LAST TIME OUT: FIRE FROGS PINCH STONE CRABS IN EXTRAS: Drew Lugbauer's second of two run-scoring doubles tied the contest in the seventh and the Florida Fire Frogs went on to triumph in ten innings, 5-4, against the FSL South Division second-half champion Charlotte Stone Crabs on Monday evening at Charlotte Sports Park. After Charlotte took a 2-0 lead in the first, Florida came back to tie it in the third at 2-2. Brett Langhorne walked, stole second, and moved to third on a Johnson throwing miscue that enabled Riley Delgado to reach. A wild pitch from LHP Christopher Sanchez sent in Langhorne. Lugbauer's first RBI double to center brought Delgado around. Charlotte regained the lead 4-2 in the fourth, but a free pass issued to Langhorne by RHP Cristofer Ogando and a stolen base put him in scoring position in the seventh. After a balk, Delgado's infield single sent him scampering to the dish. A throwing error for Ogando put Delgado at second and he would come home on Lugbauer's double to tie the contest at 4-4. Kevin Josephina's sacrifice fly in the tenth guided the Frogs to victory. RHP Walter Borkovich got the start and surrendered three earned runs over four frames. The bullpen efforts of RHP Troy Bacon, LHP Hayden Deal, and RHP Sean McLaughlin (3-5) combined to shut down the Stone Crabs offense the rest of the way, firing two scoreless innings each.

SALUTE TO THE STONE CRABS: The Fire Frogs and Stone Crabs continued their 8-game season series on the 26th of August, having played 15 prior games over the past two seasons. The Fire Frogs are 3-7 at Charlotte Sports Park over the past two seasons. Six games have been affected by rain in Kissimmee over the past two-plus seasons, two of the games were moved to Port Charlotte last year. Florida won the regular season finale in Port Charlotte last year, eliminating the Stone Crabs from playoff contention in the South division. But, the Stone Crabs have already locked up a second-half title with a shutout victory over Clearwater on Saturday evening.

DELGADO DIVES ON: All-Star Riley Delgado has gotten on in 100 of the 127 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 89 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 142 hits and is 2nd in the Braves organization trailing Drew Waters' 159 between Mississippi and Gwinnett. After hitting .223 in July, Delgado is swatting .282 through 26 August games. Delgado was on a 1x18 skid going into Friday's game, but rebounded with his 41st multi-hit effort, slashing 2-4, to break out of that stretch on Friday. He has multiple hits in three of his last four assignments, going 2x4 yesterday.

RAMOS GETS REPETITIVE: Essentially every night over the past two weeks, Jeffrey Ramos has notched a hit, including having hits in 12 of his last 15 assignments entering today's action. Dating back to a double header with Bradenton on 8/13, Ramos is mashing .273 (15x55) with 1 HR, 7 RBIs, 6 R, 4 BB, and just 6 K. He has three-multi hit efforts during this span. He was hitting .300 (6x20) over his five-game hitting streak that was snapped Saturday. Ramos is swatting .276 for the month of August with 2 HR and 15 RBIs. His 56 RBI total for the season leads the Fire Frogs and is T-12th in the FSL.

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Florida starting pitchers warmed up in July with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over a recent 18-game stretch, starters permitted just a 1.97 ERA (23 ER/105.0 IP) going back to game two of a Friday (7/26) twin bill against Daytona. Taking this back further, 12 quality starts were fired over the previous 23 games and the pitchers have maintained a 2.38 ERA (36 ER/136.1 IP). The Fire Frogs staff had given up 12 ER in 15 innings in a twin bill on 8/14 and 8/15 vs. Bradenton, compiling a 7.20 ERA with one quality start. But, the Frogs have rebounded with 59.1 innings thrown with seven quality starts in their last ten games, yielding just 17 earned runs and a 2.58 ERA.

COMPLETE GAME KINGS: Florida leads Minor League Baseball with 10 complete games during this season. This total is 4 more than any other team in the MiLB, besting the Double-A Jackson Generals of the Southern League and the Double-A Altoona Curve of the Eastern League. The Cleveland Indians and the Chicago White Sox lead the MLB with five. The Fire Frogs also tossed their 17th shutout victory on Sunday vs. Dunedin, a total that is T-7th in all of the MiLB. The Stone Crabs notched three straight shutout victories against Clearwater this past weekend and now pace the MiLB with 20.

Last Start: No Decision in what was debatably his best start of his career (last Thursday vs. TAM 8/22): 7 IP, 6 H, 1 ER (Quality Start), 1 HB, 0 BB, 8 K (tied season-high), PC: 102/68. He is 2-2 with a 2.61 ERA in seven starts (four quality) since returning from injury in mid-July: 41.1 IP, 41 H, 14 R, 12 ER, 2 HR, 6 BB, 39 K, has thrown 91 or more pitches over last five starts.

Notes: He played shortstop throughout his high school career and pitched the last two seasons. Prior to being drafted, went 12-1 with a 0.81 highschool ERA (9 ER/ 78 IP) across 22 games with Riverview HS. He started pitching because they needed some arms and they knew he threw pretty hard. Also hit for a .393 average with 11 doubles and 2 homers. His slot value was \$709,000, he signed to play with the Braves instead of attending D-II University of Tampa. Injured 6/3 in start at Fort Myers, missed a month, sent to GCL to make 3 rehab starts (7/2, 7/5, 7/10): 0-1, 3.38 ERA, 3 H, 2 HB, 1 BB, 9 K, went from 8 to 18 to 30 pitches.
