.1-3 (18-27) .3-1 (19-26) .0-6 (13-28) MONDAY: The Fire Frogs suffered a doubleheader sweep, 6-0 and 6-2, to the Lakeland Flying Tigers at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium, being outscored 12-2. Florida was shutout for the fourth time this season, and first time since a 1-0 setback at Clearwater on April 23rd. Florida had numerous opportunities in game one, loading the bases in the 3rd but not scoring while going 0-5 with men in scoring position for the game and stranding six. LHP Hayden Deal allowed contact but pieced together another solid start, permitting just one run and eight hits over five innings. A five-run sixth, highlighted by Reynaldo Rivera's two-run bomb blew the game open.

The Flying Tigers started more quickly in game two, scoring once in the first and four times in the second. RHP Keith Weisenberg was knocked out of the game after recording just four outs. Greyson Jenista got the Fire Frogs on the board in the fourth with a two-run double, scoring William Contreras and Riley Unroe, to trim the deficit to 5-2 but that was as close as they would get.

Jenista and Unroe were the only players for Florida to have hits in both games.

<u>UNROE NOT TO BE UNDONE:</u> With his hits in both games yesterday, Riley Unroe became the first Florida player to get to a 15-game on-base streak. Since April 20th, Unroe has hit .316 with 2 HR and 8 RBI as part of the streak. He has a hit in 13 of 15 games and is on a season-best six-game knock streak.

<u>DELGADO DIGS IN:</u> The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 32 of the 35 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 28 of those 35 contests. Delgado only had one hit yesterday in the doubleheader but walked twice in the first game to still find a way on. He is currently on a 9-game on-base streak, trying to become the second Florida player to get a streak of 10 or more.

THE SERIES: This encounter between the Flying Tigers and Fire Frogs is their last of the first half. The season series was originally supposed to comprise of 7 games at Osceola County Stadium and 6 at Publix Field. Due to last Thursday's rainout in Kissimmee, that game was made up today as part of the twin bill. The Fire Frogs and Flying Tigers will meet 7 times in the second half, the next being at Publix Field in July. Florida is 6-7 as the Fire Frogs in games played at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: The third game of the set will see 22-year-old RHP Nolan Kingham make his fourth start at the Advanced-A level... His brother Nick pitches for the Pirates (4th Round pick in 2010)... Signed with the Braves for \$150,000... Also drafted by Milwaukee in the 39th Round in 2015... Youth and Community Studies major at Texas... Graffanino (#25), Jefrey Ramos (#26), Isranel Wilson (#28) round out those particular prospects.
