GAUSMAN GOES FIVE IN REHAB GIG WITH FLORIDA: Coming back from plantar faciitis in his right foot, Braves pitcher RHP Kevin Gausman tossed five frames of three-run baseball in the 5-3 Fire Frogs loss to Bradenton on Friday. He struck out six hitters, most of them later on in his appearance. LHP Philip Pfeifer permitted two unearned runs over three relief innings in his first non-start since May 3rd. Florida was outhit 10-2 in the ball game, being held to just two hits for the 7th time this season. Sean Michel, Riley Delgado, and CJ Alexander were able to coax bases loaded walks in the seventh to bring them within a run. Bradenton leaned on a fantastic start from RHP Brad Case, who surrendered just one hit and no runs across six innnings. Travis Swaggerty had the first four-hit effort of his career. Oneil Cruz belted a two-run homer. Late two-out RBI knocks from Deon Stafford and Lucas Tancas ended up being the difference in the game.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 67 of the 81 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 59 of those games. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delgado is still swatting .328 (.24x73) over his past 17 games after breaking out of an 0x12 slump in Daytona on June 17 despite starting this series 0-8 with a walk.

ROAD WEARY: The Fire Frogs began a season-long ten-game road trip last Friday with their last trip to Tampa, falling in two out of three contests to the Tarpoms. Florida was swept in a three-game series by the Blue Jays that finished up on Wednesday. They play four in Bradenton this weekend (7/4-7/7) to round out the trip. Florida has struggled on the road to a 13-31 mark. The Fire Frogs enter this set having won back-to-back road games just three times this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, 5/9-5/10 at Jupiter, 6/4-6/5 at FTM). Florida is 1-10-1 in 2019 road series, and can do no better than a split against the Marauders.

MEET THE MARAUDERS (FINALLY): The Fire Frogs and Marauders begin their 8-game season series on the 4th of July, having played 17 prior games over the past two seasons. Florida is 4-6 at LECOM Park, having split a four-game series in 2017 and 2018. The Fire Frogs and Marauders played June 30-July 3 two seasons ago, engaging in a fairly similar time frame as they are right now.

FLUMMOXED FIELDING FLING: The Fire Frogs have struggled a bit defensively on this trip, committing 11 errors dating back to June 28. Florida has two errors in each of the first two games this series and has at least one over their last four contests. Despite the recent struggles, the Fire Frogs are still tied for 3rd in the circuit with a .978 fielding percentage, committing the fourth-fewest errors in the FSL (66) while being tied with a couple teams for the most games played (84).

ENDER INCIARTE REHABBING: OF Ender Inciarte has been rehabbing from his lumbar strain with the Fire Frogs since Monday. In 40 games with the Braves before injury, Inciarte swatted .218/.300/.323 with 2 home runs, 9 RBIs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 12 walks, and 27 strikeouts. He was placed on the Injured List on May 15. He was initially acquired by the Braves along with SS Dansby Swanson and RHP Aaron Blair from the Arizona Diamondbacks for RHP Shelby Miller and LHP Gabe Speier. He is 1-10 with a walk over his first four games at the dish in his first game action since May 14. He made his third start in the field Fridday out in center and has made two total put outs. He will continue his rehab assigment with AA-Mississippi come Monday.

OPPOSING STARTER: RHP Gavin Wallace gets the ball tonight for the fourth time this season and makes his 21st appearance with the Marauders. He was a 15th Round pick of the Pirates in 2017 out of Fairfield University. He set a program record in his final season with Fairfield by recording four shutouts. He also finished the season as the nation's leader with seven complete games. Wallace pitched three years for the Stags program after being a three-time letter winner at Madison High School in New Jersey. His older brother, Mike, pitched for a couple years in the Pirates organization.

Tonight's Start: Beck's 10th appearance of the season, 8th start, 5th with the Fire Frogs. He is going to be starting an Advanced-A game for the first time since April 26 in Port St. Lucie, where he suffered a groin injury and was then placed on the Injured List the next day.

Last Start: Made 2nd rehab start with the GCL Braves on July 1: ND, 4.1 IP, 7 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, career-high 11 K, PC: 52/42 strikes.

Notes: While making his fourth start of the 2019 season on 4/26, Beck injured his groin after 1.1 innings and missed two months before being activated to the roster on 7/3... Combined to throw nine rehab innings over two starts with the GCL Braves on 6/26 and 7/1: 0-0, 9 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 14 K (career-high 11 on 7/1), scaled up from 29 to 52 pitches... He threw 4.2 frames over 3 appearances (1 start) with the GCL Braves last year, striking out 7 and walking 2... Had a stress fracture in his back during his sophomore season at Stanford in 2017 so he didn't pitch... this injury pushed him back to the 29th round (Yankees) of the draft... Was the Opening Day Starter for the Cardinal as a Junior in 2018 (8-4, 2.98 ERA, 90.2 IP, 73 K, 31 BB)... Also taken in the 34th Round by the Brewers in 2015... His grandfather, Donald Piper, was in the Welsh Cup for Rugby (Equivalent to National All-American)... Threw two no-hitters in high school and a 10-inning one-hitter... His mother and sister graduated from Stanford.
