MONDAY: A three-run first inning gave the Miracle the advantage they needed in a 5-2 victory over the Fire Frogs. Every Fort Myers hitter had at least one hit, Michael Helman being the only player with two. Jeffrey Ramos went 3-4 with an RBI triple in the fourth and a run scored to stay on his recent tear at the plate. RHP Freddy Tarnok permitted three walks, five hits, and four earned runs over four innings. RHP Brooks Wilson shutout the Miracle in two innings of work in what was his first appearance since May 16. RHP Sean McLaughlin threw two innings of one-run baseball.

JOSEPHINA JUMPING: The Fire Frogs infielder may have not wanted the month of May to end. In 22 contests, he hit .337 (26-77) with five doubles, eight RBIs, and 10 runs scored. He's the only Florida hitter to be averaging over .271 (Delgado) for the month with at least 22 games played. 7 of his 9 multi-hit efforts came last month, including a 2-4 night yesterday at the dish. He raised his batting average from .196 at the end of April to the current .287. He's kept the bat going in the month of June by going 4-10 and reaching safely in all three games played.

RAMOS RAKING: With his 3-4 performance yesterday, Jeffrey Ramos became the first Fire Frog to have two triples in a game. He's hitting .438 with 2 HR and 7 RBI over his ten-game hitting streak. He is now the second Florida player to have a hit streak of ten games or more, joining the promoted Riley Unroe (5/1-5/11). Going further back however, the Dominican Republic native has recorded a knock in 13 of his last 14 ballgames, raising his average from .237 to .263.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 47 of the 54 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 40 of those contests. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit. Delgado extended his current on-base streak to 11 with a hit yesterday. Jim Haley of Charlotte is two hits behind Delgado, who's 63 paces the circuit.

ROAD WEARY: The Fire Frogs began a seven-game road trip on Monday with a four-game series in Fort Myers followed by a weekend three-game set in Tampa. Florida has struggled on the road this year with a 9-18 mark. They have dropped 8 of their past 9 road contests and 11 of 15. Florida is 1-6 in road sets this season, the only series victory coming in Jupiter over the Hammerheads May 9-11. The Fire Frogs did win their first two road games of the season in Daytona on April 4-5 as part of a split series, but dropped the two home games to halve the set with the Tortugas.

TODAY'S STARTER: 24-year-old LHP Hayden Deal is ready to make his 11th Advanced-A start on the hill today, and will be starting against the Miracle for the second-straight time... He was lights out for the Rome Braves last season, 9-1 record, 2.17 ERA, 27 G (5 starts), 78.2 IP, 62 H, 17 BB, 82 K... With his performance, he was named Rome Pitcher of the Year by the Braves organization... His wins were the second-most in the Braves system and his ERA was second-lowest among Atlanta farmhands with at least 75 innings thrown... His 4.82 strikeout-to-walk ratio was second in the organization in 2018... He was undrafted out of a small DI school (Presbyterian) in North Carolina... Royals said their Minor League roster was full, hence Billy Best and the Braves were able to sign him instead on June 23rd, 2017... Led the Big South conference in appearances (31) out of the bullpen during 2016 season and finished a league-high 26... Held opponents to a .242 BAA in 2015 while making 29 appearances, beat Clemson on April 1st... Played baseball for four years at Bandys HS in Catawba, N.C... his father also was in athletics there.

ALL-STAR FROGS: The FSL announced that Four Fire Frogs had earned bids to play in this year's 58th FSL All-Star Game at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium for the North Division in Jupiter on June 15th. William Contreras, Brandon White, Hayden Deal, and Riley Unroe are all worthy candidates. With Unroe being promoted in Mid-May to AA-Mississippi, it was announced that Riley Delgado would replace him. The Fire Frogs have 5 total selections, 4 All-Stars participating in the game, one more than a year ago.

Yielded four runs or more three separate occasions upon return to FLO (CHA x2, JUP)... ERA went from 1.67 to 5.53 at High-A by season's end... went from 3.76 to 5.53 after last appearance of year at Charlotte on August 31st: 0 IP, 5 H, 8 ER, HB, 2 BB.
