto, and he is excited to continue pushing himself in his upcoming starts.

The Texas native is quietly making a name for himself in baseball, he looks up to some of the best pitchers in the game today. He listed Jacob DeGrom, Max Scherzer and Gerrit Cole as players that he admires. The way they understand their body and what makes them effective is something that he appreciates but is not trying to replicate.



"I think that's important not to compare myself to too many other people. I move differently than DeGrom, I move differently than Gerrit Cole," he said. "I'm just trying to be the best Glenn Otto that I can be right now, and hopefully, one day, that's out there with those guys."

After a start like he's having, it's hard not to see the trajectory of Otto's career laying out in front of him. A 14-strikeout game is no small feat, but Otto has his eyes on the prize.

"I believe that with my strengths, I can go up against anybody and make it a good result. I know that's a career-high for me, 14. Hopefully, we can build on that this season and get that number even higher."

As the team gets farther into the season, Otto will have a longer leash regarding pitch count. If he can manage his pitches and get himself into the seventh inning, double-digit strikeout starts could become a regular thing for this up-and-coming star.



On Sunday, May 23rd, centerfielder **Michael Beltre** was a double shy of hitting for the cycle.

He ended his day versus the Hartford Yard Goats 3-for-4 with a home run, a triple, three runs scored, and two RBI.

On May 24th, he was named the Northeast League Player of the Week by MiLB.

Beltre hit safely in each of the six games over the last week against the Hartford Yard Goats. The first-year Patriot went 13-for-30 (.433) from the plate with one home run, seven RBI, 12 runs scored, and two stolen bases.



In 2017 was one of a dozen Reds minor leaguers to attend a leadership training program at West Point.

The Dominican Republic native now leads the team in batting (.300) and ranks second on the team in on-base percentage (.333). He also leads the Double-A Northeast League in triples (3), is tied for third in stolen bases (5), and is tied for fourth in runs scored (16).

Fisher Cats pitchers held Somerset to just 36 hits over the course of the six-game series. **Simeon Woods Richardson** and **Zach Logue** both tallied eight strikeouts in their starts.


Other leading pitchers for the Cats were relievers **Andrew McInvale** and **Brody Rodnings** who struck out five and six Patriots respectively.

The Fisher Cats took four of six from the Patriots in their first meeting of the season, but if there was a kryptonite, it was their bullpen. The Patriots twice rallied late in New Hampshire, including in the fifth game in the series. That night, both **Oswaldo Cabrera** and **Dermis Garcia** hit home runs in the top of the eighth inning to lead the Patriots to a 5-3 come-from-behind win.

New Hampshire's bullpen allowed at least four runs in each of the last two games of their most recent series against the **Portland Sea Dogs**.

Offensive leader, **Gabriel Moreno**, was trouble for the Patriots the last time the two faced off. With a batting average of .474, Moreno gathered seven RBI including two home runs over the course of the series. He has continued to be a threat in the league and is currently holding a top spot in most offensive categories across the Double-A Northeast league.

Otto Lopez also proved to be a tough out for the pinstripes as he successfully reached base 14 times over the course of the six-game series.




