**BLUE JAYS BAFFLE INCIARTE, FIRE FROGS BATS:** The Fire Frogs were shutout for the 12th time this season and recorded just two hits for the sixth time this year as Dunedin blanked Florida, 5-0. Rehabbing LHP Ryan Borucki threw the first four fantastic innings for the Blue Jays. RHP Emerson Jimenez sniped the win by throwing the fifth. RHP Joey Murray picked up a four-inning save, walking three but fanning five. LHP Hayden Deal took his fourth consecutive loss for Florida, surrendering five runs on eight hits (two homers) with two walks and three Ks. RHP Walter Borkovich contributed 2.1 scoreless frames out of the Fire Frogs pen. Kevin Josephina reached twice, drawing a walk and singling in the fifth. Riley Delgado had the other knock for Florida. Samad Taylor went deep twice off of Deal for the D-Jays. Alejandro Kirk had two early RBI singles to put the Blue Jays ahead.

**DELGADO DIGS IN:** The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 64 of the 77 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 57 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly went 1x4 on Monday and has hit safely in two straight games. Delgado is also swatting .357 (20x56) over his past 13 games after breaking out of an 0x12 slump in Daytona on June 17.

**ROAD READY?:** The Fire Frogs began a season-long ten-game road trip on Friday with their last trip to Tampa, falling in two out of three contests to the Tarpons. Florida began a three-game set against the Blue Jays yesterday that runs today through Wednesday (7/3). They also four in Bradenton this weekend (7/4-7/7) to round out the trip. Florida has struggled on the road to a 13-27 mark. The Fire Frogs enter this set having won back-to-back road games just three times this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, 5/9-5/10 at Jupiter, 6/4-6/5 at FTM). Florida is 1-9-1 in 2019 road series.

**DANGLING WITH DUNEDIN:** The Fire Frogs and Blue Jays meet for the third-time this season and this is the second instance at Jack Russell Memorial Stadium. The Fire Frogs lost the first three games of the season series before rebounding in the set finale at Jack Russell. Dunedin swept the last series of the first half from Florida, a rain-shortened four-game series that saw the first half finale cancelled due to impending inclement weather.

**ENDER INCIARTE REHABBING:** The Atlanta Braves announced on Monday that OF Ender Inciarte will begin rehabbing from his lumbar strain with the Fire Frogs. In 40 games with the Braves before injury, Inciarte swatted .218/.300/.323 with 2 home runs, 9 RBIs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 12 walks, and 27 strikeouts. He was placed on the Injured List on May 15. He was initially acquired by the Braves along with SS Dansby Swanson and RHP Aaron Blair from the Arizona Diamondbacks for RHP Shelby Miller and LHP Gabe Speier. He went 0x2 last night with two groundouts in his first game action since May 14. He makes his first start in the field today out in center.

**OPPOSING STARTER:** RHP Graham Spraker will make his 15th appearance of the season for the D-Jays and 8th start. He has made two unique outings against the Fire Frogs this year, getting the ball on May 26 at Jack Russell: L, 5 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 3 ER, 0 BB, 6 K, PC: 79/56. He also made a relief outing on June 11 at the Pond: W, 2.2 IP, H, 2 BB, 0 BB, 0 K, PC: 33/22 strikes. He was a 31st Round selection of the Blue Jays in the 2017 Draft out of D-II Quincy in Illinois. He made a spot start for AAA-Buffalo this season against Scranton-Wilkes Barre: ND, 5.1 IP, 3 H, ER, 2 BB, 5 K, PC: 80/50 strikes.

**JEFREY JUMPS ABOARD:** The 20-year-old slugger has rebounded nicely from an 0x18 slump he was suffering through at the beginning of the Daytona series on Monday June 17. He had climbed aboard in 14 straight games until that streak was snapped yesterday. He had two separate four-game hitting streaks during the long on-base streak.
