Fire Frogs Recap (All-Time)


MISCUES MANGLE FIRE FROGS IN LOSS TO MARAUDERS: Bradenton got on the board two batters into the contest and added on in spots to beat the Fire Frogs, 5-2, on Independence Day at LECOM Park. RHP Nick Economos shut down the Fire Frogs through seven innings, holding them to three hits and a run on a sac fly from Zack Soria in the 7th. RHP Brooks Wilson notched the first quality start of his career, working around five hits, four runs, an earned run, and compiling a career-high 9 Ks . Drew Lugbauer went deep for the second straight game, slamming a homer off RHP Nick Mears in the 9th inning. Raul Hernandez went 2-3 with Bradenton, scoring two runs. A two-base error on Wilson cost the Fire Frogs dearly in the fifth. Raul Siri bunted, Wilson tossed the ball into left enabling two runs to score for a 3-0 lead at the time.

LUGS LUMBERS UP: Fire Frogs infielder Drew Lugbauer became the first Florida player to record a five-RBI effort, besting two seperate four RBI games from Jefrey Ramos ( $4 / 30 \mathrm{vs}$ LAK $+6 / 2 \mathrm{vs}$ PMB) and one from Riley Unroe ( $5 / 10$ at JUP) on Wednesday. This was a career-best for Lugs who's previous career mark was 4 RBI on three-seperate occasions. He also hit a homer in consecutive games for the second time this season, doing so 6/17 +6/18 in Daytona.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 66 of the 80 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 59 of those games. He has seperate 9 -game (4/12$4 / 22$ ) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11 . He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: . 325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, $9 \mathrm{~K}, .358$ OBP. Delly had his second recent four-game hitting streak snapped on Thursday by going 0-4. Delgado is also swatting .348 ( $24 \times 69$ ) over his past 16 games after breaking out of an $0 \times 12$ slump in Daytona on June 17

ROAD WEARY: The Fire Frogs began a season-long ten-game road trip last Friday with their last trip to Tampa, falling in two out of three contests to the Tarpons. Florida was swept in a three-game series by the Blue Jays that finished last night. They play four in Bradenton this weekend (7/4-7/7) to round out the trip. Florida has struggled on the road to a 13-30 mark. The Fire Frogs enter this set having won back-to-back road games just three times this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, $5 / 9-5 / 10$ at Jupiter, 6/4-6/5 at FTM). Florida is 1-10-1 in 2019 road series.

MEET THE MARAUDERS (FINALLY): The Fire Frogs and Marauders begin their 8-game season series on the 4th of July, having played 17 prior games over the past two seasons. Florida is 4-4 at LECOM Park, having split a four-game series in 2017 and 2018. The Fire Frogs and Marauders played June 30-July 3 two seasons ago, engaging in a similar time frame as they are right now.

ENDER INCIARTE REHABBING: OF Ender Inciarte has been rehabbing from his lumbar strain with the Fire Frogs since Monday. In 40 games with the Braves before injury, Inciarte swatted $.218 / .300 / .323$ with 2 homeruns, 9 RBIs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 12 walks, and 27 strikeouts. He was placed on the Injured List on May 15 . He was initially acquired by the Braves along with SS Dansby Swanson and RHP Aaron Blair from the Arizona Diamondbacks for RHP Shelby Miller and LHP Gabe Speier. He is 2-7 with a walk over his first three games at the dish in his first game action since May 14 . He made his second start in the field Wednesday out in center, making his first two put outs, and returns to the lineup tonight.

GAUSMAN GETS THE BALL: RHP Kevin Gausman is making his first ever appearance with the Fire Frogs as part of an MLB rehab assignment. He last pitched on June 10 with Atlanta, but then was placed on the IL with plantar fasciitis in his right foot. He was also slowed down in the spring due to a sore shoulder. In 13 starts with Atlanta, he held a 2-5 record with a 6.21 ERA in 62.1 IP, $48 \mathrm{R}, 43 \mathrm{ER}, 24 \mathrm{BB}, 64 \mathrm{~K}, .285$ BAA. LHP Philip Pfeifer will most likely get the ball in relief of Gausman.

Tonight's Appearance: 12th of the season. It will be his 134th career game. RHP Kevin Gausman (rehabbing from Atlanta) gets the ball ahead of Philip today.

Last Start: Took his fourth straight losing decision in his start on Sunday afternoon at Tampa: L, career-high 7.2 IP and $11 \mathrm{~K}, 5 \mathrm{H}, 2 \mathrm{R}, 0$ ER, 1 BB, PC: 101/75 strikes. This is the third time he's gone over the 100 pitch plateau this season. This was his first start of 6 innings of length in his career. All 11 strikeouts and just three hits allowed through his first seven innings of that start.

Notes: Pfeifer's last start before this season came on April 25th, 2018 at Rochester while with Gwinnett: IP, $2 \mathrm{H}, 2 \mathrm{ER}, 2 \mathrm{HB}, \mathrm{BB}, 0 \mathrm{~K}, \mathrm{PC}$ : $36 / 20$ strikes. He permitted a run in six of his seven outings with Mississippi this season before being sent down on April 29th. This is the first time while with the Braves system that he's pitching for the Fire Frogs and the first time he's been at the Advanced-A level since 2016, when he pitched in a combined 20 games between Rancho Cucamonga (Dodgers) and the Carolina Mudcats. Acquired from the Dodgers with RHP Caleb Dirks for RHP Bud Norris, OF Dian Toscano, PTBNL (RHP Alex Grosser), and cash on June 30, 2016. Drafted in the 3rd Round (101st overall) by the Dodgers back in 2015. Also was drafted in the 44th Round back in 2011 out of Farragut HS in Knoxville, TN.
