FIRE FROGS THRASH THRESHERS: The Fire Frogs wrapped up their second road series victory of the season by taking Saturday's double header, 5-2 and 3-0, from the Threshers. LHP Philip Pfeifer threw the first complete game of his career, permitting just six hits and two runs with seven strikeouts over seven frames. RHP Tristan Beck nearly followed suit, going 6.2 stanzas of six-hit baseball with eight punch outs. RHP Brandon White oversaw Clearwater's loading of the bases in the seventh, but he slammed the door to ensure victory. Drew Lugbauer stayed hot with another homer to start game one's scoring and a double and two runs scored in the second game. Florida used a four-run sixth to take control of game one, with Trey Harris' go-ahead RBI knock being critically important. In game two, Florida scored two in the fourth as Kevin Josephina drove in a run and scored a run. Zack Soria's RBI double in the sixth provided some insurance. Josephina has now reached base in 21 of his last 25 assignments.

DELGADO DAZED: All-Star Riley Delgado has been consistently getting on base all season long, but has struggled of late. He has gotten on in 69 of the 86 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 62 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 100 hits. In the month of July, however, Delgado is hitting just .186 (8-43) in his last 11 ballgames, driving in just one run, walking twice, and picking up two Ks.

CAN'T CLEARLY RECALL: The Fire Frogs and Threshers met in two of the first six series of the 2019 season way back in April, with Florida playing six of their first 20 games against Clearwater. Since April 24, these teams hadn't met until yesterday. The Fire Frogs will play 9 of their next 37 games against the Threshers, a span lasting through August 18.

ROAD WEARY: The Fire Frogs began a season-long ten-game road trip on June 28, playing nine games through July 6 with one rainout in Bradenton. Florida went home for a short four-game series against Charlotte before hitting the road for another six-game road trip. Florida is currently in a stretch where they were scheduled to play 16 out of 20 contests away from the Pond. The Fire Frogs have struggled on the road to a 16-31 mark and enter this set having won back-to-back road games just three times this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, 5/9-5/10 at Jupiter, 6/4-6/5 at FTM). But, Florida was able to win back-to-back road games yesterday and look to win three-in-a-row for the first time this year away from home. The Fire Frogs improved their mark to 2-11-1 in 2019 road series with their other set victory coming 5/9-5/11 in Jupiter, taking two of the three from the Hammerheads.

LUGBAUER LUMBERS UP: Drew Lugbauer has really turned his season around and is having a fine second half. In 24 games he is slugging .291/.333/.628 with 25 H, 5 2B, 8 HR, and 19 RBI. More recently, Lugs has reached safely in 12 straight assignments and has hits in 7 straight, swatting .316 with 6 HR and 13 RBI and slugging .868 (these totals all lead the FSL for the month of July among qualified players). He has raised his batting average from his season-low .134 on June 4th to the present .186.

MASH-TIME FOR MORITZ: Fire Frogs OF Andrew Moritz had his Advanced-A best 9-game on-base streak snapped in game two yesterday. Still, Andrew has compiled the 8th-best batting average in the FSL for July (.325, minimum 32 at-bats). He has five multi-hit games during this stretch, including a 2-4 effort in game one.

His 4.82 strikeout-to-walk ratio was second in the organization in 2018... He was undrafted out of a small DI school (Presbyterian) in South Carolina... Royals said their Minor League roster was full, hence Billy Best and the Braves were able to sign him instead on June 23rd, 2017... Led the Big South conference in appearances (31) out of the bullpen during 2016 season and finished a league-high 26... Held opponents to a .242 BAA in 2015 while making 29 appearances, beat Clemson on April 1st... Played baseball for four years at Bandys HS in Catawba, N.C... his father also was in athletics there.
