**LUGBAUER AND BROWN NINTH-INNING HEROICS STUN DAYTONA ON TUESDAY, 2-1:** Down to their final strike, the Fire Frogs strung together three hits and scored two times to overcome a 1-0 deficit and steal the middle game of the series from the Tortugas on Tuesday night at the Jack. In a 1-2 count against RHP Connor Bennett, Drew Lugbauer blasted a towering drive over the right-field fence for his 16th long ball of the season to even the score, 1-1. Jeffrey Ramos was able to follow up the Lugbauer dinger with a single to continue the ninth-inning charge. Logan Brown then smoked a screaming liner over the head of Andy Suglio in right, enabling Ramos to score all the way from first for the lead, 2-1. Bruce Yari provided the only offense for Daytona with an RBI double in the 7th. RHP Brooks Wilson would allow only one run over a career-high eight frames, working around six hits, two walks, and a hit batsman while racking up 8 Ks and receiving the win. RHP Brandon White tossed a scoreless 9th for his 4th save. RHP Aaron Fossas threw eight shutout frames for Daytona but didn't factor in the decision.

**TANGLE WITH THE TORTUGAS:** Florida began their second three-game set of the half at the Jack versus the Tortugas on Monday. Florida has a 5-4 second half edge in the series with their back-to-back wins the past two nights. The Fire Frogs won the first two games at the Jack this year, shoving off to a 2-0 start to the season. The Fire Frogs are 5-2 at this historic stadium in 2019 and are 11-13 over the past two-plus seasons in Daytona Beach.

**DELGADO DIVES ON:** All-Star Riley Delgado struggled early in the month of July but has picked it back up lately. He has gotten on in 87 of the 108 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 75 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 120 hits and is third in the Braves organization behind Rafael Ortega's 121 (Gwinnett) and Drew Waters' 137 (Mississippi) and has more hits and a higher average than Cristian Pache (.280, .111). Delgado hit .223 (21-94) in 25 July ballgames, but has 14 hits over his last 13 assignments (14x45, averaging .311). He went hitless on Monday, snapping a five-game hitting streak, nine-game on-base streak, and seven-game road hit streak which was his second longest stretch of the year, but went 1x4 yesterday to try and build a new streak.

**SLUGBAUER AND COMPANY LUMBER UP:** Florida has gone deep in each of the last 5 games, its best stretch of the season. The Frogs hit homers in four straight contests from 6/17-6/20 to open the second half, their closest such streak to the current one. Drew Lugbauer has belted bombs in 3 of his last 4 games and is T-3rd in the FSL with 16 home runs.

**BROWN BELTING THE BALL:** The Fire Frogs catcher is in the midst of his best offensive stretch since joining the Advanced-A ranks mid-season. He is batting .355 (11x31) while riding his Florida-best eight-game hitting streak. His average has raised from .213 to .248 since the end of play on July 26 to now. He just picked up his first three-knock game of his Advanced-A career on Monday at Daytona, going 3x4 on the night. He also has a walk-off two-run double on July 27 vs. Daytona and a go-ahead RBI double on 8/6 at Daytona as part of this stretch.

**THE MORITZ POND MASH:** Andrew Moritz has enjoyed the friendly confines of the Pond since being called up to the Fire Frogs mid-season, averaging .350 (28x80) with eight multi-hit efforts. He has hits in 18 of his 20 home assignments and is currently on a ten-game home hit streak, the longest active streak in the FSL. He is hitting just .205 away from home. He had his Florida-best seven-game hitting streak end Sunday in game one at Jupiter: .370 AVG (10x27), 3 RBIs.

**STARTING OFF RIGHT:** Florida starting pitchers really started to warm up in July with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over the last 11 games, starters have permitted just a 1.54 ERA (11 ER/64.1 IP) going back to game two of a Friday (7/26) double header against Daytona. Taking this back further, nine quality starts have been fired over the previous 16 games and the pitchers have maintained a 2.26 ERA (24 ER/95.2 IP), this span does include RHP Tristan Beck allowing 6 ER over 5.1 IP on Friday July 26 in game one of the twin bill against Daytona and RHP Freddy Tarnok permitting 5 ER Sunday in game one vs. Jupiter.

**Tonight's Start:** Borkovich is set to make his 3rd Fire Frogs start and 9th start of his career tonight in Daytona. Over his two previous starts (6/2 vs. PMB GM 2, 8/1 vs. CLR GM 2), has thrown six scoreless innings, scattering five hits, two walks, and four strikeouts. He has appeared three times this season out of the pen against the Tortugas: 1-1, 0-1 SV, 5 R, 9.00 ERA (4 ER/4 IP), 7 H, 7 BB, 1 IBB, 4 K, 1 WP.

**Last Start:** 8/1 vs. Clearwater (GM 2) at the Pond: ND, 3 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 3 K, PC: 39/32 strikes. Combined with Troy Bacon and Lukas Young to shutout the Threshers, 6-0. Took the loss in his last outing against Daytona on 7/28: 1 IP, 1 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 1 IBB, 1 K, PC: 24/15. Borkovich was 2-1 with a 5.79 ERA (15 ER/23.1 IP) in 14 1st half appearances as opposed to being 0-3 with a 2.40 ERA (4 ER/15 IP) over 10 2nd half appearances. Since yielding five earned runs on May 6, Borkovich has allowed 6 ER in his last 17 games (26.2 IP, 2.03 ERA).

**Notes: 2018:** Made 31 appearances (3 starts) with Low-A Rome (68.2 IP, 4-1, 1.83 ERA, 2 saves, 44 K, 15 BB and was named a Mid-Season All-Star... Was with Florida for a three-week span in August (1st-22nd) and made three scoreless starts... Tossed 17 frames and struck out 12 without walking a batter in that stretch... Made 6 consecutive appearances without allowing a run in July while in Rome (11.2 innings). Led all Atlanta farmhands (min. 30 IP) with a 1.47 ERA. Was the Fire Frogs co-pitcher of the month in August for his efforts.
