**LAST TIME OUT: FIRE FROGS THROTTLE THRESHERS IN TWIN BILL SWEEP:** After a total washout on Friday evening suspended the series by a day, the Florida Fire Frogs came out for the second straight time in Clearwater and swept a Saturday evening double header, 3-2 and 5-0, from the Threshers to claim a series victory in front of 5,349 at Spectrum Field. The Fire Frogs outhit the Threshers 24-7 in a double dip that was completed in just 4:10 from start to finish. The Fire Frogs won the hit category from the Threshers, 13-4, in game one and 11-3 in game two. RHP Freddy Tarnok (3-7) claimed game one's win by firing six innings of four-hit baseball, allowing two runs, two walks, and racking up five strikeouts. RHP Caleb Dirks turned in a stress-free, scoreless seventh to record his first save with the Frogs. In game two, RHP Matt Hartman (3-6) became the first Florida pitcher to complete back-to-back starts. He willed the Fire Frogs to their 16th shutout win by tossing the entire seven-inning game, allowing just three hits and a free pass with five strikeouts mixed in. The Fire Frogs scored single tallies in the 5th-7th innings to cap a comeback in game one. Brett Langhome had 3 RBIs in the twin bill, two in game one. A four-run 2nd fueled a game two win as Kevin Josephina notched a run-scoring single and Jordan Rodgers belted a three-run homer, his fourth of the season.

**BUMMING WITH THE BEACH DOGS:** The Fire Frogs are finishing up a span today where they played 9 of their previous 37 games against the Threshers. The last time Florida was in Clearwater they finished off a three-game sweep with a 4-0 triumph at Spectrum Field. They are 12-11 in Clearwater since the beginning of the Fire Frogs existence. The Frogs shutout the Threshers in three straight games and didn't allow a run in a span of 29.1 innings from Dalton Guthrie's solo homer in the bottom of the 7th in a 5-2 win on July 13 in game one of a twin bill through the first four innings of game one of an August 1 double header at Osceola County Stadium. Florida shutout Clearwater and swept the double header yesterday to improve to 7-1 in the second half, five of those wins they haven't permitted a run.

**DELGADO DIVES ON:** All-Star Riley Delgado has gotten on in 94 of the 119 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 83 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 133 hits and is 2nd in the Braves organization trailing Drew Waters' 148 between Mississippi and Gwinnett. After hitting .223 in July, Delgado is swatting .299 through 18 August games. After a 6x17 Bradenton series, Delgado began the Clearwater series with a 5x8 effort at the dish on Saturday, picking up his 39th and 40th multi-hit efforts of the season.

**LASHING LUGBAUER:** The last 17 games have seen the bat of Drew Lugbauer heat up, raising his average from .177 to .193 for the year. He is hitting .321 (17x53) with 3 HR, 2 2Bs, 8 RBIs, 4 BBs, and 9 runs scored. He has 6 multi-hit efforts during this stretch and has reached in 13 of the contests. He has a very respectable .246 second half average and has slugged 11 HRs, 10 2Bs, has driven in 28 runs, and has scored 25 times while boosting his average from .151 to .193. Lugbauer is 5th in the FSL with 39 extra-base hits, three behind Kody Clemens of Lakeland who leads the pack with 42.

**STARTING OFF RIGHT:** Florida starting pitchers warmed up in July with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over a recent 18-game stretch, starters permitted just a 1.97 ERA (23 ER/105.0 IP) going back to game two of a Friday (7/26) twin bill against Daytona. Taking this back further, 12 quality starts were fired over the previous 23 games and the pitchers have maintained a 2.38 ERA (36 ER/136.1 IP). Combined with Wednesday's double header and the Thursday finale against Bradenton, the Fire Frogs staff had given up 12 ER in 15 innings, compiling a 7.20 ERA with one quality start. But, the Frogs rebounded with 13 innings thrown over two starts, yielding a 1.38 ERA.

**COMPLETE GAME KINGS:** Florida fired its 10th complete game Saturday when Matt Hartman went the distance for the second straight time. This total is four more than any other team in the MiLB, besting the Double-A Jackson Generals of the Southern League. The Cleveland Indians lead Major League Baseball with five. The Fire Frogs also tossed their 16th shutout victory on Saturday game two, a total that is T-8th in all of the MiLB behind the Quad Cities River Bandits who have 19.
