NOT SO CLEAR-WATER: Friday evening's scheduled game between the Fire Frogs and Threshers was completely washed away due to monsoon-like conditions at Spectrum Field, making today's twin bill a necessity. This will be the second double header of the week for Florida, also hosting Charlotte for two games at the Pond on Tuesday. Clearwater played two last Sunday in Tampa, had a suspended game that was completed with a 7-inning contest on Thursday, and now will play two today at their home ballpark.

THURSDAY: CHARLOTTE COMPLETES SWEEP: The Charlotte Stone Crabs won their ninth straight game, moving their MiLB best record to 17-4 in the second half of the season with an 11-4 win at Osceola County Stadium on Thursday afternoon. The Stone Crabs scored first in the first for the fourth consecutive game, as Michael Smith had a role in the first four tallies of the ball game. The Fire Frogs fell behind 6-0 and 8-1, not able to climb back into the contest despite homers by Zack Soria and Drew Lugbauer. Jordan Rodgers added an RBI single in the ninth, polishing off his first three-hit game of the season in the process. CJ Alexander also notched his second multi-hit game since returning to action a week ago in Bradenton. Kevin Josephina drew a walk and has reached in 20 of his last 24 assignments. RHP Brooks Wilson took his second straight loss, allowing five earned runs in five innings. RHP Daysbel Hernandez and RHP Kurt Hoekstra were dinged up a bit as well out of the pen, surrendering multiple hits and multiple runs in two-frame outings.

DELGADO DAZED: All-Star Riley Delgado has been consistently getting on base all season long. He has gotten on in 68 of the 84 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 61 of those games. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly went 1x3 Wednesday and has hits in back-to-back games while still pacing the circuit with 99 hits. He received just his 3rd true off day of the entire season on Thursday, having participated in a team-high 86 games entering Thursday's action.

CAN'T CLEARLY RECALL: The Fire Frogs and Threshers met in two of the first six series of the 2019 season way back in April, with Florida playing six of their first 20 games against Clearwater. Since April 24, these teams haven't met. The Fire Frogs will play 9 of their next 37 games against the Threshers, a span lasting through August 18.

ROAD WEARY: The Fire Frogs began a season-long ten-game road trip on June 28, playing nine games through July 6 with one rainout in Bradenton. Florida went home for a short four-game series against Charlotte before hitting the road for another six-game road trip. Florida is currently in a stretch where they were scheduled to play 16 out of 20 contests away from the Pond. The Fire Frogs have struggled on the road to a 14-31 mark and enter this set having won back-to-back road games just three times this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, 5/9-5/10 at Jupiter, 6/4-6/5 at FTM). The Fire Frogs are 1-11-1 in 2019 road series with their only set victory coming 5/9-5/11 in Jupiter, taking two of the three from the Hammerheads.

LUGBAUER LUMBERS UP: Drew Lugbauer has really turned his season around and is having a fine second half. In 22 games he is slugging .284/.322/.593 with 23 H, 4 2B, 7 HR, and 18 RBI. More recently, Lugs has reached safely in 10 straight assignments and has hits in 5 straight, swatting .303 with 5 HR and 12 RBI and slugging .818 (these totals all lead the FSL for the month of July). He has raised his batting average from his season-low .134 on June 4th to the present 182



**Today's Start:** 13th Advanced-A appearance in 2019, 11th start. This will be his 33rd overall Advanced-A appearance and 11th start at this level. He has pitched in 134 prior MiLB games and has started 13 games in his professional career. Pfeifer is making his first career start against Clearwater, having not been on the roster when the Fire Frogs and Threshers faced each other last.

Last Appearance: Came out of the pen in the sixth after RHP Kevin Gausman made a rehab start for the Fire Frogs in Bradenton on 7/5 vs. the Marauders: ND, 3 IP (shortest outing since his first with FLO on 5/3 vs. TAM), 5 H, 2 R, 0 ER, BB, 4 K. Pfeifer comes into tonight's start having not allowed an earned run in his last 15 innings, dating back to the 2nd inning of his 6/25 start vs. Palm Beach.

**Notes:** Pfeifer's last start before this season came on April 25th, 2018 at Rochester while with Gwinnett: IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 2 HB, BB, 0 K, PC: 36/20 strikes. He permitted a run in six of his seven outings with Mississippi this season before being sent down on April 29th. This is the first time while with the Braves system that he's pitching for the Fire Frogs and the first time he's been at the Advanced-A level since 2016, when he pitched in a combined 20 games between Rancho Cucamonga (Dodgers) and the Carolina Mudcats. Acquired from the Dodgers with RHP Caleb Dirks for RHP Bud Norris, OF Dian Toscano, PTBNL (RHP Alex Grosser), and cash on June 30, 2016. Drafted in the 3rd Round (101st overall) by the Dodgers back in 2015. Also was drafted in the 44th Round back in 2011 out of Farragut HS in Knoxville, TN.

**Today's Start:** Beck's 11th appearance of the season, 9th start, 6th with the Fire Frogs. He is going to be starting an Advanced-A game for the second time since April 26 in Port St. Lucie, where he suffered a groin injury and was then placed on the Injured List the next day.

**Last Start:** Tossed a gem for the Fire Frogs last Saturday (7/6) at Bradenton in what was a 2-0 Florida win over the Marauders: W, 6 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K, PC: 85/58 strikes in what was Beck's first quality start of his career and first time pitching more than 5 innings.

**Notes:** While making his fourth start of the 2019 season on 4/26, Beck injured his groin after 1.1 innings and missed two months before being activated to the roster on 7/3... Combined to throw nine rehab innings over two starts with the GCL Braves on 6/26 and 7/1: 0-0, 9 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 14 K (career-high 11 on 7/1), scaled up from 29 to 52 pitches... He threw 4.2 frames over 3 appearances (1 start) with the GCL Braves last year, striking out 7 and walking 2... Had a stress fracture in his back during his sophomore season at Stanford in 2017so he didn't pitch... this injury pushed him back to the 29th round (Yankees) of the draft... Was the Opening Day Starter for the Cardinal as a Junior in 2018 (8-4, 2.98 ERA, 90.2 IP, 73 K, 31 BB)... Also taken in the 34th Round by the Brewers in 2015... His grandfather, Donald Piper, was in the Welsh Cup for Rugby (Equivalent to National All-American)... Threw two no-hitters in high school and a 10-inning one-hitter... His mother and sister graduated from Stanford.
