FLORIDA AND CLEARWATER COLLECT WINS ON THURSDAY: The Clearwater Threshers came from two runs back to capture game one of a double header, $3-2$, in nine innings before the Florida Fire Frogs answered with their 13th shutout victory of the season, 6-0, to win the series on Thursday afternoon at Osceola County Stadium. The Fire Frogs poured across two unearned runs in the second frame of game one. Logan Brown began the frame with a single against RHP Kyle Arjona. Jordan Rodgers reached on a throwing error to place two in scoring position. Garrison Schwartz plated Brown with a sacrifice liner. Andrew Moritz drove a two-out run-scoring base hit, putting Florida ahead 2-0. RHP Brooks Wilson allowed one run in his start, tossing five strong innings of five-hit baseball while working around three walks and mixing in three punch outs. Clearwater scored single tallies in the fifth, seventh, and ninth to cap off a comeback win and even the set.

In game two, a trio of Fire Frogs hurlers combined to toss the club's fourth shutout in the last five meetings with the Threshers and second of the series. RHP Walter Borkovich got the ball and yielded just a single hit with three strikeouts over the first three innings. RHP Troy Bacon (4-3) fired the next three and worked around two hits and a walk to secure the winning end of the decision. RHP Lukas Young chipped in a perfect seventh to finish off the game. Jefrey Ramos had three RBIs in the contest, a sac fly in the first and RBI knocks in the third and fifth while going $2 \times 3$. Kevin Josephina had two triples and drove in two runs. Andrew Moritz notched an RBI single in the sixth

JUPITER JUBILEE: First two games of a six-game road trip for Florida, which will be followed by the Fire Frogs playing 14 of their next 17 games at the Pond. 2nd of 2 meetings this season between the clubs at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium with the 1st meeting coming back in May. The Fire Frogs won 2 -out-of-3 games to take what would be their only road series win of the season before July 13. 10 of the 13 series games were played in the 1st half. The Fire Frogs are 10-9 in games played against Jupiter at this stadium. Yesterday's rainout was the first rain-effected game of this season series.

DELGADO DIGGING OUT OF SLUMP: All-Star Riley Delgado struggled early in the month of July but has picked it back up lately. He has gotten on in 83 of the 103 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 71 of those games. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: . 325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, $9 \mathrm{~K}, .358$ OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 115 hits and is third in the Braves organization behind Rafael Ortega's 119 (Gwinnett) and Drew Waters' 134 (Mississippi) and has more hits and a higher average than Cristian Pache (.278, 108). Delgado hit .223 (21-94) in 25 July ballgames, but has nine hits over his last eight assignments (9x27, averaging .333). He had knocks in both games of Thursday's double header and he also drew a walk in game two

JOSEPHINA JAMMED IN JULY: The Fire Frogs utility man Kevin Josephina had his longest hitting streak of the season come to an end last Saturday. He had a hit in seven consecutive assignments, starting on July 19 and was averaging . 429 (9x21) with a homer and 2 RBIs over that span. Kevin slashed .243 in 23 July ballgames, reaching base in 17 of those and driving in six runs. On Thursday, he became the second Fire Frog to record two triples in a game, joining Jefrey Ramos who had two three-base hits on June 3. He went $3 \times 3$ in that contest while scoring twice and driving in two runs to pace the win.

THE MORITZ POND MASH: Andrew Moritz has enjoyed the friendly confines of Osceola County Stadium since being called up to the Fire Frogs mid-season, averaging . 350 (28x80) with eight multi-hit efforts. He has hits in 18 of his 20 home assignments and is currently on an ten-game home hit streak which is the longest active streak in the FSL. He is hitting just .231 away from home. He hopes to extend his six-game hitting streak today: . 375 AVG (9x24), 3 RBIs

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Florida starting pitchers really started to warm up in July, with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over the last six games, starters have permitted just a 1.01 ERA (4ER/35.2 IP) going back to game two of last Friday's double header against Daytona. The starters have allowed just four total runs (3ER) the last 30.2 innings. Taking this back a bit further, six quality starts have been fired over the previous eleven games and the pitchers have maintained a 2.28 ERA (17 ER/67 IP), this span does include RHP Tristan Beck allowing 6 ER over 5.1 IP last Friday in game one of the twin bill against Daytona
