SLUGBAUER EMERGES: For the fourth time in his career, Drew Lugbauer swatted home runs in consecutive games, doing so at the Advanced-A level for the first time. His career-high was three straight games with a long ball, doing so July 20-23 with Danville back in 2017. He also achieved the feat once with Rome in 2018 (August 3-4). This was the second occasion this season where a Florida player has gone deep in consecutive games, joining the promoted Gleyson Jenista who hit bombs in April 25-26 contests at St. Lucie.

HEAVENLY HUASCAR: RHP Huascar Ynoa became the second former Fire Frog to make his MLB debut in 2019, doing so yesterday for the Braves against the Philadelphia Phillies. In a relief role, the 21-year-old tossed two scoreless frames of one-run baseball while fanning two in a 15-1 Atlanta win. Ynoa rocketed up the Braves system, starting the year with the Fire Frogs and made it to the Show in just under two months time after being called up to Double-A Mississippi on April 19th. He went 0-1 with a 3.27 ERA in three starts for Florida spanning 11 innings. He walked 6, struck out 16, and allowed just 10 hits and four runs. He pitched in 11 more games (3 starts) between Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett before receiving his call to the Majors on Saturday. He was transferred back to Gwinnett yesterday.

Today's Start: The southpaw makes his 8th start at the High-A level (9th appearance this season). This is his first appearance against the Daytona Tortugas.

Last Outing: Pfeifer took the loss against the Dunedin Blue Jays on June 12th in what was the first half finale. He tossed 5.1 innings, allowing four hits, four runs, four walks, and struck out a career-high nine batters. He threw 100 pitches (56 strikes) which was the second-most he's thrown in his career.

Notes: Pfeifer's last start before this season came on April 25th, 2018 at Rochester while with Gwinnett: IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 2 HB, BB, 0 K, PC: 36/20 strikes. He permitted a run in six of his seven outings with Mississippi this season before being sent down on April 29th. This is the first time while with the Braves system that he's pitching for the Fire Frogs and the first time he's been at the Advanced-A level since 2016, when he pitched in a combined 20 games between Rancho Cucamonga (Dodgers) and the Carolina Mudcats. Acquired from the Dodgers with RHP Caleb Dirks for RHP Bud Norris, OF Dian Toscano, PTBNL (RHP Alex Grosser), and cash on June 30, 2016. Drafted in the 3rd Round (101st overall) by the Dodgers back in 2015. Also was drafted in the 44th Round back in 2011 out of Farragut HS in Knoxville, TN.

Yielded four runs or more three separate occasions upon return to FLO (CHA x2, JUP)... ERA went from 1.67 to 5.53 at High-A by season's end... went from 3.76 to 5.53 after last appearance of year at Charlotte on August 31st: 0 IP, 5 H, 8 ER, HR, 2 BB.

2017: Appeared in 35 games with High-A Florida, and went 4-4 with a 3.97 ERA (29 ER/65.2 IP) and 58 strikeouts... Appeared in 17 games with Mississippi to open the season before transferring to Gwinnett on 6/1... Allowed four runs in 1.0 innings in his Triple-A debut and three runs in 1.1 frames in his final outing of the season, but tallied a 2.30 ERA (11 ER/43.0 IP) in his 25 other outings with the G-Braves... Career-best 7 K, 3 IP, 0 R on 8/21 vs. Rochester.

2015: Pitched at three levels over the course of his first full season, combining to go 3-1 with a 2.98 ERA (16 ER/48.1 IP) and 11 saves in 33 appearances between Rome (A), Danville (R) and Carolina (A+)... Fanned 13.0 batters per 9.0 innings, tops among all Braves farmhands (min. 25.0 IP), while 11 saves tied him for third most in the system... Opened the year with Rome and allowed just seven hits in 24.1 innings, but issued 23 walks with 35 strikeouts...
