FRIDAY: The Florida Fire Frogs allowed six runs in an inning for the second time in three days while falling to the St. Lucie Mets, 7-3, on Friday evening at First Data Field. After St. Lucie jumped out in front 1-0, the Fire Frogs tied it on a sacrifice fly from Riley Delgado that brought in Shean Michel who tripped to start the inning. The Mets answered though with six runs on five hits and an error to go back in front 7-1. Cody Bohanek had a three-hit game for the Mets. Quinn Brodey and Luis Carpio got on three times as well.

Riley Unroe doubled home a run in the 8th to extend his hitting and on-base streak. Shean Michel has his on-base streak up to six games entering tonight. Greyson Jenista become the first Fire Frog to hit long balls in consecutive games with his solo shot in the 9th off RHP Briam Campusano.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 20-year-old Freddy Tarnok makes his fifth Advanced-A start and 24th of his career tonight in the 3rd game of the set against the Mets. He was selected in the 3rd Round back in 2017 out of Riverview HS in the Tampa area. He played shortstop throughout his high school career and pitched the last two seasons. He went 7-0 with a 0.66 ERA in 53 innings with 63 strikeouts and 11 walks. He started pitching because they needed some arms and they knew he threw pretty hard. Also hit for a .393 average with 11 doubles and 2 homers. His slot value was \$709,000, he signed to play with the Braves instead of attending D-II University of Tampa. Can touch 95-97 occasionally with his fastball, but usually sits around 92-93.

HITTING CHANGE: It was announced before the game on April 22nd at Clearwater that Danny Santiesteban, who was originally expected to be with Danville in 2019, has been moved up to Florida to become the team's hitting coach. This is Danny's second season in the organization, having been in the same role with the DSL Braves last year. Danny was drafted by the Mariners (42nd, 2003) and the Twins (39th, 2004) organizations, playing four seasons in affiliated ball and three in independent leagues. He played 93 games for the Fort Myers Miracle back in 2008. Former hitting coach, Doug DeVore, and the Florida Fire Frogs parted ways just two days prior after the doubleheader vs. Daytona finished up.

ROSTER ANALYSIS: 12 players on the Fire Frogs Opening Day roster have Advanced-A experience or higher to start this season. 8 of the Top 30 Atlanta Braves prospects according to Baseball America begin the season in Florida, William Contreras (#9), Greyson Jenista (#15), Freddy Tarnok (#16), Tristan Beck (#17), Huascar Ynoa (#19), A.J. Graffanino (#25), Jeffrey Ramos (#26), Israel Wilson (#28) round out those particular prospects.
