TUESDAY: A five-run seventh inning capped off a Fire Frogs comeback win against the Miracle, 8-2. The Fire Frogs won for just the fifth time in 32 games when trailing after 6 innings. Trey Harris dazzled in his Advanced-A debut, going 2-4 with 3 runs scored. Kevin Josephina had another multi-hit game. Shean Michel had two big RBIs. Riley Delgado had his first 3-RBI game of the season. LHP Hayden Deal recorded his 9th quality start of 11 total by tossing six innings of two-run baseball, just one of them were earned. Kurt Hoekstra notched a three-inning save.

JOSEPHINA JUMPING: The Fire Frogs infielder may have not wanted the month of May to end. In 22 contests, he hit .337 (26-77) with five doubles, eight RBIs, and 10 runs scored. He's the only Florida hitter to be averaging over .271 (Delgado) for the month with at least 22 games played. 7 of his 9 multi-hit efforts came last month, including a 2-4 night yesterday at the dish. He raised his batting average from .196 at the end of April to the current .293. He's kept the bat going in the month of June by going 6-12 and reaching safely in all four games played.

RAMOS RAKING: Ramos is the second Florida player to have a hit streak of ten games or more, joining the promoted Riley Urhoo (5/1-5/11). Unfortunately, Ramos wasn't able to get a hit yesterday but he did extend his on-base streak to 11 games and he is still hitting .400 over this span. Going further back, the Dominican Republic native has recorded a knock in 13 of his last 15 ballgames, raising his average from .237 to .268.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 48 of the 55 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 41 of those contests. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit. Delgado extended his current on-base streak to 12 with a hit yesterday. Jim Haley of Charlotte is three hits behind Delgado, who's 64 count paces the circuit.

ROAD WEARY: The Fire Frogs began a seven-game road trip on Monday with a four-game series in Fort Myers followed by a weekend three-game set in Tampa, Florida has struggled on the road this year with a 10-18 mark. They have dropped 8 of their past 10 road contests and 11 of 16. Florida is 1-6 in road sets this season, the only series victory coming over the Hammerheads May 9-11. The Fire Frogs did win their first two road games of the season in Daytona on April 4-5 as part of a split series, but dropped the two home games to halve the set with the Tortugas.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Matt Withrow swaps out with RHP Nolan Kingham to make the start today. Withrow tossed just a single inning on Saturday night's suspended game against Palm Beach, getting the Cardinals in order.

2016: Played the entirety of his second professional season with High-A Carolina and went 9-6 with a 3.80 ERA (51 ER/120.2 IP) and 131 strikeouts in 25 games (24 starts) to earn the Mudcats' Pitcher of the Year honors from the organization...Paced Carolina in wins (9) and led all Mudcats starters with a 3.80 ERA (51 ER/120.2 IP), while his 131 strikeouts on the season were second most in the Carolina League and fifth most among Braves farmhands...Also ranked in the Top 10 among Atlanta prospects in wins (T3rd, 9), starters ERA (8th, 3.80) and innings (10th, 120.2)...Surrendered 3 or fewer earned runs in 21 of his 25 games, and aside from a 3.0-inning start in which he gave up 11 runs on 7/23, he pitched to a 3.06 ERA...Earned his first pro W in his 4th start of the season on 5/1 (vs. LYN)...Fanned career-best 11 in his final start of the season, 8/31 vs. Wilmington.

2015: Made his professional debut with rookie-level Danville after being selected by the Braves in the sixth round of the 2015 June free agent draft...Allowed two earned runs or fewer in 12 of his 13 starts...Pitched primarily in relief during his junior season at Texas Tech and turned in a career-best 3.63 ERA (9 ER/22.1 IP) over 13 games (1 start).

ALL-STAR FROGS: The FSL announced that Four Fire Frogs had earned bids to play in this year's 58th FSL All-Star Game at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium for the North Division in Jupiter on June 15th. William Contreras, Brandon White, Hayden Deal, and Riley Unroe are all worthy candidates. With Unroe being promoted in Mid-May to AA-Mississippi, it was announced that Riley Delgado would replace him. The Fire Frogs have 5 total selections, 4 All-Stars participating in the game, one more than a year ago.
