**DUNEDIN DARTS PAST FIRE FROGS IN EXTRAS:** In as back-and-forth as a game is gonna get, the Fire Frogs lost their third straight extra-innings contest (dating back to 5/28), 12-11, in the series finale against the D-Jays. The Fire Frogs lost an early 4-0 lead, seeing Dunedin rush out to a 9-4 lead after four frames. Florida scored 7 unanswered runs, but a three-run 10th propelled the Blue Jays to victory. RHP Nolan Kingham surrendered nine runs (six earned) in four innings. RHP Lukas Young shutout the D-Jays over 2.2 stanzas. RHP Troy Bacon set down six of his first seven batters, but then ran into trouble in the 10th. Drew Lugbauer got the Fire Frogs off and running early with a two-run long ball in the second. He also notched a sacrifice fly in the third as part of a 5 RBI night. Andrew Moritz (3-5) and Riley Delgado (2-6) each scored three runs in the contest. Lugbauer's two-out RBI double followed up by Kevin Josephina's RBI knock tied the game at 9 in the 9th and forced extras. Cullen Large, who went 4-6, had a two-out RBI single to plate Cal Stevenson and win the game.

**LUGS LUMBERS UP:** Fire Frogs infielder Drew Lugbauer became the first Florida player to record a five-RBI effort, besting two separate four RBI games from Jeffrey Ramos (4/30 vs LAK + 6/2 vs PMB) and one from Riley Unroe (5/10 at JUP). This was a career-best for Lugs who's previous career mark was 4 RBI on three-separate occasions.

**DELGADO DIGS IN:** The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 66 of the 79 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 59 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Dolly went 2x6 on Tuesday and has hit safely in four straight games. Delgado is also swatting .369 (24x65) over his past 15 games after breaking out of an 0x12 slump in Daytona on June 17.

**ROAD WEARY:** The Fire Frogs began a season-long ten-game road trip on Friday with their last trip to Tampa, falling in two out of three contests to the Tarpons. Florida was swept in a three-game series by the Blue Jays that finished last night. They play four in Bradenton this weekend (7/4-7/7) to round out the trip. Florida has struggled on the road to a 13-29 mark. The Fire Frogs enter this set having won back-to-back road games just three times this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, 5/9-5/10 at Jupiter, 6/4-6/5 at FTM). Florida is 1-10-1 in 2019 road series.

**MEET THE MARAUDERS (FINALLY):** The Fire Frogs and Marauders begin their 8-game season series on the 4th of July, having played 17 prior games over the past two seasons. Florida is 4-4 at LECOM Park, having split a four-game series in 2017 and 2018. The Fire Frogs and Marauders played June 30-July 3 two seasons ago, engaging in a similar time frame as they are right now.

**ENDER INCIARTE REHABBING:** The Atlanta Braves announced on Monday that OF Ender Inciarte would begin rehabbing from his lumbar strain with the Fire Frogs. In 40 games with the Braves before injury, Inciarte swatted .218/.300/.323 with 2 homers, 9 RBIs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 12 walks, and 27 strikeouts. He was placed on the Injured List on May 15. He was initially acquired by the Braves along with SS Dansby Swanson and RHP Aaron Blair from the Arizona Diamondbacks for RHP Shelby Miller and LHP Gabe Speier. He is 2-7 with a walk over his first three games at the dish in his first game back since May 14. He made his second start in the field last night out in center, making his first two put outs.

**OPPOSING STARTER:** RHP Nicholas Economos makes his first appearance against the Fire Frogs in what will be his 9th start of the season with Bradenton. He has split the season so far between Low-A Greensboro (8 games, 5 starts) and the Marauders, pitching to the tune of a 6-5 record with a 2.52 ERA in 78.2 IP with 32 BB and 86 Ks while holding the opposition to a .193 batting average. He was a 21st Round selection in 2015 by Pittsburgh out of Mercer County CC in West Windsor, NJ. Four of his prior eight Bradenton starts are quality.
